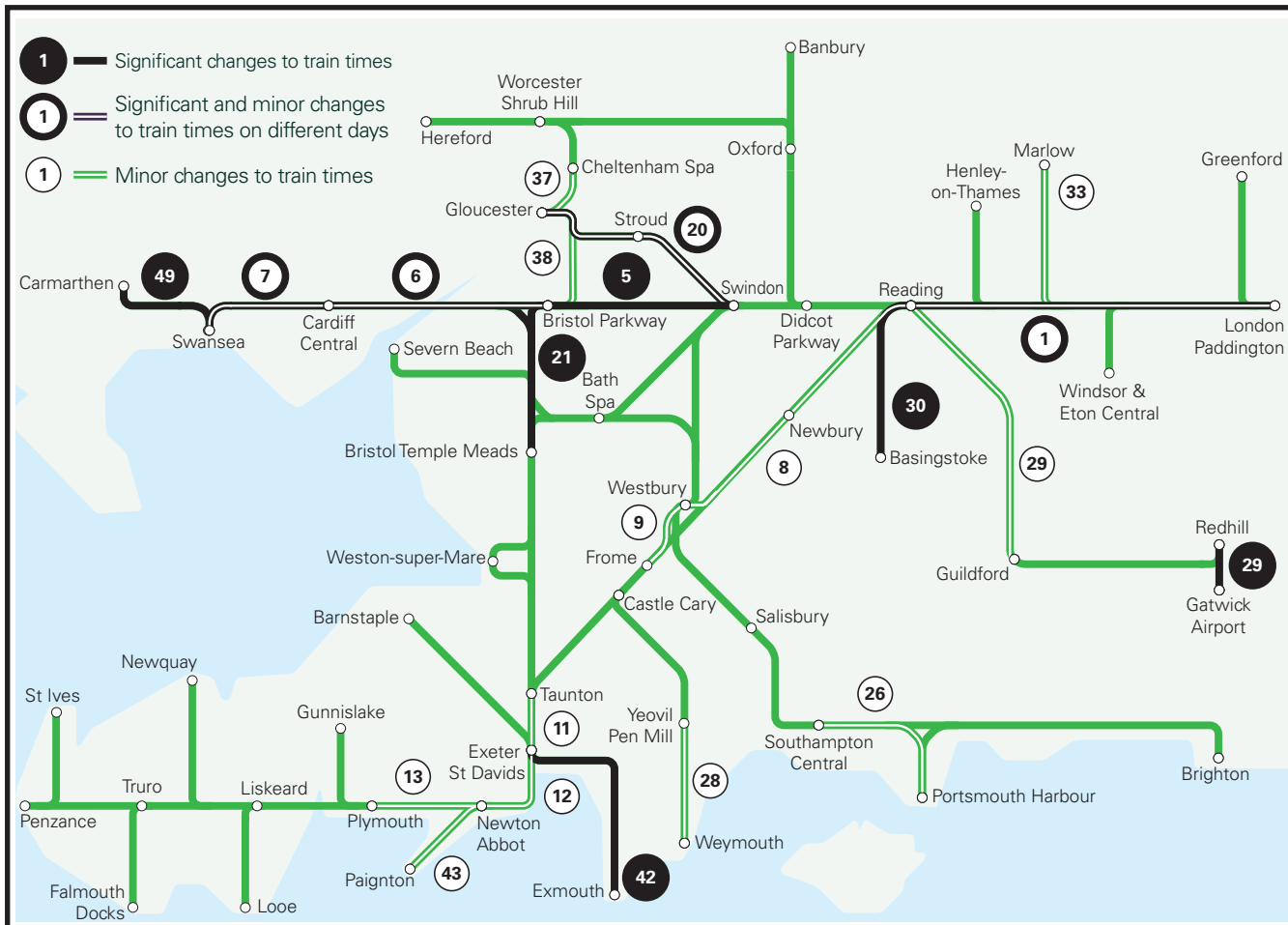


Summary of timetable changes

Sunday – High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be amended. Many trains FROM London Paddington will depart slightly later than advertised, but a few trains will depart slightly EARLIER. Most trains TO London Paddington will arrive slightly earlier than advertised. Local stopping services FROM London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Ealing Broadway or Hayes & Harlington. Passengers should use alternative TfL Rail services on which GWR tickets will be valid.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service – Most High Speed services from London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later at Reading and at stations beyond. Most High Speed services to London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Some local trains will also be retimed by a few minutes. The 2008 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Reading.

Sunday – Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Passengers should use connecting rail services via Bristol Temple Meads to travel between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. Most GWR trains to / from Carmarthen will not run between Swansea and Carmarthen. Passengers should use alternative Transport for Wales services. GWR tickets will be valid.

Sunday – Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted to run from / to Bristol Parkway. Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton will not run north of Bristol Temple Meads. A few trains will not run at all. Replacement buses will run between Newport, Severn Tunnel Junction, Patchway and Bristol Parkway.

Monday to Thursday – The 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.

All week – An amended timetable is in place. In some cases, passengers to / from Bedwyn, Hungerford and Kintbury will need to change trains at Newbury.

Saturday – The 2328 Bath Spa to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.

Thursday from approximately 2300 until end of service – Trains between Taunton and Exeter St Davids will have their journey times extended by up to 25 minutes.

Saturday – The 2004 London Paddington to Plymouth will run later from Exeter St Davids to Plymouth.

Sunday – The 0826 & 0915 Exeter St Davids to Plymouth and 0845 Exeter St Davids to Paignton will be retimed later for all or part of their journey.

Sunday – All day, trains between Swindon, Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa will run to an amended timetable.

Monday to Thursday – The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will run non-stop from Swindon to terminate at Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, calling at all intermediate stations.

Saturday – The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Westbury will not call at Eastleigh or Southampton Airport Parkway. Passengers for these stations should use alternative SWR services.

28

Monday – The 2030 Bristol Parkway to Weymouth will terminate at Yeovil Pen Mill. Two replacement buses will run from Yeovil Pen Mill to Weymouth. One will call at Dorchester West only, the other will call at all stations. Journey times will be extended.

- 29** **All weekend** – Most GWR services to / from Gatwick Airport will not run between Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Alternative rail connections, provided by Southern or Thameslink will be available, on which GWR tickets will be valid. Passengers will need to travel EARLIER from Gatwick Airport to connect into GWR services at Redhill.

- 29** **Sunday** – Some trains from Redhill to Reading will be retimed later between Guildford and Reading.
Friday – The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Redhill. An alternative rail connection will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which GWR tickets will be valid.

- 30** **Sunday** – All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Journey times will be extended.
-
- 33** **Monday to Thursday** – The 2057 Maidenhead to Bourne End, 2112 Bourne End to Marlow and 2112 Bourne End to Maidenhead will run up to 2 minutes later than usual.
-
- 38** **Monday to Thursday** – The 2237 Worcester Shrub Hill to Bristol Temple Meads will terminate at Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Gloucester to Bristol Temple Meads. Journey times will be extended.

- 42** **All weekend** – Buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids, Exeter Central and Exmouth. Journey times will be extended.
