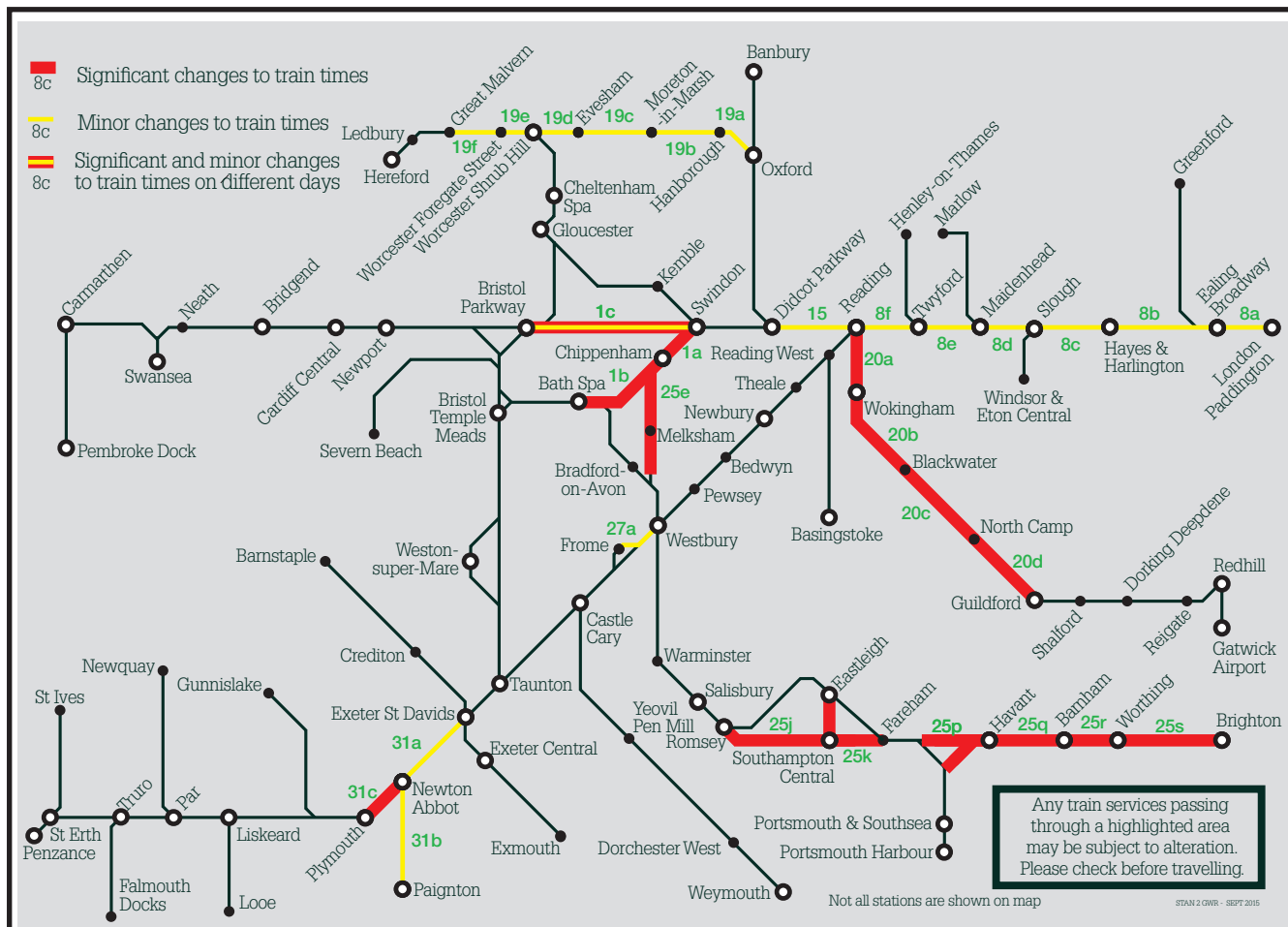


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a, 1b	● Sunday – All day , trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Travel on alternative services for Didcot Parkway and Swindon. Replacement buses will run between Swindon, Chippenham and Bath Spa.
1a, 25e	● Sunday – All day , buses will replace trains between Swindon and Westbury. The 0802 Westbury to Warminster and 0820 Warminster to Swindon services will not run.
1c	● Sunday – All day , trains between London Paddington and South Wales will not call at Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. The 0837 London Paddington to Swansea service will depart EARLIER than usual at 0751.
1c	● Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2245 London Paddington to Swansea service will be diverted between Swindon and Bristol Parkway and will run later than usual from Bristol Parkway and beyond.
8a – 8f, 15	● Sunday – The 0814 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway service will depart EARLIER than usual at 0802.
8d	● Sunday – From approximately 2215 until the end of service, trains will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
8d	● Monday – The 0502 Reading to London Paddington service will not call at Taplow or Burnham. Customers will need to travel on a later service.
8d	● Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 until 0515 the following morning, trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
8d	● Friday – From approximately 2330 until the end of service, trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
15	● Saturday and Sunday – From approximately 2300 Saturday evening until 0945 Sunday morning, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15	● Sunday and Monday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 Monday morning, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15	● Friday – From approximately 2345 until 0530 Saturday 10 February, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
19a – 19f	● Sunday – The 0800 London Paddington to Great Malvern service will now depart EARLIER than usual at 0759.
20a – 20d	● Sunday – All day , buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford, with an amended hourly train service operating between Guildford and Redhill/Gatwick Airport.
25j, 25k	● Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , services between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central. They will call additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Customers for Southampton Central should change at Salisbury on Saturday and Eastleigh on Sunday. Some services will terminate earlier in their journey. Some services will not run.
25p – 25s	● Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , services to/from Brighton will not run. Please use other operators' services to complete your journey.
27a	● Saturday – The 2310 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run between Westbury and Frome.
31a, 31b	● Wednesday – The 2355 Paignton to Exeter St Davids service will run approximately 15 minutes later than usual between Starcross and Exeter St Davids.
31c	● Saturday – All day , trains will not run between Totnes and Plymouth. Services between London Paddington/Bristol Temple Meads and the West of England will terminate/start at Totnes/Exeter St Davids. Replacement buses will run between Totnes and Plymouth.
