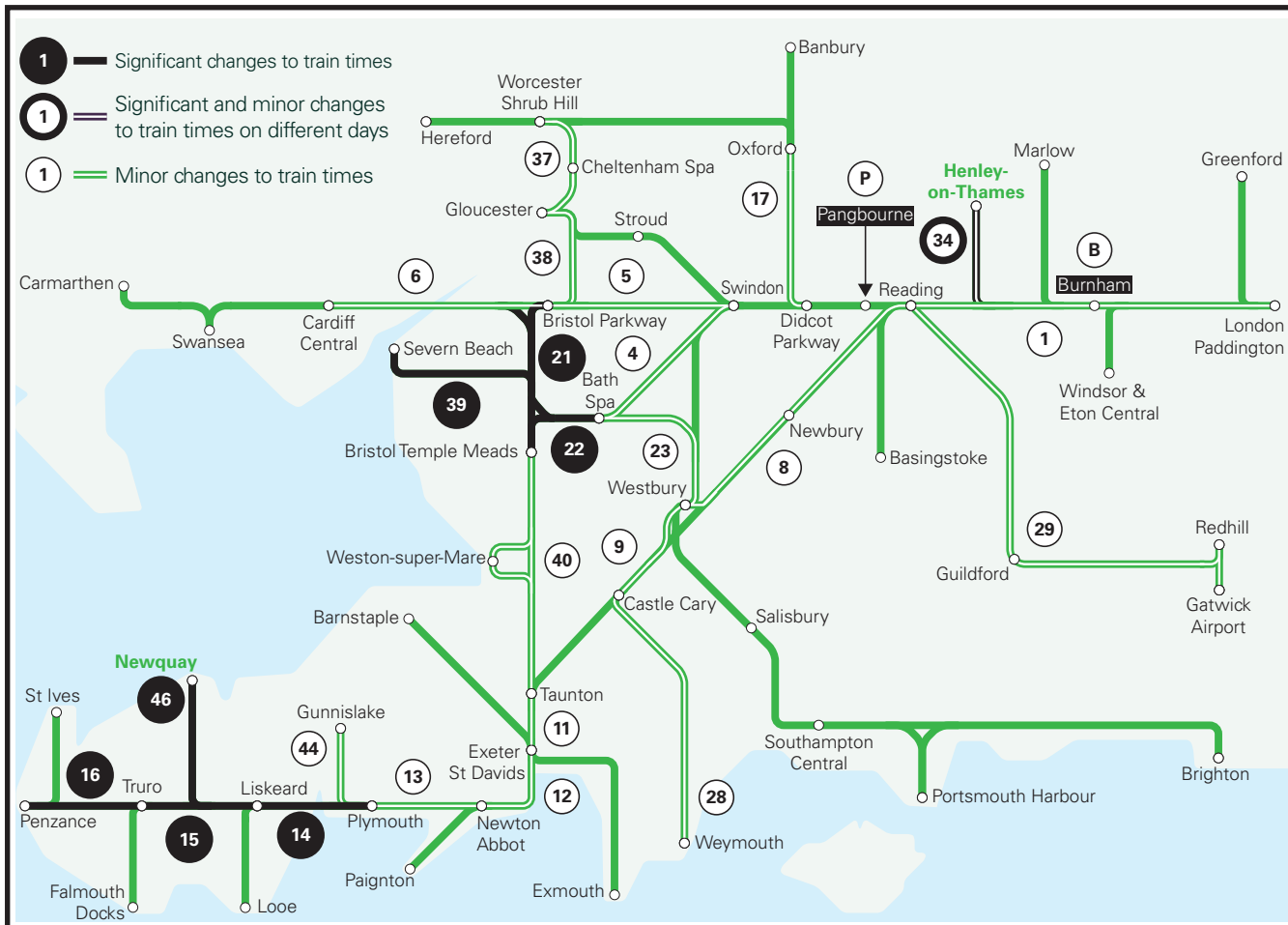


# Summary of timetable changes

- ① **Saturday** – The 2220 and 2250 London Paddington to Reading will run up to 6 minutes EARLIER than usual.
- 
- ④ ②② **All week** – Trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will either run between London Paddington and Bath Spa or will be diverted west of Swindon to run via Bristol Parkway. A revised service will run between Westbury and Bath Spa. Buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa. Trains will continue to run between Bath Spa, Filton Abbey Wood and Bristol Parkway, with some trains calling at Oldfield Park and Keynsham.

