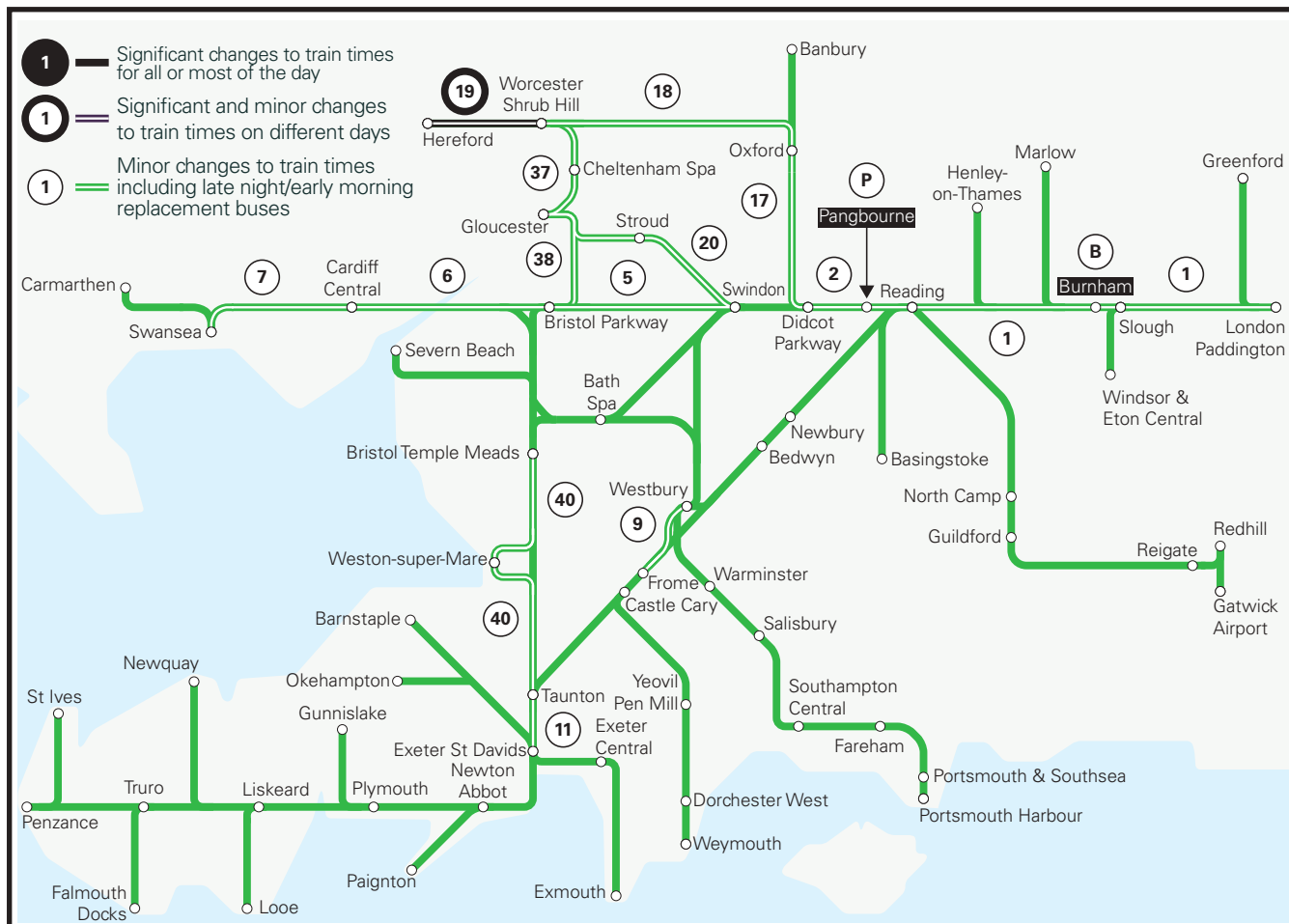


Summary of timetable changes

- ② ⑰ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2345 until approximately 0500 next day** - The 2318 (**Monday to Thursday**) & 0032 (**Tuesday to Friday**) London Paddington to Oxford will arrive slightly later at Oxford. The 0354 (**Tuesday to Friday**) Oxford to Reading will run up to 20 minutes EARLIER from Oxford to Didcot Parkway. Buses will replace other local trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.

- ⑥ ⑦ **Sunday** - The 2043 & 2143 London Paddington to Swansea will divert between Cardiff Central and Bridgend and will run up to 25 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.
Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will divert between Cardiff Central and Bridgend and will run up to 25 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.

- ⑥ ⑳ **Saturday** - The 2200 & 2247 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will be replaced by buses. The 1823 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central and 1837 Plymouth to Cardiff Central will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. Alternative rail connections will be available from Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central. The 2023 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. A bus will run from Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central.
Sunday - The 0858 Bristol Parkway to Cardiff Central will be replaced by an EARLIER bus from Bristol Parkway to Newport, with a rail connection from Newport to Cardiff Central.

- ⑪ ④⑩ **Sunday** - The 0759 Exeter St Davids to Bristol Temple Meads will depart at 0814 and run later throughout.
The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive Exeter St Davids approximately 20 minutes later than usual.
The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart Exeter St Davids slightly EARLIER than usual.

- ⑳ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
-
- Saturday and Sunday** - The 2345 (**Saturday**) Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Taplow or Burnham.
The 0033 (**Sunday**) London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
- Ⓑ **Sunday until approximately 0800 and from 2345 until end of service** - Trains will not call at Burnham. Buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
Monday to Thursday from approximately 2315 until end of service - Trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

- Ⓟ **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2330 until 0500 next day** - Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
Friday - The 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
