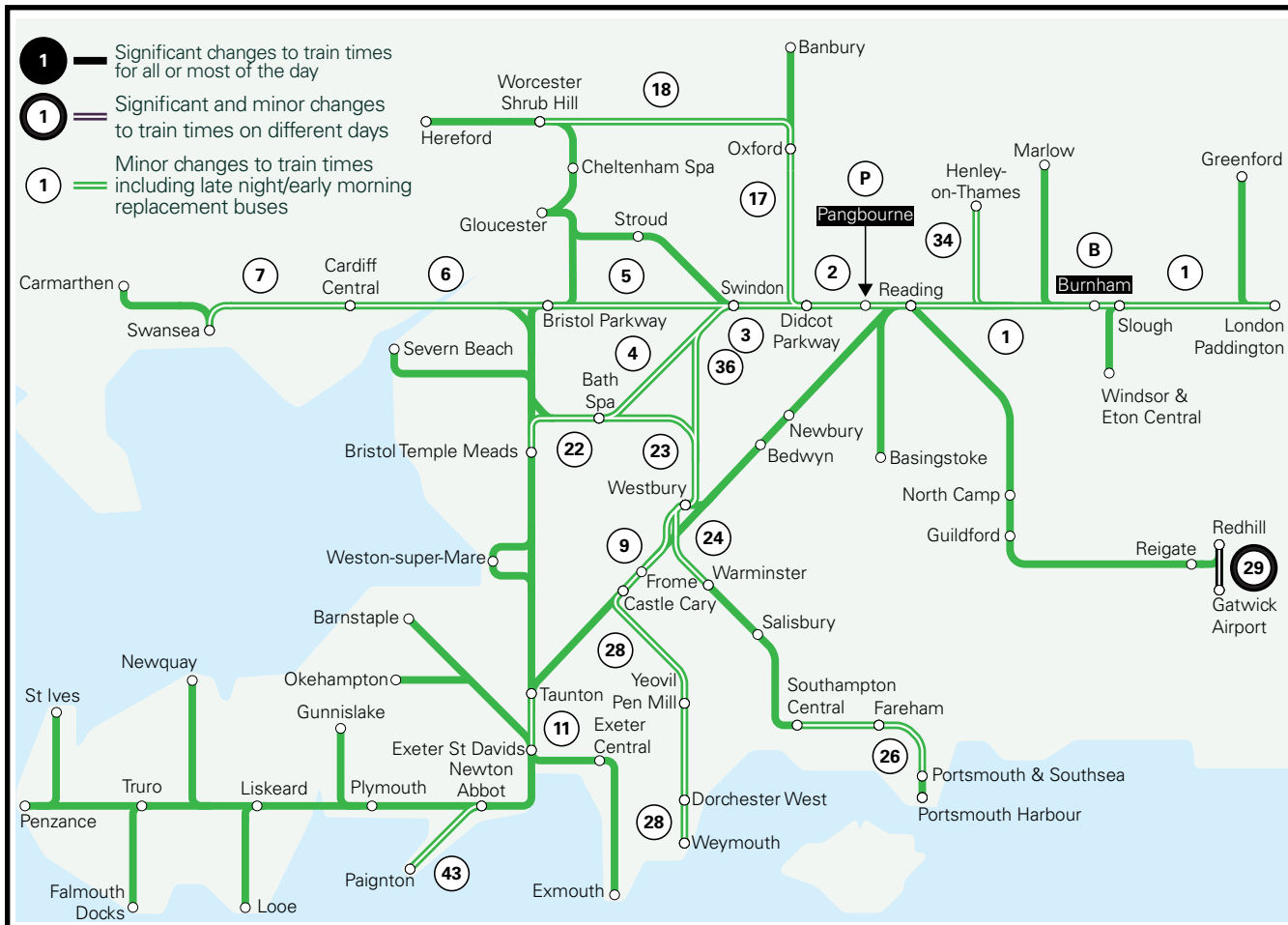


# Summary of timetable changes

- ① **Tuesday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service** - Most trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings. The 2025 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will start from Reading.
- 
- ② ③ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will run non-stop from Reading to Bath Spa. The 2318 London Paddington to Oxford will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. Buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham, from Didcot Parkway to Swindon and from Swindon to Chippenham, Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads.

- ⑤ ⑥ **Monday, Tuesday and Thursday** - The 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.
- ⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2048, 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.
- 
- ⑧ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0341 Swansea to London Paddington will depart later from Bridgend and arrive later at Cardiff Central.
- 
- ⑨ **Saturday** - The 2311 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A bus will run from Westbury to Frome.
- 
- ⑩ ④⑩ **Sunday** - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive Exeter St Davids approximately 20 minutes later than usual. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart Exeter St Davids slightly EARLIER than usual.

- ⑨ ②③ **Sunday until approximately 1100** - Trains through Westbury will be revised. Some trains will not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Some trains will be replaced by buses.

- ②⑧ **Sunday** - The first train in each direction to and from Weymouth will run later than usual.
- 
- ②⑤ ②⑥ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2121 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will divert after Southampton Central to call additionally at Southampton Airport Parkway and Eastleigh, and will run later from Fareham to Portsmouth & Southsea.
- 
- ②⑨ **Saturday** - The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Redhill. A bus will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.
- Sunday** - All day, trains between Reading and Gatwick Airport will run between Reading and Redhill only. Alternative rail connections, operated by Southern and Thameslink, will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Generally, passengers will need to travel EARLIER from Gatwick Airport to maintain connections at Redhill.
- Monday** - The 0445 Redhill to Gatwick Airport will be replaced by a bus, running EARLIER than usual. The 0510 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. A bus, departing EARLIER than usual, will run from Gatwick Airport.

- ③④ **Tuesday to Thursday** - The 2146 & 2216 Twyford to Henley-on-Thames and 2201 & 2231 Henley-on-Thames to Twyford will run 1 minute later than usual.
- 
- ④③ **Monday, Wednesday and Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service** - Trains will not run between Newton Abbot and Paignton. Passengers should use alternative bus services, operated by Stagecoach, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.
- The last train in each direction between Newton Abbot and Paignton will depart at 2117 from Newton Abbot and at 2139 from Paignton.** Passengers will need to travel EARLIER from Paignton, Torquay and Torre to maintain connections into trains at Newton Abbot.
- 
- ⑧ **Saturday** - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
- 
- ⑨ **Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
