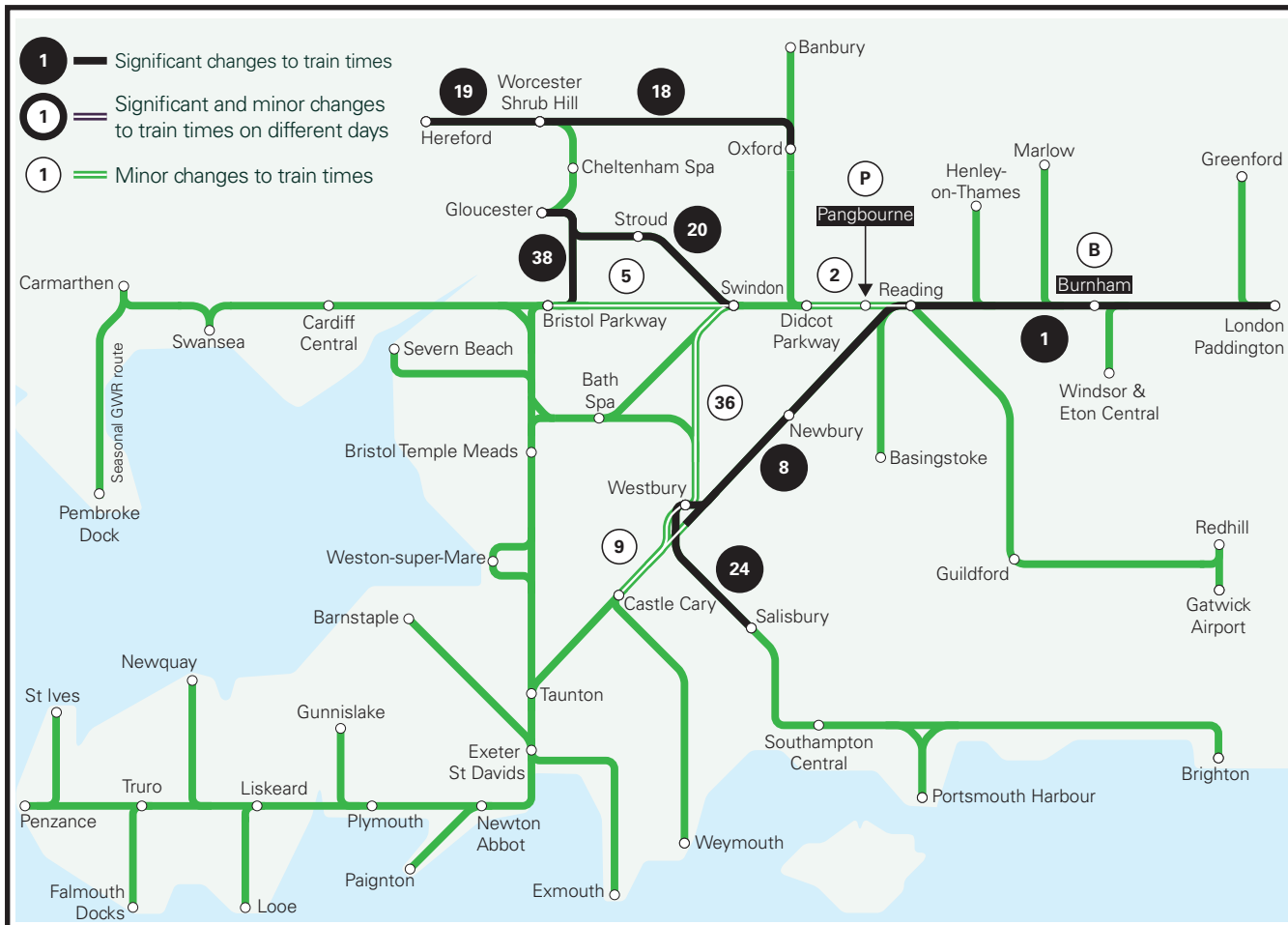


Summary of timetable changes

- ② **Monday to Thursday** - The 2315 London Paddington to Oxford will call additionally at Didcot Parkway.
-
- ⑤ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will run a little later after Bristol Parkway.
-
- ⑤ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2332 London Paddington to Cardiff Central will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon and Chippenham. A bus service will run from Reading to Didcot Parkway, Swindon, Chippenham, Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads.
-
- ⑧ **Saturday and Sunday** – Trains between London Paddington and the south west will run to a significantly amended timetable departing earlier than usual. Some trains will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, Swindon, Westbury and Castle Cary. Buses replace trains between Reading and Newbury, and between Swindon and Pewsey.
-
- ⑧ **Saturday and Sunday** – . Buses replace trains between Reading and Bedwyn. Alternative trains will run between London Paddington and Reading
-
- ⑨ **Saturday** – The 2329 Bath Spa to Frome terminates at Westbury connecting with a bus to Frome.
-
- ⑨ **Sunday until 1000** – Trains will run to an amended timetable between Westbury and Weymouth, and between Westbury and Bath Spa.
-
- ⑱ **Monday to Thursday from 2200 until 0200 the next day** – The 2150 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will be diverted and run to an amended timetable. Buses replace trains between Oxford and Worcester Shrub Hill.
-
- ⑳ **Saturday until Monday** – Buses replace trains between Warminster and Salisbury. Trains will run to an amended timetable between, Cardiff Central, Bristol Temple Meads, Frome and Warminster, and between Salisbury and Portsmouth Harbour. GWR trains will not run to Brighton, use alternative local services.
-
- ㉑ **Saturday, Sunday and Monday** – Buses replace trains between Swindon and Gloucester, with Kemble, Stroud and Stonehouse Town Hall being served by local stopping buses. A few early and late buses will extend to/from Cheltenham Spa. Trains will not run between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa.

- ㉒ **Saturday and Sunday** - Trains between Swindon, Melksham and Westbury will run to an amended timetable.
-
- ㉓ **Saturday until Monday** – Buses will replace trains between Gloucester and Bristol Parkway. Trains will run to an amended timetable between Great Malvern and Gloucester, and between Bristol Parkway and Bristol Temple Meads.
-
- Ⓑ **From 2300 Saturday until 0200 the next day** - Trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
-
- Ⓟ **Saturday until 0510** - Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
