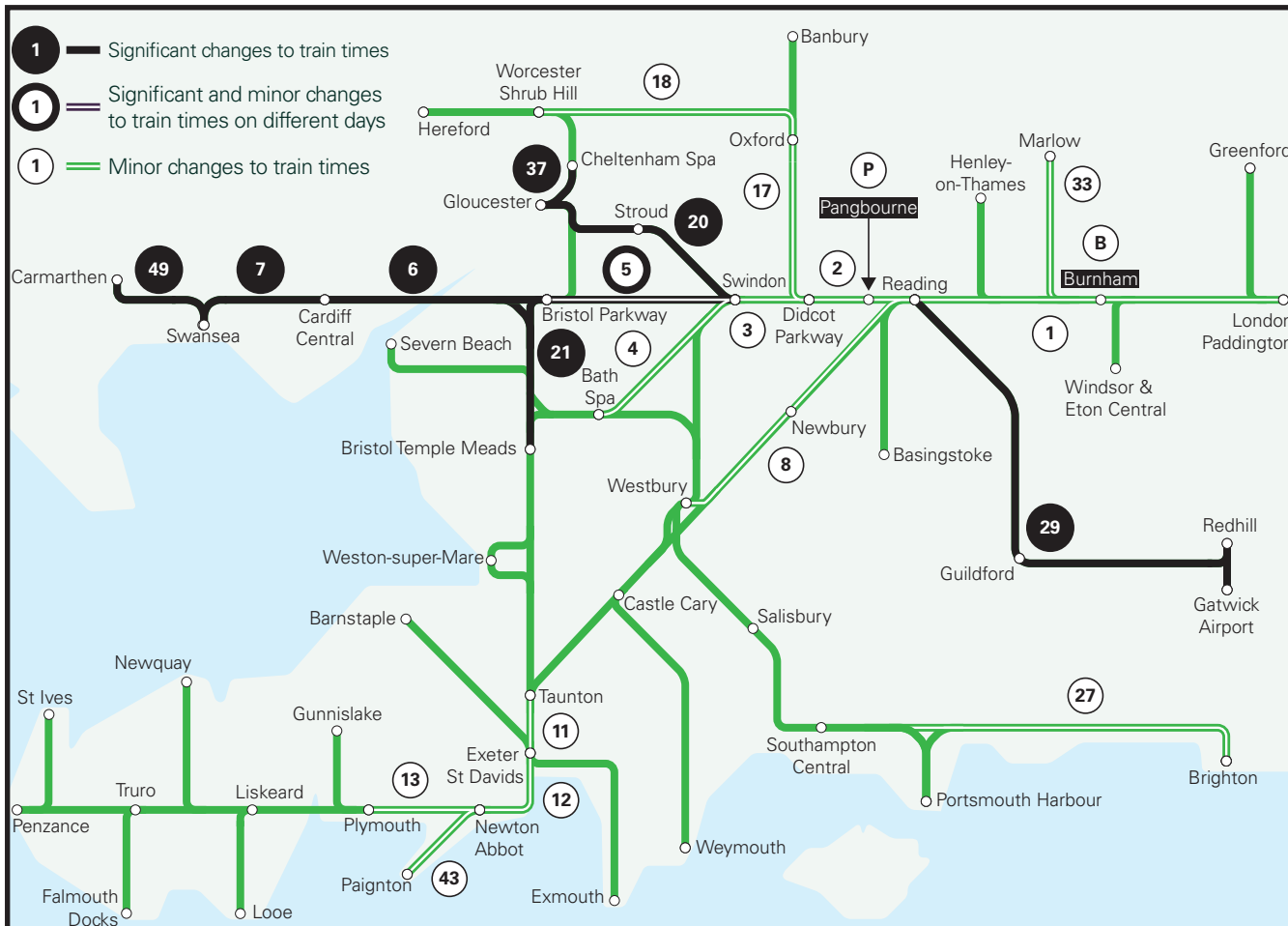


Summary of timetable changes

- ① **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service** – Most High Speed services from London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later at Reading and at stations beyond. Most High Speed services to London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Some local trains will also be retimed by a few minutes.
The 2008 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Reading.

