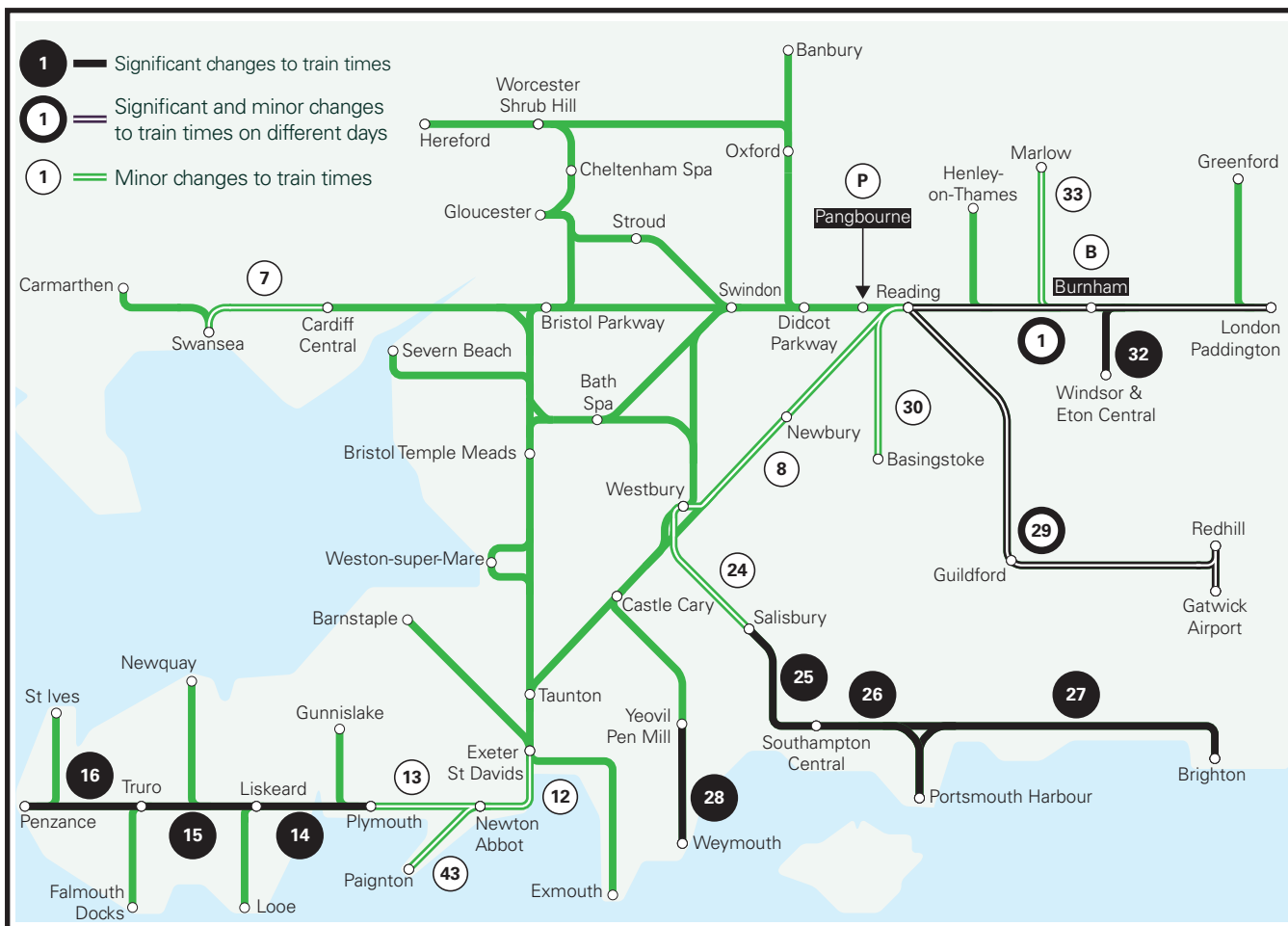


Summary of timetable changes

Sunday – High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be amended. Many trains FROM London Paddington will depart slightly later than advertised, but a few trains will depart slightly EARLIER. Most trains TO London Paddington will arrive slightly earlier than advertised. Most local stopping services FROM London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Ealing Broadway or Hayes & Harlington. Passengers should use alternative TfL Rail services on which GWR tickets will be valid.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service – Most High Speed services from London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later at Reading and at stations beyond. Most High Speed services to London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Some local trains will also be retimed by a few minutes. The 2008 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Reading.

Monday to Thursday – The 2048, 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will divert after Cardiff Central and arrive up to 25 minutes later at Bridgend and stations to Swansea.

All week – An amended timetable is in place. In some cases, passengers to / from Bedwyn, Hungerford and Kintbury will need to change trains at Newbury.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service – Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. Journey times will be extended.

Saturday – The 2004 London Paddington to Plymouth will run later from Exeter St Davids to Plymouth.

Sunday – The 0826 & 0915 Exeter St Davids to Plymouth and 0845 Exeter St Davids to Paignton will be retimed later for all or part of their journey.

Saturday – The 1304 & 1704 London Paddington to Penzance will terminate at Plymouth. Passengers travel forward from Plymouth on the next available service.

Sunday – All day, buses will replace trains between Plymouth or Liskeard and Par or St Austell. A reduced rail service will run between Plymouth and Liskeard and between St Austell and Penzance. Journey times will be extended.

Monday – The 0605 & 0910 Penzance to London Paddington will start from Plymouth. Alternative rail connections, departing EARLIER than usual, will run from Penzance to Plymouth.

Friday – The 1904 London Paddington to Penzance will terminate at Plymouth. A rail connection will run from Plymouth to Penzance. The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will terminate at Plymouth. A replacement bus will run from Plymouth to Liskeard, connecting into an alternative rail service from Liskeard to Penzance.

All weekend – Trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central, but calling additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Replacement buses will run between Eastleigh and Southampton Central. A few trains will not run for the whole of their journey and GWR services to / from Brighton will not run at all. Passengers should use other operators' services to complete their journey if travelling to / from Havant and stations to Brighton.

- 28** **Wednesday** – The 2030 Bristol Parkway to Weymouth will terminate at Yeovil Pen Mill. A replacement bus will run from Yeovil Pen Mill to Weymouth.
- Thursday and Friday** – Buses will replace trains between Yeovil Pen Mill and Weymouth. Journey times will be extended.
-
- 29** **Sunday** – All day, a special hourly service will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Guildford.
- Monday to Thursday** – The 2320 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.

- 29** **Tuesday to Friday** – The 0431 Reading to Gatwick Airport & 0457 Reading to Redhill will start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Reading to Guildford. The 0530 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart slightly earlier and will call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North and Ash.

- 30** **Sunday** – The 0738 Reading to Basingstoke and 0807 Basingstoke to Reading will be replaced by buses running EARLIER than usual. Journey times will be extended.
-
- 32** **Sunday** – Trains between Slough and Windsor & Eton Central will not run. Replacement buses will run half-hourly between Slough and Windsor & Eton Riverside, taking 20 minutes.
-
- 33** **Sunday** – The 0929 Maidenhead to Marlow and 0955 Marlow to Maidenhead will run 3 minutes later than usual.
- Monday to Thursday** – The 2057 Maidenhead to Bourne End, 2112 Bourne End to Marlow and 2112 Bourne End to Maidenhead will run up to 2 minutes later than usual.

- B** **Saturday** – The 0034 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
-
- P** **Sunday until approximately 1145** – Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
