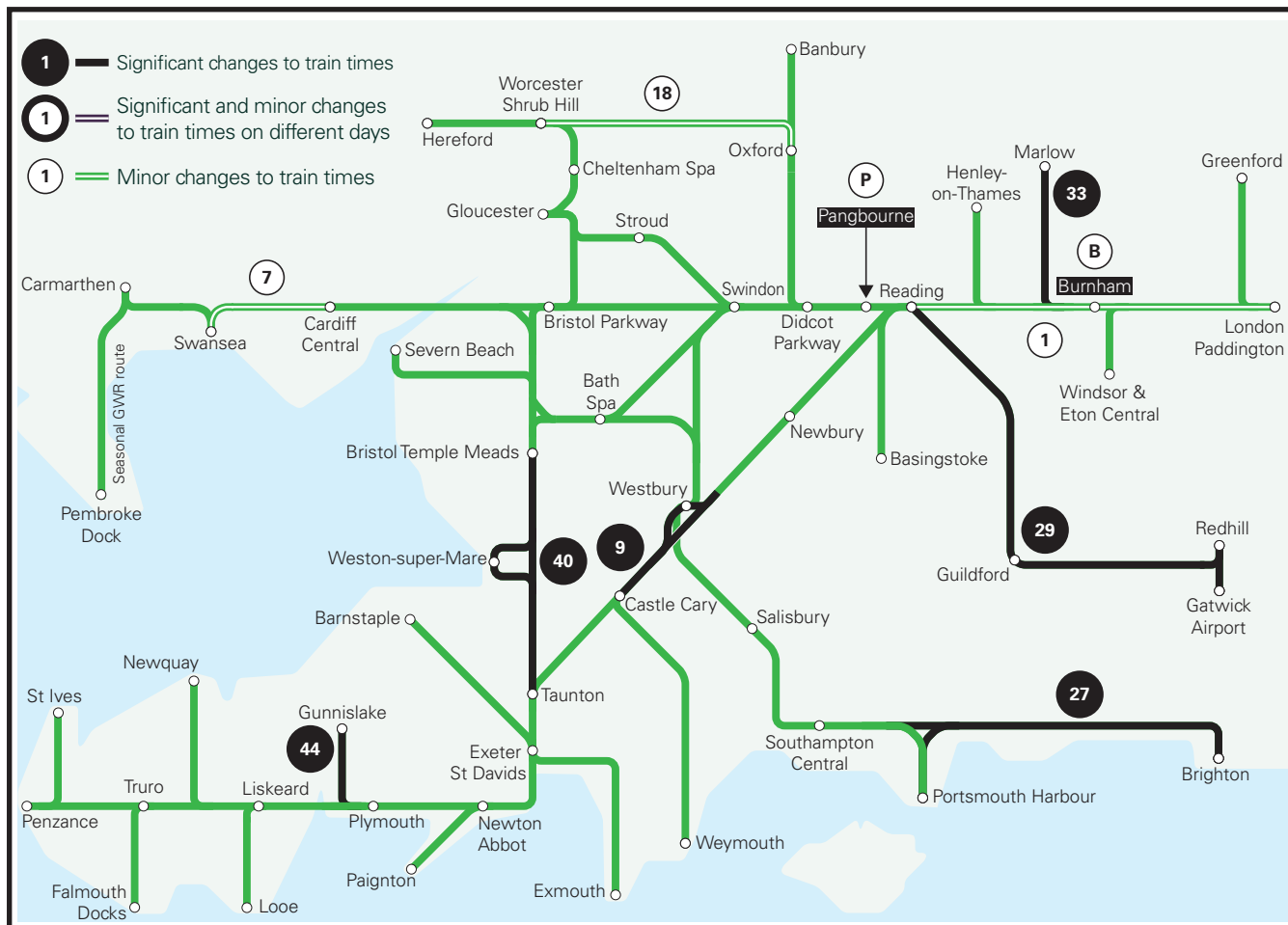


# Summary of timetable changes

## Saturday 14 to Friday 20 November 2020

- ① **From 2145 Saturday until 1300 Sunday** - Trains between London Paddington and Reading will have journey times amended. Some local trains will start from/terminate at Slough instead of London Paddington
- ⑦ **Sunday** - Trains between London Paddington and Swansea will be amended with trains diverted via an alternative route between Cardiff Central and Bridgend extending journey times.
- ⑨ **Saturday** - Trains between London Paddington and the West of England will run to an amended timetable with trains diverted via an alternative route. Some services between London Paddington and Exeter St Davids via Newbury, Pewsey or Westbury will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Castle Cary and between Castle Cary and Taunton.
- ⑨ **Sunday** - Trains between London Paddington and the West of England will run to an amended timetable with trains diverted via an alternative route. Some services between London Paddington and Exeter St Davids via Newbury, Pewsey or Westbury will terminate at Frome. Replacement buses will run between Frome and Castle Cary and between Castle Cary and Taunton.
- ⑨ **Saturday and Sunday** - Trains will run to an amended timetable between Bristol Temple Meads and Frome and between Castle Cary and Weymouth. Replacement buses will run between Frome and Castle Cary.
- ⑱ **Tuesday to Thursday** - 2150 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway and will then be diverted direct to Worcester Shrub Hill. An alternative train will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford where it will connect with a stopping bus service to Worcester Shrub Hill.
- ⑳ **Saturday** - Trains to/from Brighton will be amended. Buses will replace trains between Barnham and Brighton.
- ㉑ **Sunday** - Buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford. Trains will run at a reduced hourly frequency between Guildford and Gatwick Airport.
- ㉓ **From 0400 Saturday until Friday** - Buses will replace trains between Bourne End and Marlow.
- ㉔ **Sunday** - The line between Weston-super-Mare and Highbridge & Burnham will be closed. Trains from Bristol which terminate at Weston-super-Mare will continue to run. Trains between Bristol and Taunton will not call at Weston Milton or Weston-super-Mare. Change at Worle for buses to/from Weston Milton and Weston-super-Mare.
- ㉖ **Monday to Thursday** - Buses will replace trains between Plymouth and Gunnislake.
- Ⓑ **From 2350 Saturday until 0800 the next day** - Trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow connecting with trains.
- Ⓑ **From 2350 Sunday until 0200 the next day** - Trains will not call at Burnham. Buses will run between Slough and Burnham connecting with trains.
- Ⓟ **From 2300 Saturday until 0200 the next day** - Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst connecting with trains.
