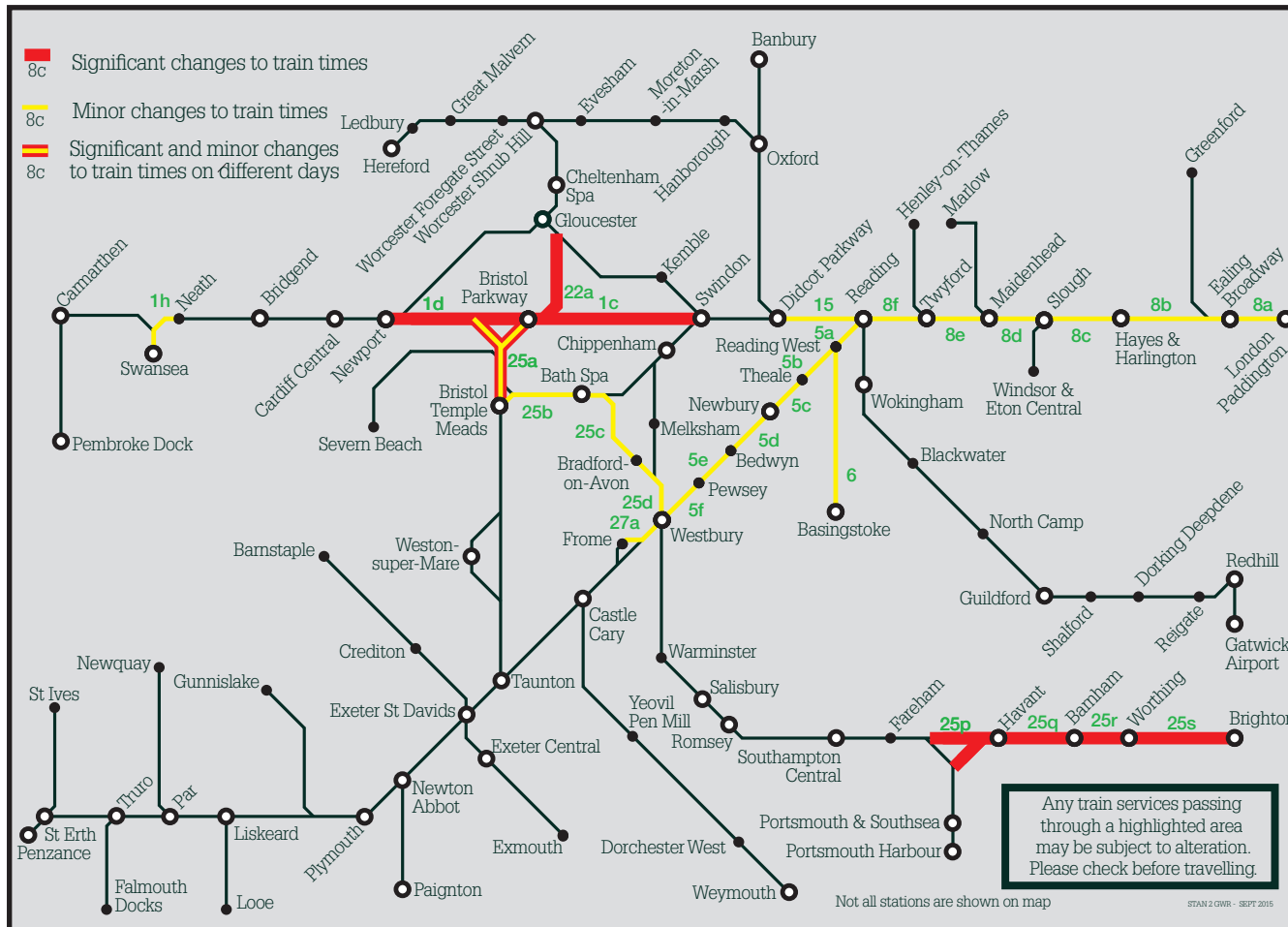


## Summary of timetable changes

1c, 1d	<p><b>Saturday and Sunday – All weekend</b>, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. Trains will call at Patchway. Replacement buses will run between Patchway and Bristol Parkway. On Saturday, trains from London Paddington to South Wales will depart up to 15 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 0759 Swansea to London Paddington, 0900 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads and 1915 London Paddington to Swansea services will not run. The 2335 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads service will depart 5 minutes EARLIER than usual. On Sunday, the 1525 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington, 1803 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads and 1903 London Paddington to Swansea services will not run. 1c, 1d	<p><b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week</b>, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. 1h	<p><b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday</b> – The 2115 and 2245 London Paddington to Swansea services will terminate at Neath. Change at Neath for an onwards replacement bus to Swansea.</p>
1h	<p><b>Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday</b> – The 0354 Swansea to London Paddington service will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run between Swansea and Neath to connect with the train.</p>
5a – 5f	<p><b>Saturday – From approximately 2115 until 0845 the following morning</b>, buses will replace trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn. On Sunday morning, the 0857 London Paddington to Penzance service will depart 3 minutes EARLIER than usual and be diverted between Reading and Westbury.</p>
5a – 5f	<p><b>Sunday – From approximately 2100 until the end of service</b>, buses will replace trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn. Some services between London Paddington and the West of England will be diverted.</p>
6	<p><b>Saturday – From approximately 2115 until 0845 the following morning</b>, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.</p>
6	<p><b>Sunday – From approximately 2100 until the end of service</b>, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.</p>
8a – 8f	<p><b>Sunday</b> – The 0100 London Paddington to Reading service will be replaced by two bus services: a direct London Paddington to Reading and a stopping service. The 0803 London Paddington to Great Malvern service will depart 3 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 0815 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will depart 13 minutes EARLIER than usual.</p>
8a – 8f	<p><b>Monday, Wednesday and Friday</b> – The 2259 London Paddington to Reading service will depart 2 minutes EARLIER than usual and not call at Acton Main Line, Iwer and Langley. The 2314 London Paddington to Reading service will depart 2 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 2351 London Paddington to Reading service will not call at Acton Main Line, West Ealing or Hanwell.</p>
8d	<p><b>Sunday</b> – The 1600, 1700 and 1800 Reading to London Paddington services will not call at Burnham. Please travel on alternative services.</p>
8d	<p><b>Monday, Wednesday and Thursday – From 2215 until 0515 the following morning</b>, trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
8d	<p><b>Friday – From approximately 2330 until the end of service</b>, trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
8f	<p><b>Tuesday, Thursday and Friday</b> – The 0019 Henley-on-Thames to Reading service will terminate at Twyford. Change at Twyford for an onwards rail connection to Reading.</p>
15	<p><b>Sunday – From approximately 2300 until the end of service</b>, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>
15	<p><b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2130 until 0515 the following morning</b>, trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.</p>

22a, 25a ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week</b> , buses will replace trains between Yate and Filton Abbey Wood. 25a – 25d, 27a ●	<b>Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday</b> – The 2320 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will depart 30 minutes EARLIER than usual and run earlier throughout. There will be a replacement bus departing at the usual time.
25p – 25s ●	<b>Sunday – All day</b> , GWR service will not run between Cosham and Brighton. Some trains will start/terminate earlier in their journey. Change for other operators' onwards rail connections to/from Brighton.
