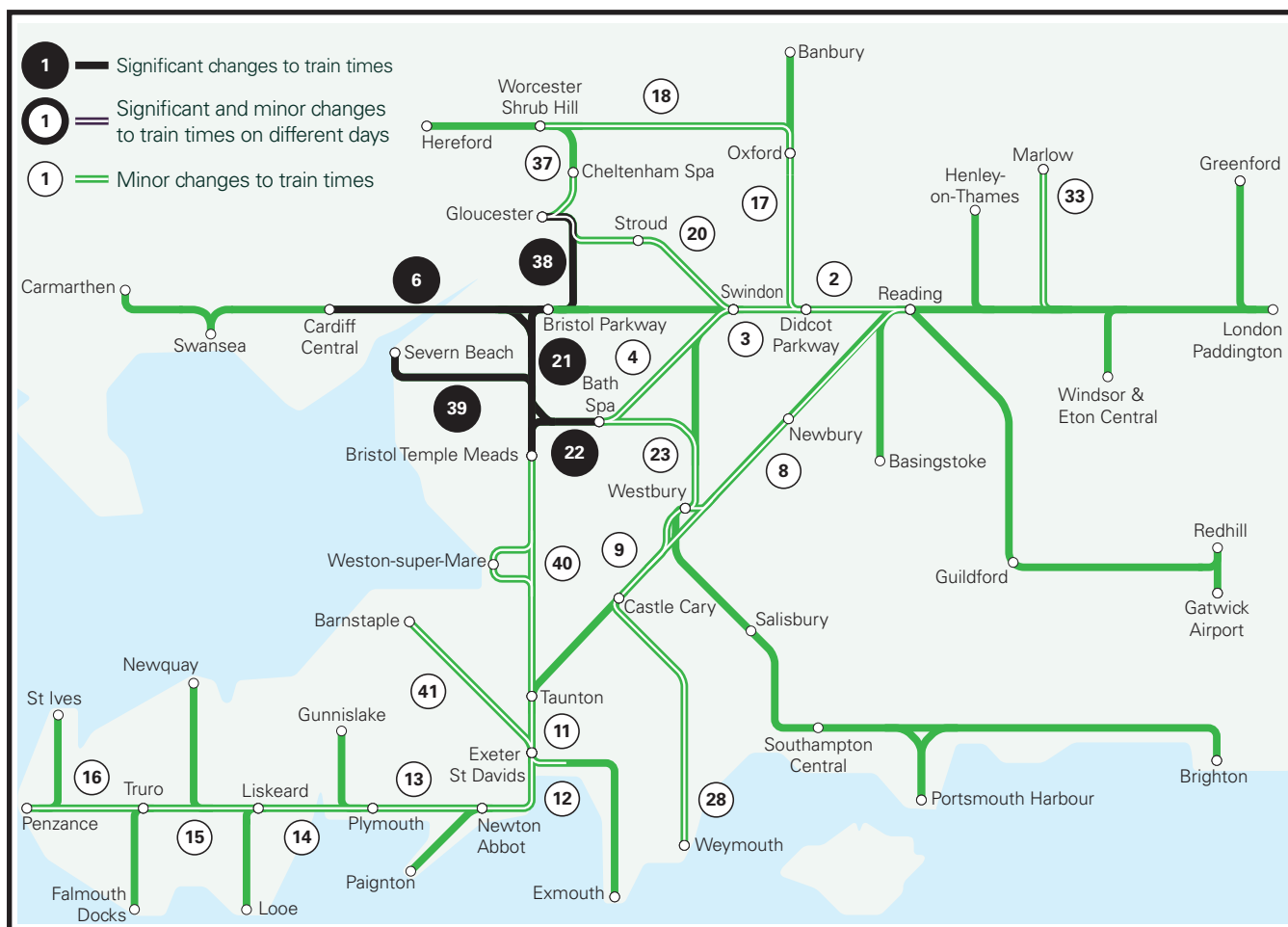


Summary of timetable changes

② ③ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. The 2318 London Paddington to Oxford will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Reading, Didcot Parkway, Swindon, Chippenham, Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads.

⑥ ②① **All week** – Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted, not calling at Bristol Temple Meads, but calling additionally at Bristol Parkway. Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton & between Bristol Parkway / Filton Abbey Wood and Weston-super-Mare will generally not run north of Bristol Temple Meads. A reduced train service will run between Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads; some trains will run EARLIER than usual. On Monday to Friday, a special train service will run between Bristol Parkway, Filton Abbey Wood and Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. Replacement buses will also run every day between Bristol Parkway and Bristol Temple Meads calling at all stations.

⑧ **All week** – Minor changes between Bedwyn and Reading due to fleet availability. Passengers to / from Bedwyn, Hungerford and Kintbury will need to change trains at Newbury.

⑨ ②⑧ **Sunday** – Most trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weymouth will run between Westbury and Weymouth only. Rail connections will be available at Westbury.

⑪ to ⑩ **All week** – A few trains will be retimed between Taunton and Penzance, in some cases running EARLIER than usual.

Monday to Thursday – The 2150 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway (change for a rail connection to Oxford and Moreton-in-Marsh) and will then be diverted, not calling at stations from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. A replacement bus will run from Moreton-in-Marsh to Worcester Shrub Hill.

⑰ ⑱ The 2250 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will terminate at Moreton-in-Marsh. A replacement bus will run from Moreton-in-Marsh to Worcestershire Parkway.

The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill and restart from Oxford. Replacement buses will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford; one non-stop (to connect at Oxford with the train), the other calling at all stations (no connection).

⑳ ⑳ **Sunday from approximately 1300** – Trains from Cheltenham Spa to Swindon will run a few minutes EARLIER than usual.

⑳ **Wednesday** – The 1134 Maidenhead to Marlow and 1200 Marlow to Maidenhead will be replaced by buses throughout.

⑳ **All week** – A special service will run between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa / Great Malvern. Rail and / or bus connections will be available for passengers travelling to / from stations south of Bristol Parkway.

㉑ **Saturday and Monday to Friday** – A special hourly service will run between Lawrence Hill and Avonmouth / Severn Beach. Passengers travelling to / from Bristol Temple Meads should use replacement buses to / from Stapleton Road.

Sunday – A replacement bus service will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Severn Beach.

㉒ **All week** – Trains between Taunton and Cardiff Central and between Weston-super-Mare and Filton Abbey Wood / Bristol Parkway will generally not run north of Bristol Temple Meads. Some trains between Taunton / Weston-super-Mare and London Paddington will not run.

㉓ **All week** – Some trains from Exeter Central or Exeter St Davids to Barnstaple will run a few minutes EARLIER as far as Crediton. Some trains between Barnstaple and Exeter Central will terminate at / start from Exeter St Davids.
