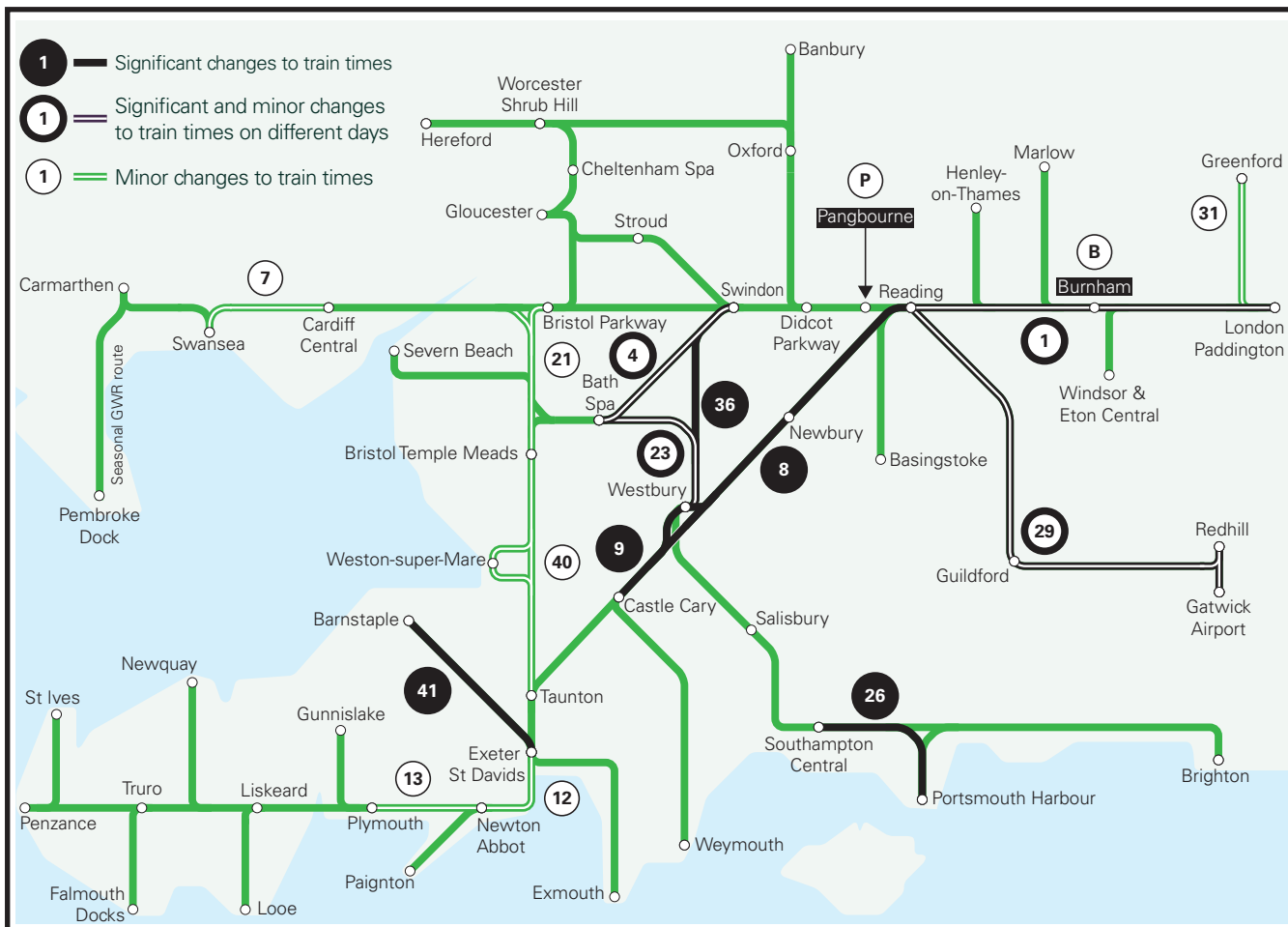


Summary of timetable changes

- ① **From 2100 Saturday until 0200 next day** - Trains will run to an amended timetable between London Paddington, Reading, Didcot Parkway, Bristol Parkway and Worcester.
-
- ① **Sunday** - Trains to and from London Paddington will run to an amended timetable. Some trains will depart earlier and some trains will not run to/from London Paddington.
-
- ④ **Saturday and Sunday** - Services will run to an amended timetable between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads with trains diverted via an alternative route. Trains will also run between Swindon and Chippenham with some continuing to / from London Paddington. Buses will replace trains between Chippenham and Bath Spa. Buses will be extended to / from Swindon on Saturday and Sunday evenings.

