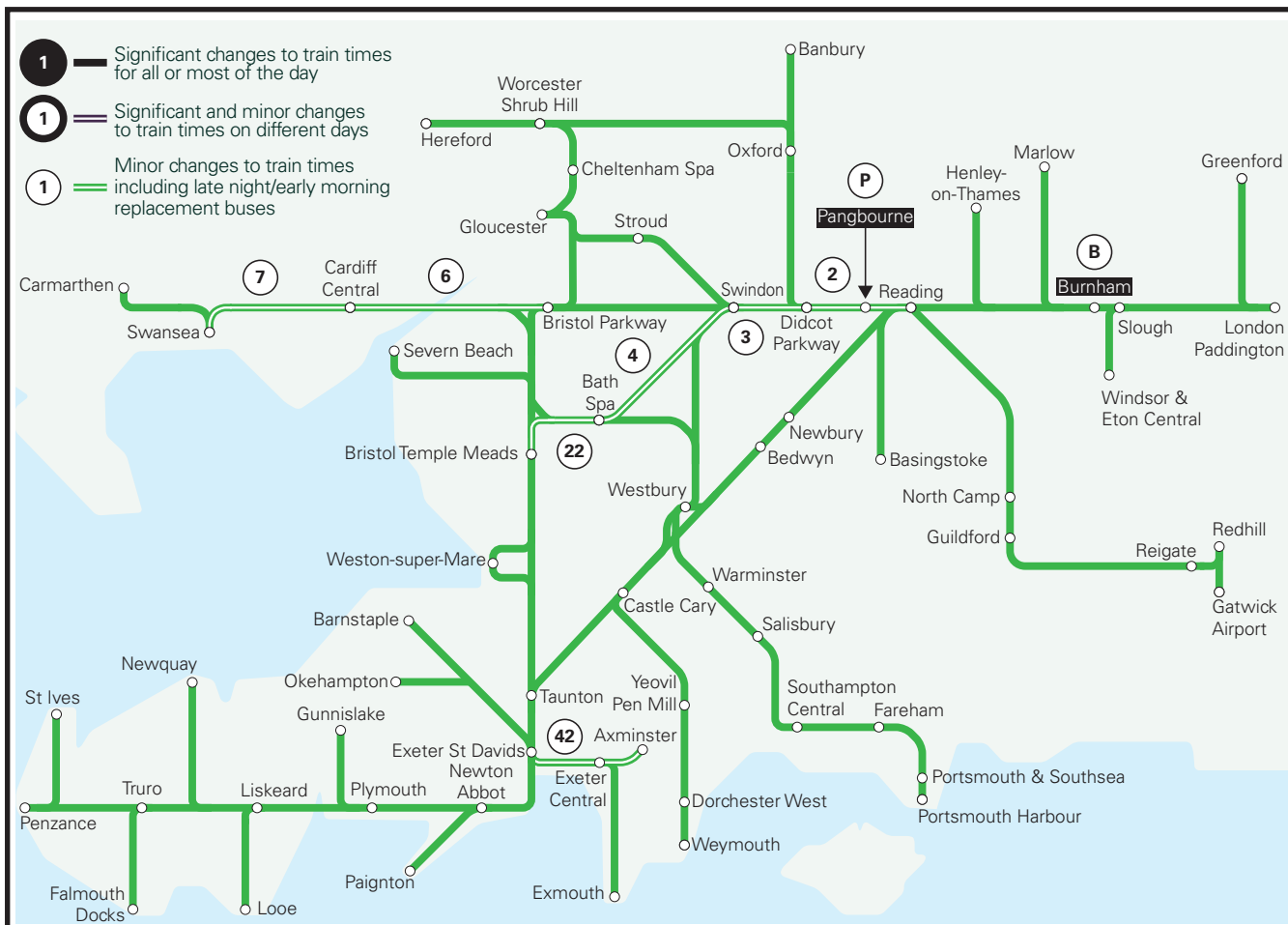

② ③ **Tuesday to Thursday from approximately 2200 until end of service each evening** - Trains running between London Paddington, Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads will be amended. Some services will be replaced with buses between Swindon, Chippenham, Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads.

⑥ ⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2048, 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will run slightly later after Cardiff Central.

④② **Monday to Friday** - The 1631 Barnstaple to Axminster will terminate at Exeter Central. Change at Exeter Central for a replacement bus, provided by SWR, to Axminster, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

Ⓑ **Saturday** - The 0034 (departing 0040) London Paddington to Reading and the 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Ⓟ **Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
