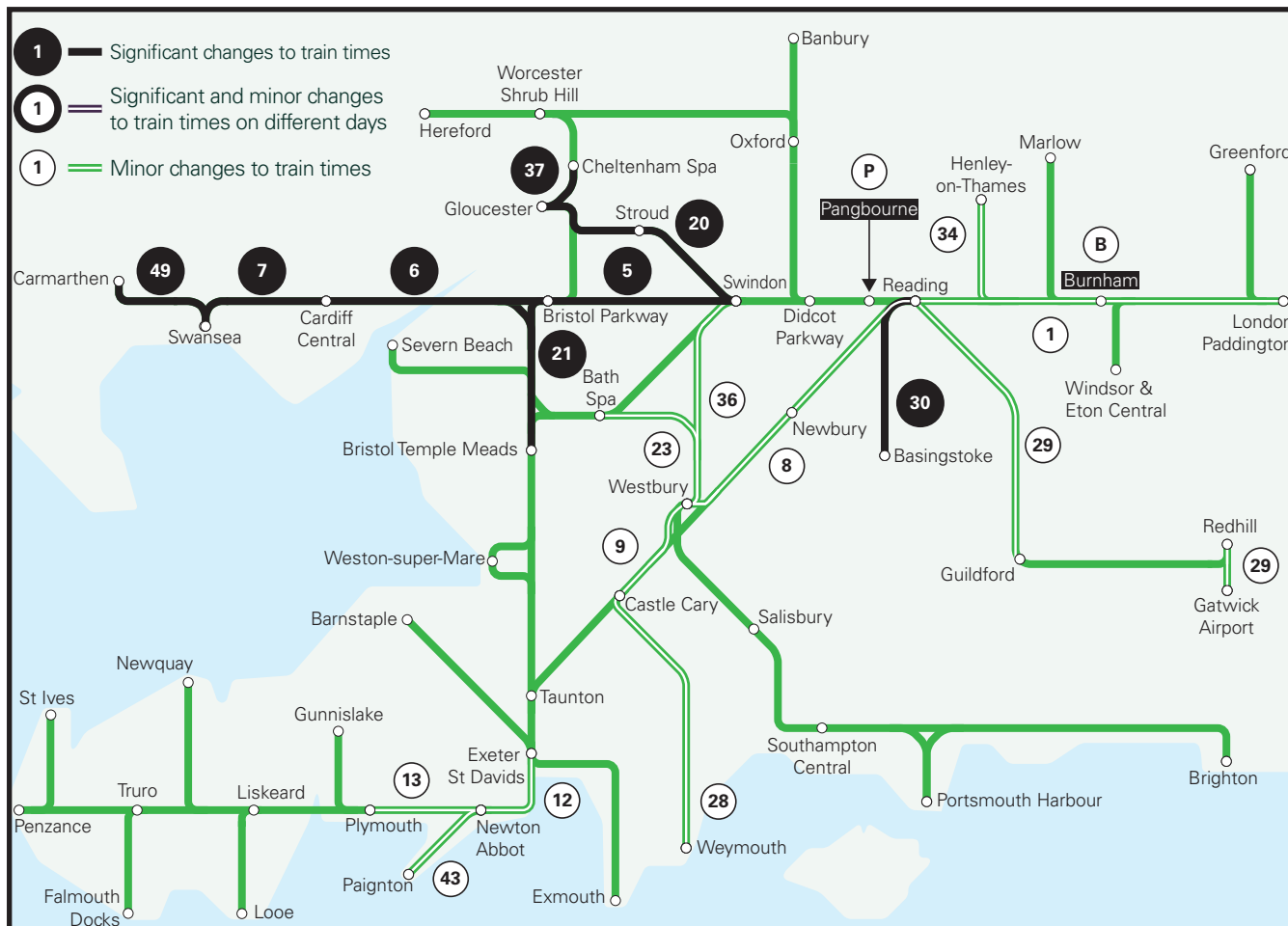


Summary of timetable changes

① **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service** – Most High Speed services from London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later at Reading and at stations beyond. Most High Speed services to London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Some local trains will also be retimed by a few minutes. The 2008 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Reading.

⑤ ⑥ **All weekend** – Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. Journey times will be extended **On Saturday only**, most trains towards South Wales will depart EARLIER than usual from London Paddington, Reading and Swindon and most trains towards London will depart EARLIER than usual from stations in South Wales.

⑦ ④⑨ Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Passengers should use connecting rail services via Bristol Temple Meads to travel between Swindon and Bristol Parkway.

On Sunday only, most GWR trains to / from Carmarthen will not run between Swansea and Carmarthen. Passengers should use alternative Transport for Wales services. GWR tickets will be valid.

⑥ ②① **All weekend** – Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted to run from / to Bristol Parkway. Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton will not run north of Bristol Temple Meads. A few trains will not run at all. Replacement buses will run between Newport, Severn Tunnel Junction, Patchway and Bristol Parkway. On Saturday only, Pilning will be served by buses to / from Bristol Parkway.

⑧ **All week** – Minor changes between Bedwyn and Reading due to fleet availability. Passengers to / from Bedwyn, Hungerford and Kintbury will need to change trains at Newbury.

⑨ ②③ ②⑧ ③⑥ **Sunday** – The 0844 Westbury to Bath Spa and 0917 Bath Spa to Westbury will not run. Replacement buses will run EARLIER than the trains. The 0907 Westbury to Weymouth will run a few minutes later than usual. The 0848 Westbury to Swindon will run up to 30 minutes later than usual and terminate at Chippenham. The 0940 Swindon to Weymouth will start from Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will run between Chippenham and Swindon, in some cases, EARLIER than the trains.

(The 1103 Weymouth to Swindon and 1341 Swindon to Weymouth, both previously advised to be altered as a result of this work, will both now run normally).

⑨ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.

Saturday – The 2004 London Paddington to Plymouth will run up to 12 minutes later from Exeter St Davids to Plymouth.

⑫ ⑬ **Sunday** – The 0826 (departing 0829) & 0915 Exeter St Davids to Plymouth and 0845 Exeter St Davids to Paignton will run up to 10 minutes later than usual.

④③ **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2345 until 0500 next day** – A few late evening trains will be subject to minor retimings. The 0458 (Tuesday & Wednesday) Exeter St Davids to Paignton will depart at 0504 and run later throughout.

⑳ **Sunday** – All day, trains between Swindon and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa will run to a revised timetable.

- 29** **Saturday** – The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Redhill. A replacement bus will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.
Sunday – The 0611 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill at 0641. An alternative rail connection will be available from Gatwick Airport at 0628.
Sunday – All day, some trains will be slightly retimed between Reading and Guildford, in some cases, EARLIER than usual.

- 30** **Sunday** – All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Journey times will be extended.

- 34** **Tuesday to Friday** – The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will run from Twyford to Reading.
-
- B** **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2330 until 0530 next day and Friday from approximately 2345 until end of service** – Trains will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

- P** **Friday** – The 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
