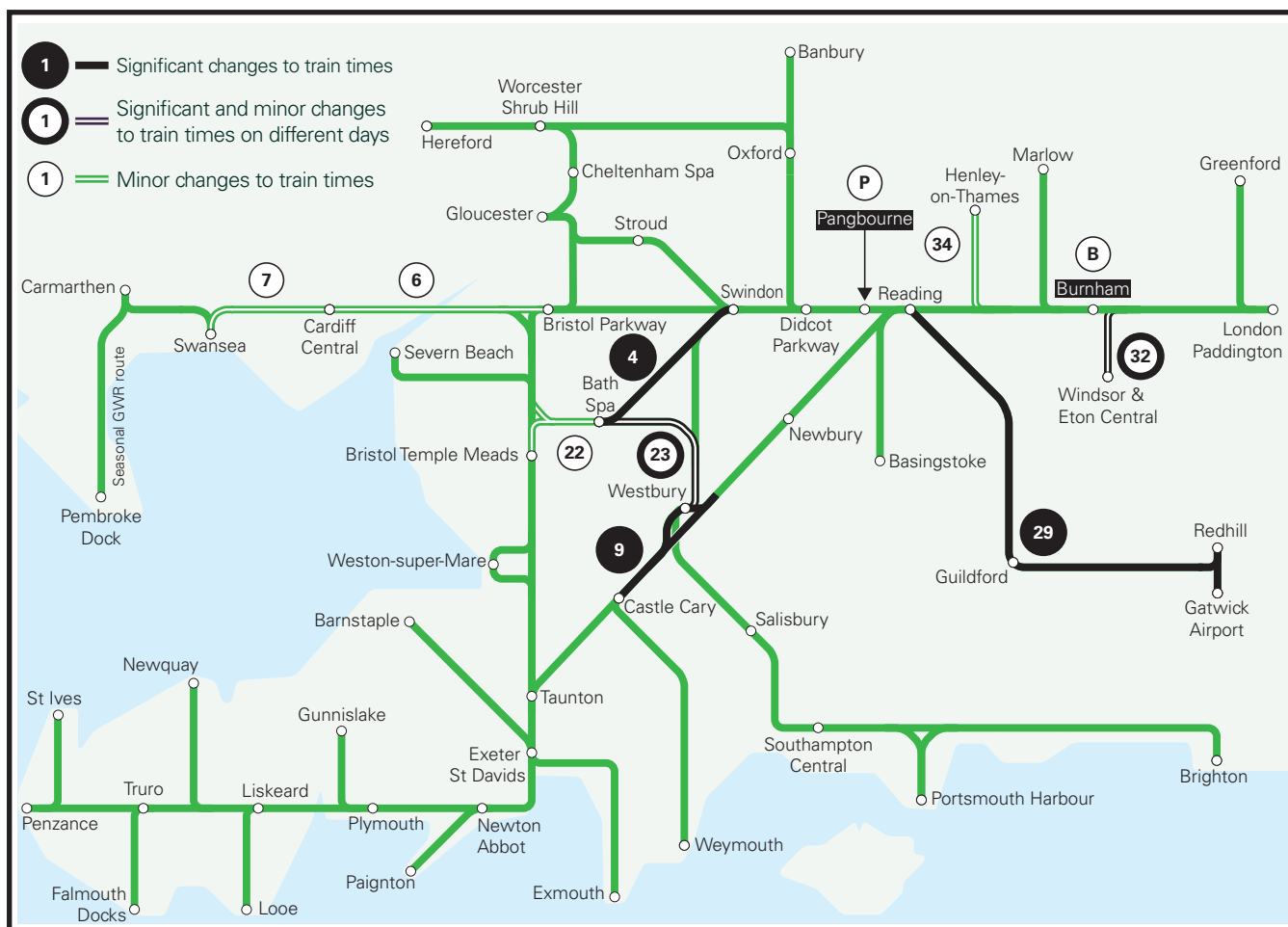


Summary of timetable changes

- 4** **Saturday and Sunday** - Services will run to an amended timetable between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads with trains diverted via an alternative route. Trains will also run between Swindon and Chippenham with some continuing to / from London Paddington. Buses will replace trains between Chippenham and Bath Spa. Buses will be extended to/from Swindon on Saturday and Sunday evenings.
-
- 6** **Monday to Wednesday and Friday** – The 2332 London Paddington to Cardiff Central will run later than usual after leaving Bristol Temple Meads.
-
- 6** **Wednesday and Thursday** – The 2248 London Paddington to Swansea and the 2332 London Paddington to Cardiff Central will run slightly later before Newport.
-
- 7** **Monday to Friday** – 0346 Swansea to London Paddington will depart Swansea a few minutes earlier than usual and will run earlier as far as Cardiff Central.
-
- 9** **Saturday and Sunday** – Trains between London Paddington, Exeter St Davids, Plymouth and Penzance call at Frome instead of Westbury. A train service operates Frome to Westbury.
-
- 22** **23** **Friday** – The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will run later than usual.
-
- 23** **Saturday and Sunday** - Trains will run to an amended timetable between Bristol Temple Meads, Cardiff Central / Great Malvern and Bath Spa, and between Westbury and Portsmouth Harbour / Weymouth. Buses replace trains between Bath Spa and Westbury. GWR trains will not run to Brighton, use alternative local services.
-
- 23** **Monday to Thursday** – The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will run to an amended timetable, terminating at Westbury and connecting with a bus to Frome.
-
- 29** **Saturday and Sunday** – Buses replace trains between Reading and Wokingham. Trains will run to an amended timetable between Wokingham and Redhill. Alternative trains will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.
-
- 29** **Sunday until 0200 the next day** – Buses replace trains between Reading and Wokingham, leaving earlier than usual. Trains will run to an amended timetable between Wokingham and Redhill / Gatwick Airport.
-
- 29** **Tuesday to Friday** – The 0431 Reading to Gatwick Airport service starts at Guildford, with a bus from Reading connecting into the train and a local bus serving intermediate stations.
-
- 32** **Saturday** – A bus will replace the 2353 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central.
-
- 32** **Sunday** – Early morning and late evening trains will be replaced by buses between Slough and Windsor & Eton Central.
-
- 34** **Monday to Thursday from 2100 until 0200 the next day** – Trains will run to an amended timetable between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames.
-
- B** **Monday to Friday from 2345 until 0200 the next day** - Trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
-
- P** **Friday from 2300 until 0200 the next day** - Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
