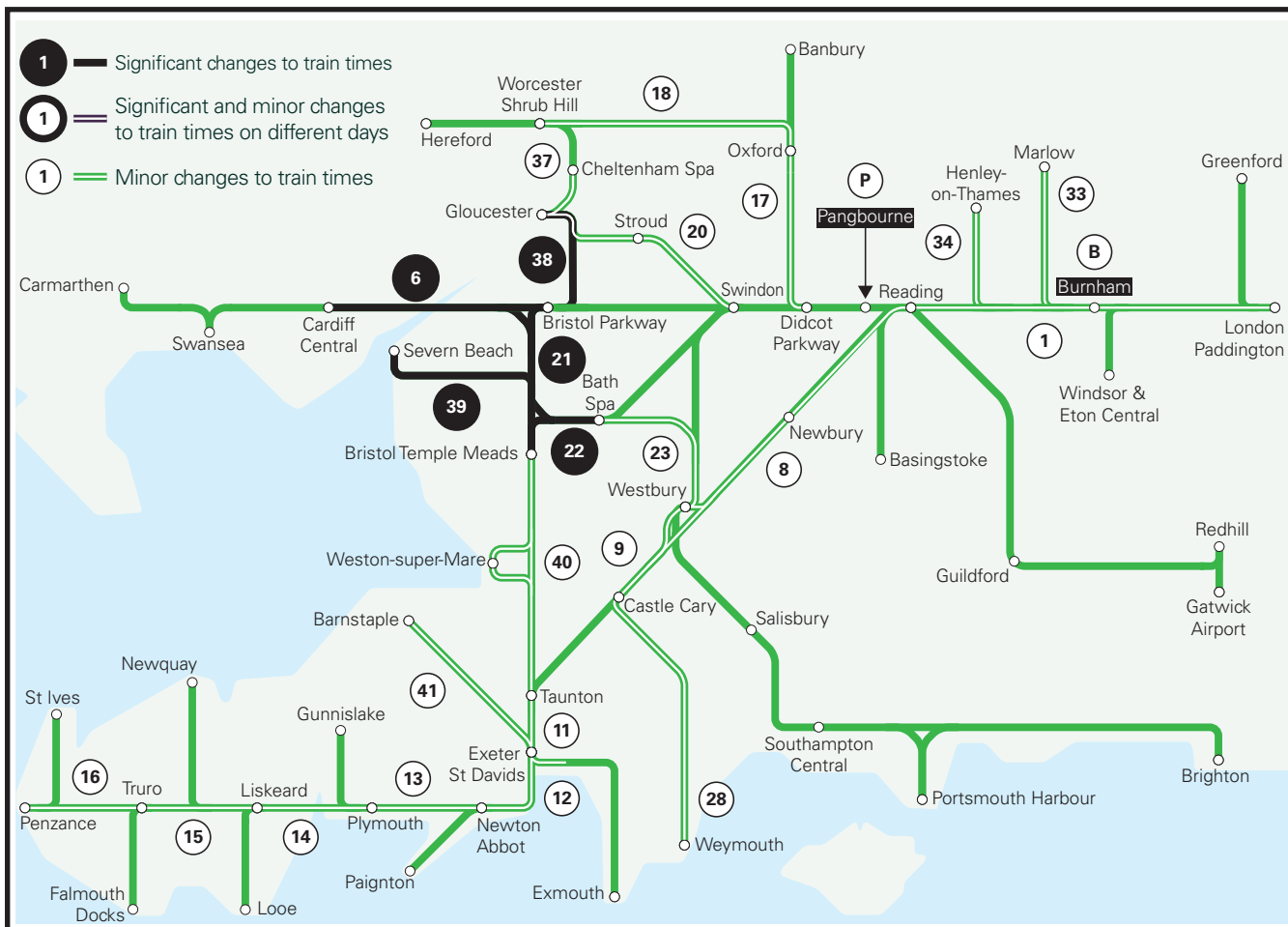


# Summary of timetable changes

① **Sunday until approximately 1300** – Some High Speed services will depart up to 8 minutes EARLIER from London Paddington. Local services from London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Ealing Broadway or Hayes & Harlington. Passengers should use alternative TfL Rail services to travel to/from these stations.

②② **All week** – Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted, not calling at Bristol Temple Meads, but calling additionally at Bristol Parkway. Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton & between Bristol Parkway / Filton Abbey Wood and Weston-super-Mare will generally not run north of Bristol Temple Meads. A reduced train service will run between Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads; some trains will run EARLIER than usual. On Monday to Friday, a special train service will run between Bristol Parkway, Filton Abbey Wood and Bristol Temple Meads, not calling at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. Replacement buses will also run every day between Bristol Parkway and Bristol Temple Meads calling at all stations.

⑧ **All week** – Minor changes between Bedwyn and Reading due to fleet availability. Passengers to / from Bedwyn, Hungerford and Kintbury will need to change trains at Newbury.

⑧ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 1930 until end of service** – Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. The 1857 Plymouth to London Paddington will be diverted, not calling at Pewsey or Newbury, but calling additionally at Swindon. Replacement buses will run between Pewsey and Swindon and from Reading to Newbury.

⑧ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2222 London Paddington to Westbury will terminate at Reading. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Bedwyn (but **not** to Westbury).

⑨ ②⑧ **Sunday** – Most trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weymouth will run between Westbury and Weymouth only. Rail connections will be available at Westbury.

⑪ to ⑩ **All week** – A few trains will be retimed between Taunton and Penzance, in some cases running EARLIER than usual.

⑰ ⑱ **Sunday** – The 2145 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will be diverted, not calling at stations from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway, but will call additionally at Swindon. A replacement bus will run from Didcot Parkway to Worcester Shrub Hill.

⑰ **Monday** – The 0500 Oxford to Didcot Parkway will not run. The 0520 Oxford to London Paddington will depart EARLIER at 0516 and call additionally at Radley.

⑳ ⑳ **Sunday from approximately 1300** – Trains from Cheltenham Spa to Swindon will run a few minutes EARLIER than usual.

⑳ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted, not calling at Kemble, Stroud or Stonehouse. A replacement bus will run, calling at these stations.

⑳ **Wednesday** – The 1134 Maidenhead to Marlow and 1200 Marlow to Maidenhead will be replaced by buses throughout.

㉑ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2146 Twyford to Henley-on-Thames and the 2201 Henley-on-Thames to Twyford will run 5 minutes later than usual. The 0018 (Tuesday to Friday) Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. A rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

㉒ **All week** – A special service will run between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa / Great Malvern. Rail and / or bus connections will be available for passengers travelling to / from stations south of Bristol Parkway.

**39** **Saturday and Monday to Friday** – A special hourly service will run between Lawrence Hill and Avonmouth / Severn Beach. Passengers travelling to / from Bristol Temple Meads should use replacement buses to / from Stapleton Road.

**Sunday** – A replacement bus service will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Severn Beach.

**40** **All week** – Trains between Taunton and Cardiff Central and between Weston-super-Mare and Filton Abbey Wood / Bristol Parkway will generally not run north of Bristol Temple Meads. Some trains between Taunton / Weston-super-Mare and London Paddington will not run.

**41** **All week** – Some trains from Exeter Central or Exeter St Davids to Barnstaple will run a few minutes EARLIER as far as Crediton. Some trains between Barnstaple and Exeter Central will terminate at / start from Exeter St Davids.

**B** **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2300 until end of service and Friday from approximately 2345 until end of service** – Trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

**P** **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2330 until 0500 next day and Friday from approximately 2355 until end of service** – Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
