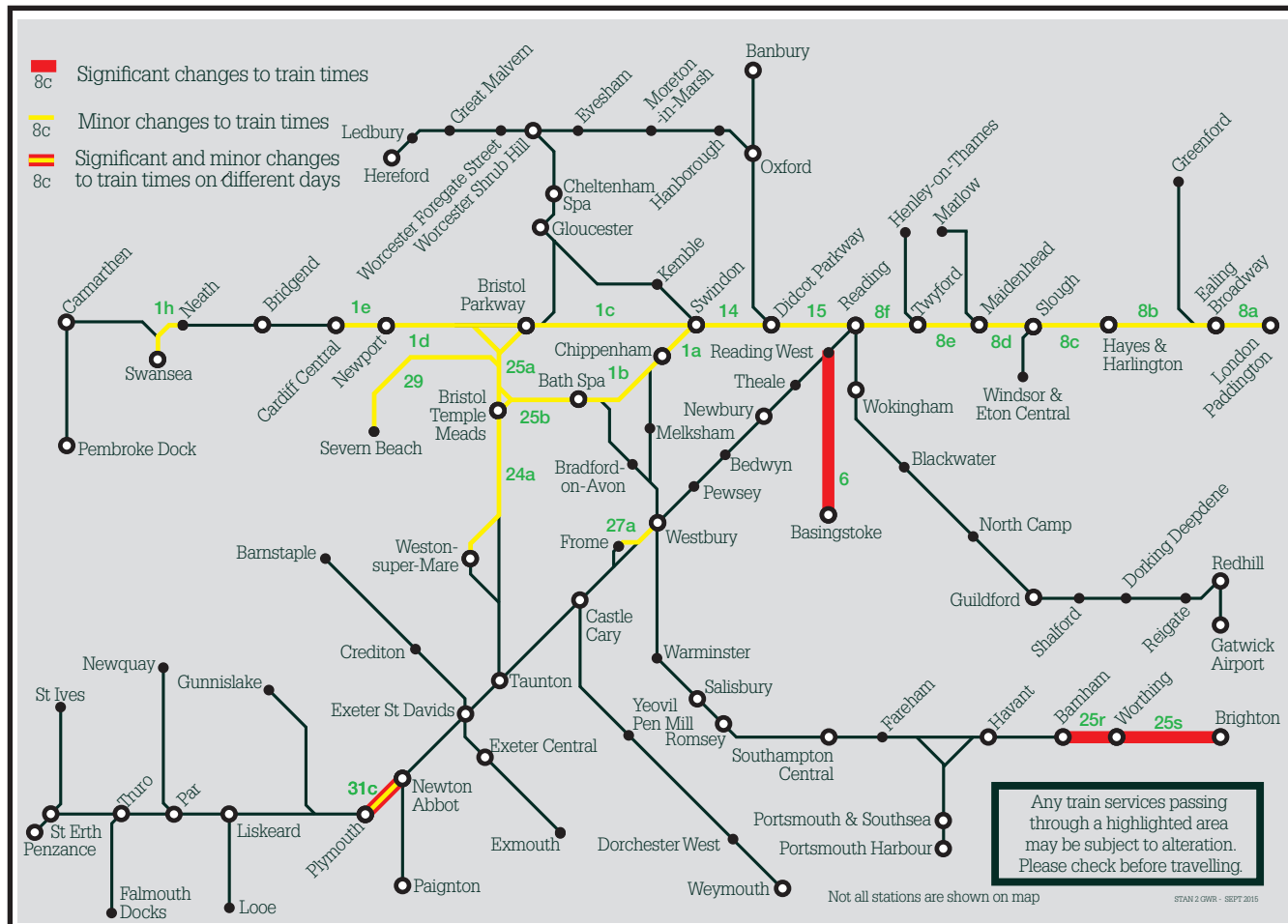


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a, 1b, 1c, 14, 15 ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 until 0530 the following morning, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads/South Wales will be diverted and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Replacement buses will serve these stations.
1a, 25b – 25e ●	Sunday – The 0848 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads service will depart later at 0857 and will run later throughout. The 0926 Swindon to Westbury service will depart later at 0947 and run later throughout. The 0820 Warminster to Swindon service will start from Westbury at 0852. An EARLIER replacement bus will run to connect with the train.
1d, 1e, 25a ●	Sunday – The 0801 Exeter St Davids to Bristol Temple Meads service will continue to Cardiff Central, calling at Filton Abbey Wood, Severn Tunnel Junction, Newport and Cardiff Central.
1h ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2115 and 2245 London Paddington to Swansea service will terminate at Neath. Replacement buses will run between Neath and Swansea.
1h ●	Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – The 0354 Swansea to London Paddington service will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run between Swansea and Neath to connect with the train.
6 ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1500, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.
8a – 8f ●	Saturday – The 0518 London Paddington to Oxford service will depart 1 minute EARLIER than usual and run earlier through to Reading.
8a – 8f, 15 ●	Sunday – The 0814 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway service will depart EARLIER at 0802.
8a – 8f, 15 ●	Monday and Wednesday – The 2327 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway service will depart 9 minutes later than usual and will run later throughout.
8d ●	Tuesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Taplow or Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
8e, 8f ●	Sunday – The 0005, 0030, 0100 and 0645 London Paddington to Reading services will terminate at Maidenhead. Change at Maidenhead for a replacement bus for Twyford and Reading.
15 ●	Sunday and Monday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 Monday morning , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15 ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 the following morning , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15 ●	Friday – From approximately 2345 until 0530 Saturday 27 January, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
24a ●	Sunday – From approximately 2200 until the end of service, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare.
25a ●	Sunday – The 2233 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will terminate at Bristol Parkway.
25a ●	Monday – The 0445 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington service will start from Bristol Parkway. An EARLIER replacement bus will run to connect with the train.
25a, 29 ●	Sunday – The 0858 Bristol Temple Meads to Severn Beach service will depart 8 minutes EARLIER than usual and run earlier throughout. The 0946 Severn Beach to Taunton service will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads.
25r, 25s ●	Sunday – All day , buses will replace trains between Barnham and Brighton. The 2146 Brighton to Portsmouth Harbour service will not run.
27a ●	Thursday – The 2320 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run between Westbury and Frome.
31c ●	Saturday – All day , trains will not run between Totnes and Plymouth. Services between London Paddington/Bristol Temple Meads and the West of England will terminate/start at Totnes. Replacement buses will run between Totnes and Plymouth.
