


Summary of timetable changes

| Area | DETAILS |

| 1a, 1b | Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2330 London Paddington to Cardiff Central service will be diverted and not call at Chippenham and Bath Spa. A replacement bus will serve these stations. |
| 1a – 1c, 14, 15 | Saturday – All day until approximately 0815 Sunday morning, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads/South Wales will be diverted and not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham/Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will serve these stations. Some trains will call additionally at Patchway for replacement buses to Bristol Parkway. Some services will be amended, some will not run. |
| 1e | Saturday – The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central and 2200 London Paddington to Cardiff Central services will terminate at Newport. Change at Newport for onwards rail connections to Cardiff Central. |
| 1e, 1f | Sunday – All day, buses will replace trains between Newport and Bridgend. Some services between Portsmouth Harbour and Newport (usually Cardiff Central) will not run. |
| 3a, 3b, 23 | Saturday – All day until approximately 0815 Sunday morning, trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa only. Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Swindon. |
| 5a – 5e | Saturday – All day, services between Bedwyn/Newbury and Reading/London Paddington will run EARLIER than usual. |
| 8a – 8f | Saturday – From approximately 2230 until the end of service, some trains will depart up to 8 minutes EARLIER than usual. |
| 8a – 8f | Sunday – From approximately 0030 until 0500, buses will replace trains between Reading and London Paddington. |
| 8b | Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday – The 2351 London Paddington to Reading service will not call at West Ealing or Hanwell. |
| 8d | Monday – From approximately 2215 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. |
| 15 | Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday – From approximately 2230 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne. |
| 15 | Friday – From approximately 2345 until the end of service, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne. |
| 25b – 25d, 27a | Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2320 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will depart 30 minutes EARLIER than usual and run earlier throughout. A replacement bus will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Frome, departing at the usual time. |
| 25e | Saturday - All day, trains between Swindon and Westbury (via Melksham) will be amended. Some services will not run. |
| 31c | Sunday – All day, buses will replace trains between Newton Abbot and Plymouth. Some services between London Paddington and the West of England will not run. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington, the Night Riviera service, will run 150 minutes later than usual between Plymouth and Newton Abbot, and arrive at London Paddington 60 minutes later than usual. |
| 31c | Thursday - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance, The Night Riviera service, will depart Exeter St Davids at 0350 and Newton Abbot at 0412. |
| 38 | Sunday – All day, trains between Par and Newquay will run to an amended timetable. |
