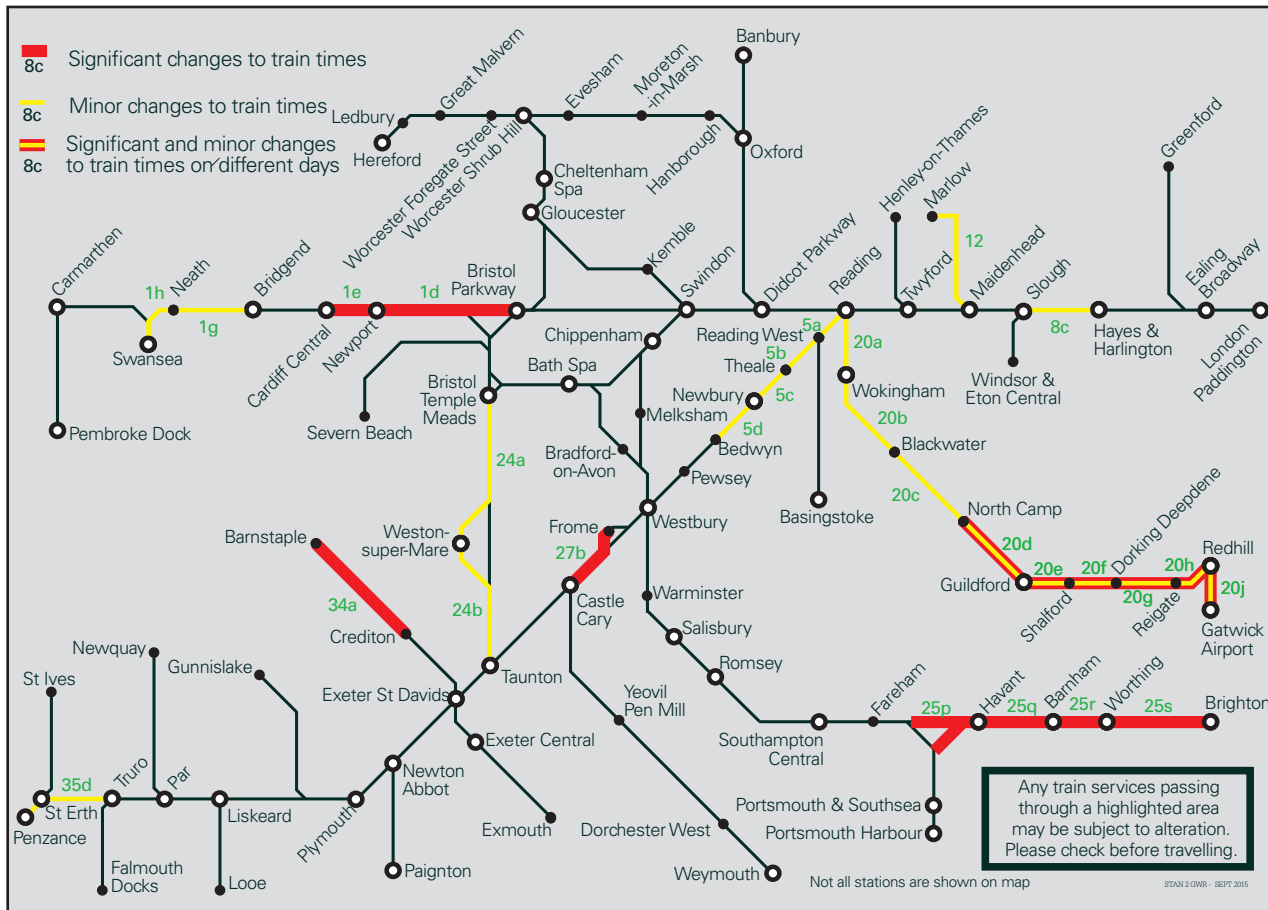


Summary of timetable changes

Area	DETAILS
1d – 1e	● Sunday – All day , an amended timetable will run between London Paddington and South Wales, with an hourly service in operation.
1g, 1h	● Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – The 0436 Swansea to London Paddington service will depart EARLIER than usual at 0431 and run earlier between Swansea and Cardiff Central.
5a – 5d	● Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2145 until the end of service , buses will replace trains between Reading and Newbury/Bedwyn.
8c	● Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday – From approximately 2345 until 0530 the following morning , GWR trains from Didcot Parkway/Reading to London Paddington will not call at Langley.
12	● Sunday – From the start of service until approximately 0915 , buses will replace trains between Maidenhead and Marlow.
20a – 20d	● Sunday – All day , buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford. Trains between Guildford and Redhill/Gatwick Airport will run to an amended timetable.
20a – 20d	● Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday – The 2318 Gatwick Airport to Reading service will terminate at Guildford. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Reading.
20a – 20d	● Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – The 0431 Reading to Gatwick Airport service will start from Guildford. An EARLIER fast replacement bus will run between Reading and Guildford to connect with the train. A replacement bus will also run at the usual time.
20d – 20h, 20j	● Friday – All day , buses will replace trains between North Camp and Redhill/Gatwick Airport. An amended rail service will run between Reading and Ash.
20e – 20h, 20j	● Thursday – The 2229 Reading to Gatwick Airport service will terminate at Redhill. Change at Redhill for an onwards rail connection to Gatwick Airport. The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport service will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run between Guildford and Gatwick Airport.
24a	● Sunday – The 0826 Weston-super-Mare to London Paddington service will depart 5 minutes EARLIER than usual. It will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. An onwards rail connection will run from Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington.
24a, 24b	● Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday – From approximately 2215 until the end of service , buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare/Taunton.
25p – 25s	● Sunday – All day , GWR Brighton services will not run. Please use other operators' services to complete your journey.
27a	● Friday – The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome service will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run between Westbury and Frome.
27b	● Sunday – All day , buses will replace trains between Westbury/Frome and Castle Cary. Services between London Paddington and the West of England will depart up to 45 minutes EARLIER than usual. Some services will not run.
34a	● Saturday and Sunday – All weekend , buses will replace trains between Crediton and Barnstaple.
35d	● Friday – The 0915 Penzance to London Paddington service will depart 2 minutes EARLIER than usual.