- ④ **Friday** - 2332 London Paddington to Cardiff Central will not call at Chippenham or Bath Spa. A bus operates between Swindon, Chippenham and Bath Spa, and to Bristol Temple Meads.
-
- ⑦ **Sunday until 0850** – Buses replace trains between Swansea and Cardiff Central.
-
- ⑦ **From 2230 Sunday until 0200 next day** – Trains from London Paddington to Swansea will run to an amended timetable, departing later than usual after Cardiff Central.
-
- ⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - Late evening trains from London Paddington to Swansea will run to an amended timetable, departing later than usual after Cardiff Central.
-
- ⑦ **Monday to Friday** – The 0346 Swansea to London Paddington will depart Swansea a few minutes earlier than usual and will run earlier as far as Cardiff Central.
-
- ⑧ **Monday to Thursday from 2150 until 0200 the next day** – Buses replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.
-
- ⑨ **Saturday and Sunday** – Trains between London Paddington, Exeter St Davids, Plymouth and Penzance call at Frome instead of Westbury. A train service operates Frome to Westbury.
-
- ⑫ ⑬ **Monday to Thursday from 2300 until 0200 the next day** – Trains will run to an amended timetable between Exeter St Davids and Plymouth, departing at later than usual times.
-
- ⑫ ⑬ **Tuesday and Wednesday** – Late night and early morning trains will run to an amended timetable between Paignton and Exeter St Davids, departing later than usual times.
-
- ⑳ **Tuesday to Friday** – The 0453 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington will start from Bristol Parkway. A bus runs from Bristol Temple Meads to connect with the train.
-
- ㉓ **Friday** – The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Bath Spa, with a bus serving Freshford, Avoncliff, Bradford-on-Avon, Trowbridge, Westbury and Frome.
-
- ㉓ ㉔ **Saturday and Sunday** - Trains will run to an amended timetable between Bristol Temple Meads, Cardiff Central/Great Malvern and Bath Spa, and between Westbury and Portsmouth Harbour / Weymouth. Buses replace trains between Bath Spa and Westbury. GWR trains will not run to Brighton, use alternative local services. On Sunday, buses will also replace trains between Portsmouth & Southsea and Portsmouth Harbour.

- ②9 **Saturday and Sunday** – Buses replace trains between Reading and Wokingham. Trains will run to an amended timetable between Wokingham and Redhill. Alternative trains will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.

 - ②9 **Tuesday to Friday from midnight to 0200 the next day** – The 0431 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford with a fast bus from Reading to Guildford to connect with the train. A local bus will serve intermediate stations.

 - ②9 **Tuesday to Friday** – The 0431 Reading to Gatwick Airport starts from Guildford with a fast bus from Reading to Guildford to connect. A local bus will serve intermediate stations.

 - ③1 **From 2030 Saturday until 0200 next day** - Trains between Greenford and West Ealing will not run. Customers should use alternative TfL services.

 - ③6 **Saturday and Sunday** - Trains run to an amended timetable between Swindon and Chippenham. Buses replace trains between Chippenham and Westbury.

 - ④0 **Monday and Tuesday from 2200 until 0200 Wednesday** – Trains will not call at Weston Milton or Weston-super-Mare. Buses run between Worle, Weston Milton and Weston-super-Mare.

 - ④1 **Saturday and Sunday** - Buses replace trains between Crediton and Barnstaple. Trains will run to an amended timetable between Crediton and St James' Park.

 - Ⓑ **From 2300 Saturday until 0200 the next day** - Trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

 - Ⓑ **From 2300 Sunday until 0200 the next day** - Trains will not call at Burnham. Buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

 - Ⓟ **From 0200 Saturday until 0910 Sunday** - Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
