

Changes to South Wales services Weekends in October 2021



Trains that normally use the Severn Tunnel will be affected by planned engineering work.

This will impact train services on 9/10, 16/17 and 23/24 October, as well as on Sunday 31 October.

- Trains between London Paddington and Swansea will be diverted by an alternative route, adding about 40 minutes to the normal journey time. These trains will not stop at Bristol Parkway
- Fewer trains will stop at Bristol Parkway. Change at Bristol Temple Meads for trains to London Paddington
- Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will start/terminate at Bristol Parkway
- Buses replace all trains between Bristol Parkway and Newport
- A reduced train service will run between Newport and Cardiff Central
- Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton only

Replacement buses

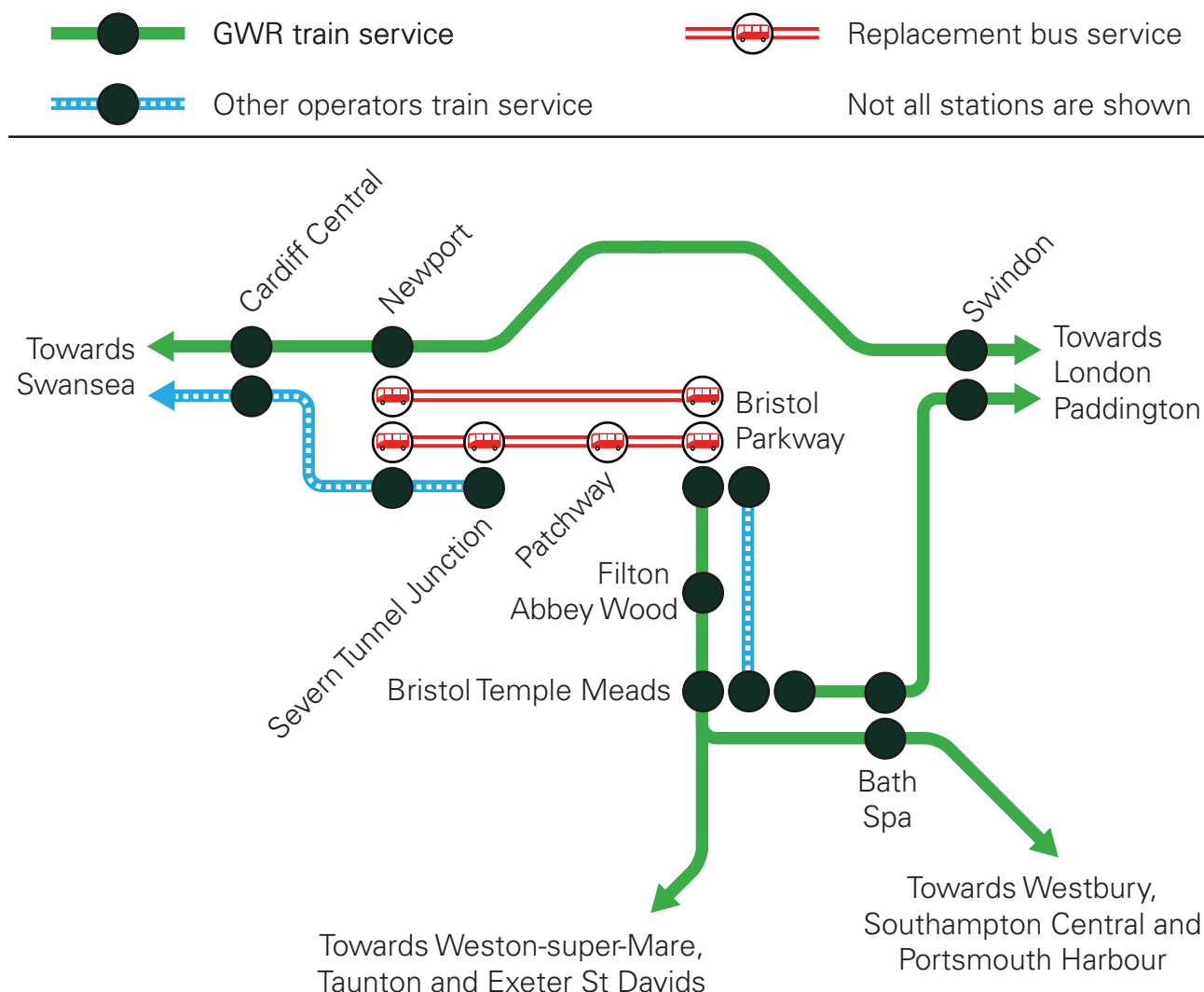
Road transport will be provided on the following routes:

Bristol Parkway – Newport

- Non-stop every 30 minutes – journey time 45 minutes
- Calling at Patchway and Severn Tunnel Junction every hour – journey time 1 hour 10 minutes

Replacement transport will also run between Bristol Parkway and Pilning on Saturdays.

Buses will depart from the station car parks at all affected stations.