- ⑤ **Monday to Friday** – Some trains between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway will be retimed.
- 
- ⑥ ②① **All week** – Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual, and will be diverted, not calling at Bristol Temple Meads, but calling additionally at Bristol Parkway. Some trains will not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Trains between Bristol Parkway, Filton Abbey Wood and Bristol Temple Meads will run to a revised timetable.
- 
- ⑧ **All week** – Minor changes between Bedwyn and Reading due to fleet availability. Passengers to / from Bedwyn, Hungerford and Kintbury will need to change trains at Newbury.
- The 2222 (Monday to Thursday) London Paddington to Westbury will terminate at Bedwyn. The 0454 (Tuesday to Friday) Westbury to London Paddington will start from Newbury. No replacement buses will be provided.
- 
- ⑨ ②⑧ **All week** – Most Saturday and Monday to Friday trains to/from Filton Abbey Wood or further north will be diverted and will not call at Bristol Temple Meads. Some trains will run between Weymouth and either Westbury or Bath Spa only. Alternative rail services will run between Westbury and Bath Spa, with replacement buses between Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads.
- 
- ⑨ ②③ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. Replacement buses will run, calling at all stations.
- ⑨ ②③ **Friday** – The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will start from Bristol Parkway. A replacement bus will run from Bristol Temple Meads, calling at all stations to Westbury.
- 
- ⑪ to ⑬ **Monday: Boardmasters Festival at Newquay** – Due to the amended service running to and from Newquay, some trains between London Paddington / Plymouth and Penzance will not run for their whole journey, or will have different stopping patterns from usual.
- ⑭ to ⑯ The first direct train from London Paddington to stations west of Plymouth will be at 1204. There will be no direct trains from Penzance to London Paddington between 0910 and 1745. Please check before travelling.
- 
- ⑬ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2104 & 2202 London Paddington to Plymouth and 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive at Plymouth up to 20 minutes later than usual.
- 
- ⑰ **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2345 each evening until 0415 next day** – Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. The 0354 (Tuesday to Thursday) Oxford to Reading will depart from Oxford EARLIER at 0334.
- 
- ⑳ **Saturday and Sunday: Henley Regatta** – A special, enhanced, service will run between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames.
- ㉑ On Saturday, Wargrave will only be served by an hourly replacement bus service to and from Twyford.
- ㉒ On Sunday, trains towards Twyford will not call at Shiplake. Passengers travelling from Henley-on-Thames to Shiplake should travel via Twyford. Passengers travelling from Shiplake to Wargrave or Twyford should use northbound services and travel via Henley-on-Thames.
- 
- ㉓ **Tuesday to Thursday** – The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. A rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

- 37 38** **Saturday and Monday to Friday** – Most trains normally running to / from Westbury or beyond will continue to do so, but will not call at Bristol Temple Meads. Alternative rail connections will be available between Bristol Parkway, Filton Abbey Wood and Bristol Temple Meads.
- 
- 39** **Saturday and Monday to Friday** – A special hourly service will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Avonmouth / Severn Beach.  
**Sunday** – A few trains will run EARLIER than usual.
- 
- 40** **All Week** – Some trains will be subject to minor retimings and some additional services will run.
- 
- 44** **Monday** – The 0457 Plymouth to Gunnislake and 0542 Gunnislake to Plymouth will be replaced by buses.
- 
- 46** **Monday: Boardmasters Festival at Newquay** – A special service will run to and from Newquay, with most trains from Newquay extended beyond Par to Plymouth and London Paddington. Intermediate stations between Par and Newquay will be served by replacement buses for most of the day.
- 
- Saturday** – The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Taplow or Burnham. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
- B** **Sunday from approximately 2345 until end of service** – Trains will not call at Burnham. Buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
- Monday to Friday from approximately 2345 until end of service each evening** – Trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
- 
- P** **Saturday from approximately 2300 to Sunday until approximately 0915 and Sunday from approximately 2300 until end of service** – Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
- Friday** – The 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