- ② ⑤ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service** – The 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. Journey times will be extended. The 2318 London Paddington to Oxford will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will divert after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run to maintain intermediate journeys.

⑦ ④⑨ **All weekend** – Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. **On Saturday only**, most trains towards South Wales will depart EARLIER than usual from London Paddington, Reading and Swindon. Most trains towards London will depart EARLIER than usual from stations in South Wales. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Passengers should use connecting rail services via Bristol Temple Meads to travel between Swindon and Bristol Parkway.
On Sunday only, most GWR trains to / from Carmarthen will not run between Swansea and Carmarthen. Passengers should use alternative Transport for Wales services. GWR tickets will be valid.

- ⑥ ②① **All weekend** – Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted to run from / to Bristol Parkway. Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton will not run north of Bristol Temple Meads. A few trains will not run at all. Replacement buses will run between Newport, Severn Tunnel Junction, Patchway and Bristol Parkway.
On Saturday only, Pilning will be served by buses to / from Bristol Parkway.

- ⑧ **All week** – An amended timetable is in place. In some cases, passengers to / from Bedwyn, Hungerford and Kintbury will need to change trains at Newbury.

- ⑪ ⑫ **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2345 until end of service** – Trains from Newton Abbot to Exeter St Davids and Taunton will be retimed later than usual.

④③ **Saturday** – The 2004 London Paddington to Plymouth will run up to 12 minutes later from Exeter St Davids to Plymouth.
Sunday – The 0826 & 0915 Exeter St Davids to Plymouth and 0845 Exeter St Davids to Paignton will run up to 10 minutes later than usual.

Monday to Thursday – The 2150 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, then be diverted to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. A rail connection will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford (Monday to Wednesday) or Moreton-in-Marsh (Thursday) then a replacement bus will run from Oxford (Monday to Wednesday) or Moreton-in-Marsh (Thursday) to Worcester Shrub Hill.

- ⑰ ⑱ The 2250 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will terminate at Oxford (Monday to Wednesday) or Moreton-in-Marsh (Thursday). A replacement bus will run from Oxford (Monday to Wednesday) or Moreton-in-Marsh (Thursday) to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill. A non-stop bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, for a connecting train service to London Paddington. A separate bus, calling at booked intermediate stations, will also run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford. There will be no onward connection beyond Oxford out of this bus.

On Thursday only, the 2345 Didcot Parkway to Oxford will not run. Passengers should travel on an earlier or later service instead.

- ⑳ ㉓ **Sunday** – All day, trains between Swindon, Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa will run to an amended timetable.

- ㉔ **Sunday** – GWR services to / from Brighton will be diverted to run to / from Portsmouth Harbour instead. Passengers should change trains en-route, using other operators' services to complete their journey if travelling to / from stations to Brighton. GWR tickets will be valid.

Saturday – All day, a special hourly service will run between Blackwater and Gatwick Airport.

Sunday – All day, a special hourly service will run between Blackwater and Redhill.

- ㉙ **On both days**, replacement buses will run between Reading and North Camp. With the exception of the final bus departure from Reading (which will only run to Blackwater), passengers should interchange between buses and trains at North Camp. Passengers travelling between Reading and Wokingham should use alternative trains provided by South Western Railway. GWR tickets will be valid.

On Sunday, passengers travelling to / from Gatwick Airport should use alternative trains provided by Southern or Thameslink. GWR tickets will be valid.

- ㉛ **Sunday** – The 0929 Maidenhead to Marlow and 0955 Marlow to Maidenhead will run 4 minutes later throughout.

- ㉜ **Monday to Thursday** – The 2057 Maidenhead to Bourne End, 2112 Bourne End to Marlow and 2112 Bourne End to Maidenhead will run up to 2 minutes later than usual.

- Ⓑ **Saturday** – The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Taplow or Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Sunday from approximately 2345 until end of service – Trains will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

- Ⓟ **Saturday from approximately 2300 until end of service, Sunday until approximately 0915 and from approximately 2300 until end of service** – Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
