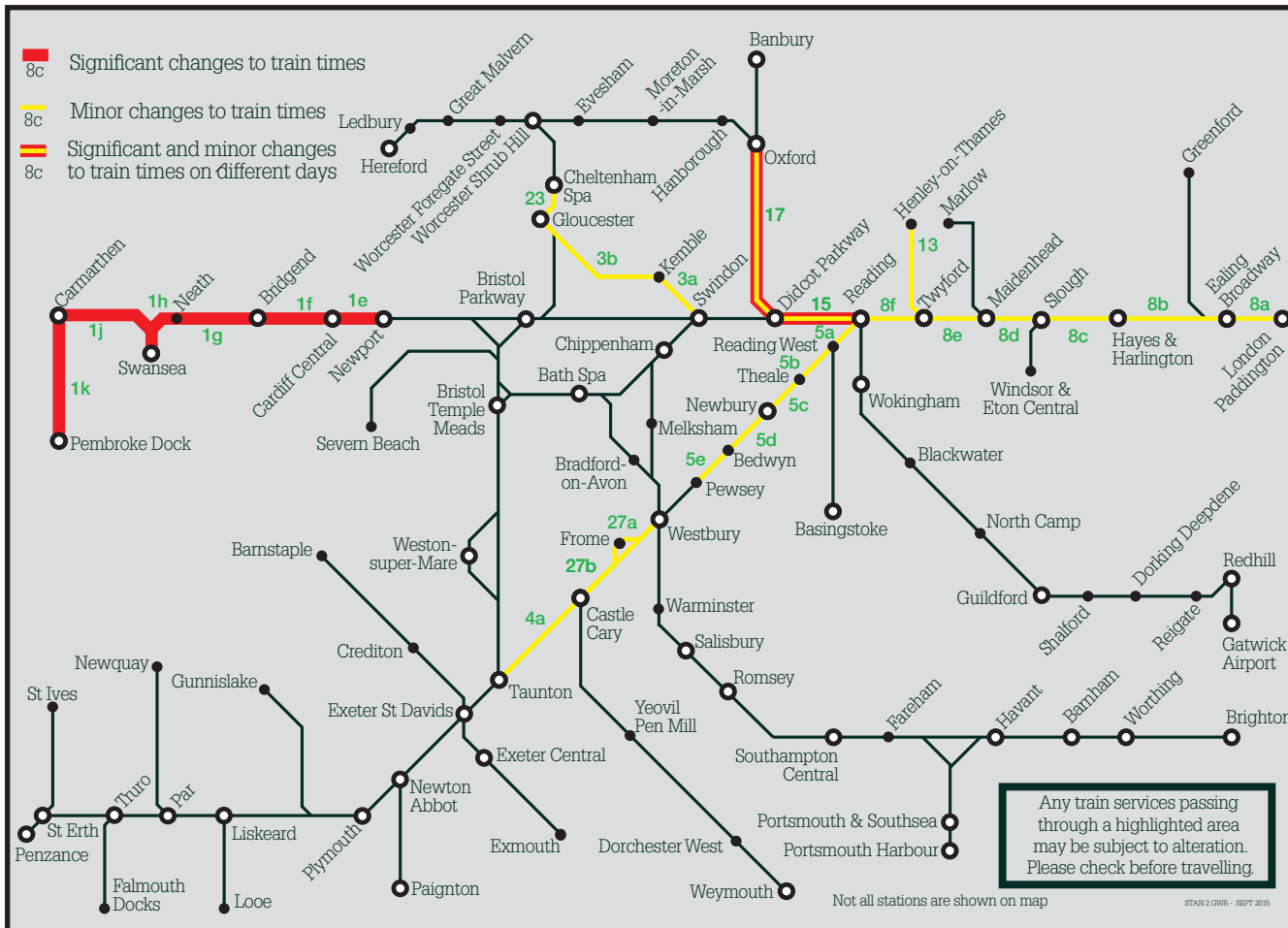


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1e ●	Saturday – All day , trains from Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will depart 3 minutes EARLIER than usual. Most trains between Cardiff Central and Weston-super-Mare/Taunton will start from/terminate at Newport. The 0630 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour service will start from Newport. The 0723 Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central will not run.
1f – 1h, 1j, 1k ●	Saturday – All day , trains from Pembroke Dock/Carmarthen/Swansea to London Paddington will run up to 10 minutes EARLIER than usual.
1f – 1h ●	Sunday – All day , trains between Carmarthen/Swansea and London Paddington will run a few minutes EARLIER than usual. The 0753 Swansea to London Paddington service will start from Cardiff Central. A fast bus will run from Swindon to Cardiff Central to connect with the train. A stopping bus will also run.
3a, 3b, 23 ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2336 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa service will be diverted between Swindon and Gloucester, not calling at Kemble, Stroud and Stonehouse, and terminate at Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve these stations.
4a ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2103 London Paddington to Plymouth service will be diverted between Westbury and Taunton, not calling at Castle Cary. It will run up to 35 minutes later than usual from Taunton and beyond. A replacement bus will run between Westbury and Castle Cary.
5a – 5e ●	Sunday – All day , trains between London Paddington and Newbury/Bedwyn will operate between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn only.
8a – 8f ●	Sunday – All day , trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads/Cheltenham Spa and the West of England will depart up to 15 minutes EARLIER than usual.
13 ●	Sunday – All day , trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames will run up to 5 minutes later than usual.
15 ●	Saturday – From approximately 2300 until the end of service , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15 ●	Sunday – All day , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne. Trains from Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will depart a few minutes EARLIER than usual.
15 ●	Monday – The 0407 will depart 1 minute later than usual and not call at Pangbourne. A replacement bus will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
17 ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1245 , buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. From approximately 1245 until the end of service, stopping trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford will not run. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway, Radley and Oxford.
17 ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday - Each day , the 0550 Oxford to London Paddington service will not call at Culham. The 0608 Oxford to Didcot Parkway service will call additionally at Culham.
27a ●	Saturday – The 2310 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will terminate at Westbury. Change at Westbury for an onwards rail connection to Frome.
