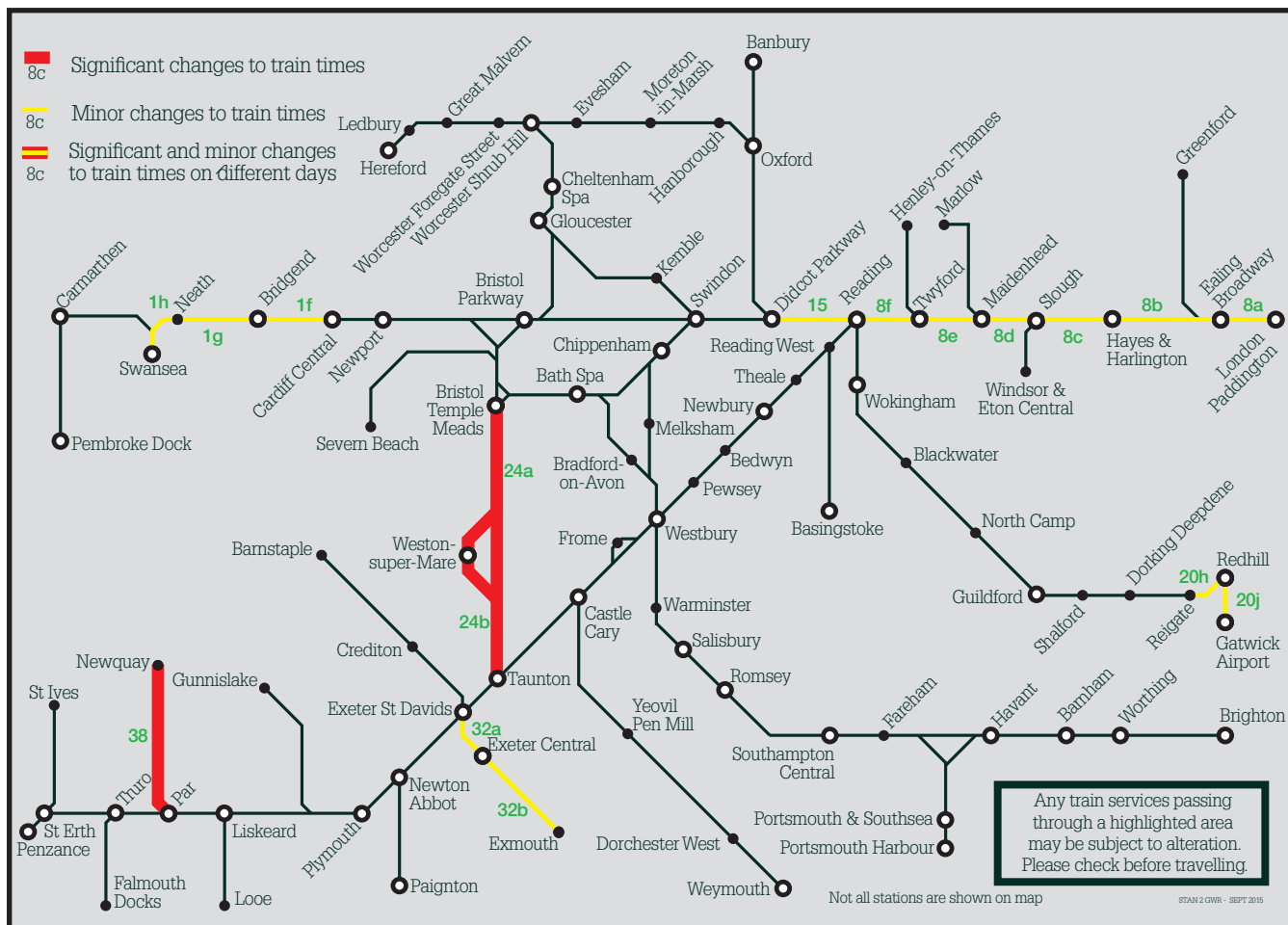


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1f – 1h ●	Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 1200 , buses will replace trains between Cardiff Central and Swansea. From approximately 1200 until the end of service , trains will be diverted between Cardiff Central and Bridgend, extending journey times by up to 30 minutes.
8a – 8f ●	Saturday – The 2250 London Paddington to Oxford service will depart 3 minutes EARLIER than usual. The 2320 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway service will depart 6 minutes EARLIER than usual.
8a – 8c ●	Sunday – The 0645 London Paddington to Reading service will start from Slough at 0740. A replacement bus will run between London Paddington and Slough to connect with the train.
8a, 8b ●	Monday – The 2351 London Paddington to Reading service will not call at West Ealing or Hanwell. Use alternative TfL Rail services to complete your journey.
8d ●	Monday and Wednesday – From approximately 2200 until 0515 the following morning , trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
15 ●	Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday – From approximately 2230 until 0515 the following morning , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
15 ●	Friday – From approximately 2345 until the end of service , trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Tilehurst and Pangbourne.
20h, 20j ●	Saturday – The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport service will now run as normal.
20j ●	Sunday – The 0611 Gatwick Airport to Reading service will now run as normal.
24a, 24b ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare/Taunton. Some rail services which go beyond these stations will be amended and some will not run.
32a, 32b ●	Monday – The 2216 Barnstaple to Exmouth service will terminate at Exeter St Davids. A replacement bus will run between Exeter St Davids and Exmouth.
32a, 32b ●	Tuesday – The 0004 Exmouth to Exeter St Davids service will be replaced by a bus.
38 ●	Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , trains will not run between Par and Newquay. Replacement buses will run between St Austell and Newquay.
