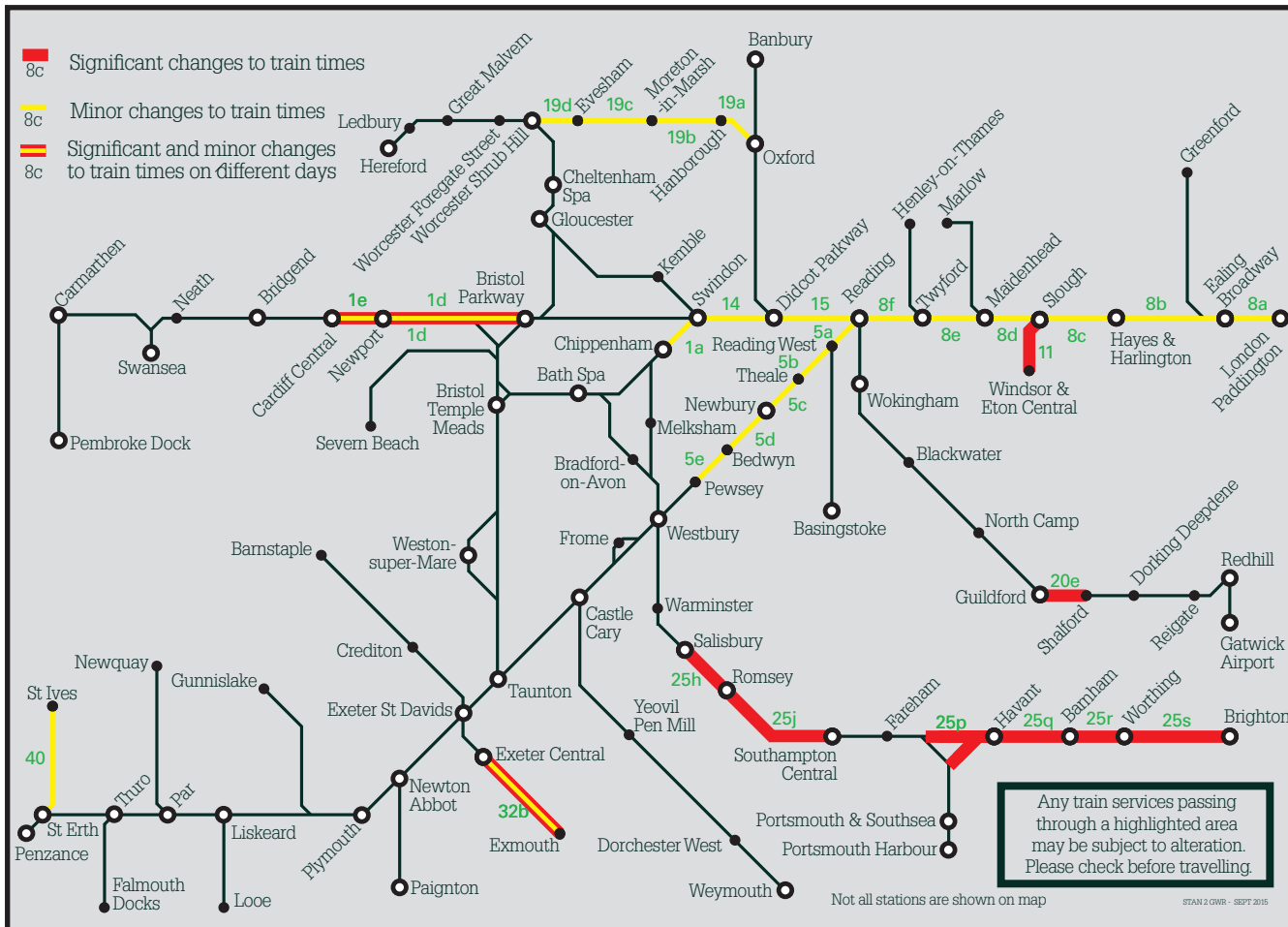


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1a, 14, 15 ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2330 London Paddington to Cardiff Central service will be diverted and not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham. Replacement buses will serve these stations.
1d, 1e ●	Saturday – The 2200 London Paddington to Cardiff Central service will terminate at Bristol Parkway. A replacement bus will run between Bristol Parkway and Cardiff Central.
1d, 1e ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1400 , buses will replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Newport/ Cardiff Central. Some trains which run beyond these stations will be amended. Some will not run.
5a – 5e ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 0930 , buses will replace trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn. From 0930 until the end of service, trains between London Paddington and Newbury/Bedwyn will run between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn only.
8a – 8c ●	Saturday – The 2349 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington service will terminate at Slough. A replacement bus will run between Slough and London Paddington. The 0100 London Paddington to Reading service (Sunday morning) will start from Slough. A replacement bus will run between London Paddington and Slough.
8a – 8c ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 0800 , buses will replace trains between London Paddington and Slough.
8a – 8f ●	Sunday – All day , trains from London Paddington to Bedwyn/Bristol Temple Meads/Cheltenham Spa/Hereford/Oxford/South Wales/ the West of England/Worcester will depart up to 10 minutes EARLIER usual.
8d ●	Saturday – From the start of service until approximately 0630 , trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
11 ●	Sunday – All day , buses will replace trains between Slough and Windsor & Eton Central (buses pick up and drop off at Windsor & Eton Riverside).
19a – 19d ●	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 2148 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill service will terminate at Oxford. A replacement bus will run between Oxford and Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2151 Hereford to London Paddington service will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill and restart at Oxford. A replacement bus will run between Worcester Shrub Hill and Oxford.
20e ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1600 , buses will replace trains between Guildford and Shalford. A special amended timetable will run between Reading and Guildford, and Shalford and Redhill/Gatwick Airport.
25h, 25j ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , buses will replace trains between Salisbury and Southampton Central. Some trains which run beyond these stations will be amended. Some will not run.
25p – 25s ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , GWR Brighton services will not run. Please travel on alternative operators' services to complete your journey.
32b ●	Saturday – From approximately 2030 until the end of service , buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids and Exmouth.
32b ●	Sunday – All day , buses will replace trains between Exeter Central and Exmouth.
40 ●	Saturday – All day , trains between Penzance/St Erth and St Ives will run between St Erth and St Ives only.
