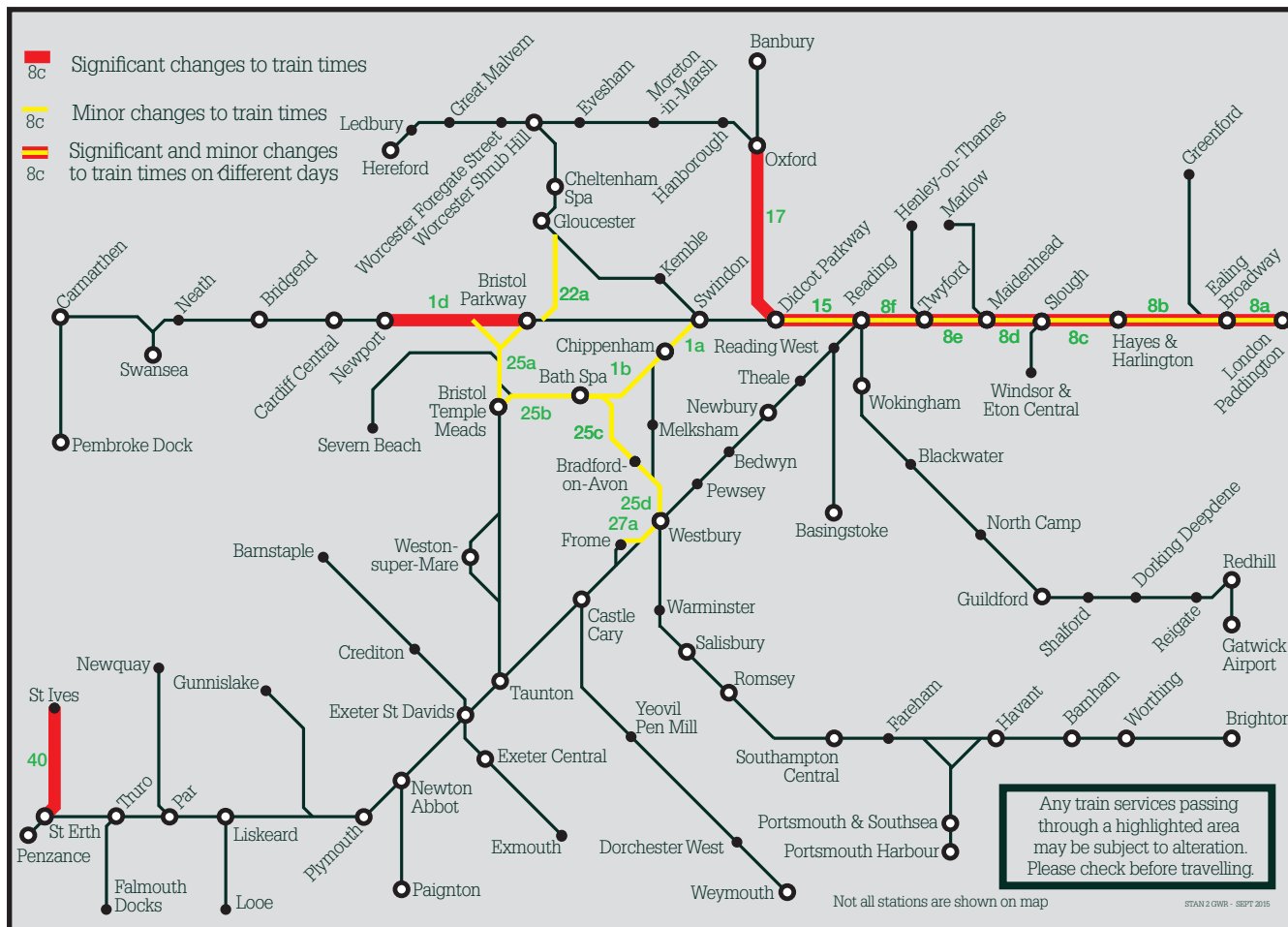


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a, 1b, 25b ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2215 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads and 2330 London Paddington to Cardiff Central (Bristol Temple Meads on Monday only) will be diverted and not call at Chippenham and Bath Spa. Replacement buses will serve these stations.
1d ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1530 , trains will not call at Bristol Parkway. Trains will call additionally at Patchway. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Patchway.
8a – 8f, 15 ●	Saturday – The 2312 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will terminate at Reading. Change at Reading for an onwards rail connection towards Didcot Parkway.
8a – 8f ●	Sunday – The 1912 London Paddington to Swansea service will depart 7 minutes EARLIER than usual.
8a – 8f, 15, 17 ●	Sunday – All day , trains between London Paddington and Oxford/Worcester/Great Malvern/Hereford will depart EARLIER than usual and not call at Didcot Parkway. Stopping services between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway will terminate/start at Reading. Services which usually run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford will be extended to start/terminate at Reading.
8a – 8f ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2200 until the end of service , trains will depart London Paddington up to 10 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 2201 Reading to London Paddington service will not call at Langley and Iwer. The 2353 London Paddington to Reading service will not call at West Ealing and Hanwell.
8d ●	Saturday – From approximately 2345 until 0800 Sunday morning , trains will not call at Taplow or Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow (buses will not run to Taplow after 0030).
8d ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2200 until the end of service , trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
8d ●	Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – The 0502 Reading to London Paddington service will not call at Taplow and Burnham. Please use alternative services to complete your journey.
8d ●	Friday – From approximately 2330 until the end of service , trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
15 ●	Saturday – From approximately 2300 until the end of service , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15 ●	Friday – From approximately 2345 until the end of service , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
22a, 25a ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1530 , buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Gloucester. You will need to travel EARLIER than usual to maintain connections to rail services.
25b – 25d, 27a ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2320 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will run 30 minutes EARLIER than usual. A replacement bus will depart at the usual time.
40 ●	Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – All week , buses will replace trains between St Erth and Lelant Saltings. A small number of trains will run between St Erth and St Ives. For more information visit GWR.com/StErth
