


## Summary of timetable changes

## Saturday 27 November to Friday 3 December 2021

- From approximately 2100 Saturday and all day Sunday High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be amended.

  Many trains FROM London Paddington will depart slightly later than advertised, but a few trains will depart slightly EARLIER. Most trains TO London Paddington will arrive slightly earlier than advertised. On Sunday, most local stopping services between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway will run between Slough and Didcot Parkway only and some will be retimed.
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service Most High Speed services from London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later at Reading and at stations beyond. Most High Speed services to London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Some local trains will also be retimed by a few minutes. The 2008 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Reading.
- Monday to Thursday The 2248 (Monday, Tuesday and Thursday only) London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon (2) to (7) and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea. The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Replacement buses will run to maintain intermediate journeys.
- **Sunday** The 0753 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea to Cardiff Central to connect with the train.
- 8 All week An amended timetable is in place. In some cases, passengers to / from Bedwyn, Hungerford and Kintbury will need to change trains at Newbury.
- 9 Saturday The 2328 Bath Spa to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.
- Saturday The 2004 London Paddington to Plymouth will run later from Exeter St Davids to Plymouth.

  Sunday The 0826 & 0915 Exeter St Davids to Plymouth and 0845 Exeter St Davids to Paignton will be retimed later for all or part of
  - Sunday The 0826 & 0915 Exeter St Davids to Plymouth and 0845 Exeter St Davids to Paignton will be retimed later for all or part of their journey.
- Monday and Tuesday The 2150 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway to set down only (for a rail connection to Oxford) and then run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2250 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will terminate at Oxford. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill and restart from Oxford. Replacement buses will run between Oxford and Worcester in place of diverted trains. Journey times will be extended.
- Sunday All day, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be replaced by buses between Salisbury and Southampton Central. Romsey will only be served by replacement buses provided by South Western Railway. Some trains will not run for the whole of their journey and GWR trains to / from Brighton will not run at all.
- Monday to Thursday The 2121 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will be diverted after Southampton Central and will run later from Fareham to Portsmouth & Southsea.
- All week Buses will replace trains between Yeovil Pen Mill and Weymouth. Journey times will be extended. In most cases, passengers travelling northbound from Weymouth and intermediate stations will need to travel EARLIER to maintain connections into trains at Yeovil Pen Mill.

## Saturday 27 November to Friday 3 December 2021

- **Sunday** Some trains from Redhill to Reading will be retimed later between Guildford and Reading.
- 30 Sunday All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Journey times will be extended.
- **Sunday** All day, buses will replace trains between Swansea and Carmarthen. Journey times will be extended. **Saturday** The 0034 & 2328 London Paddington to Reading, 0018 Reading to London Paddington and 2345 Didcot Parkway to
- London Paddington will not call at Burnham and Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
