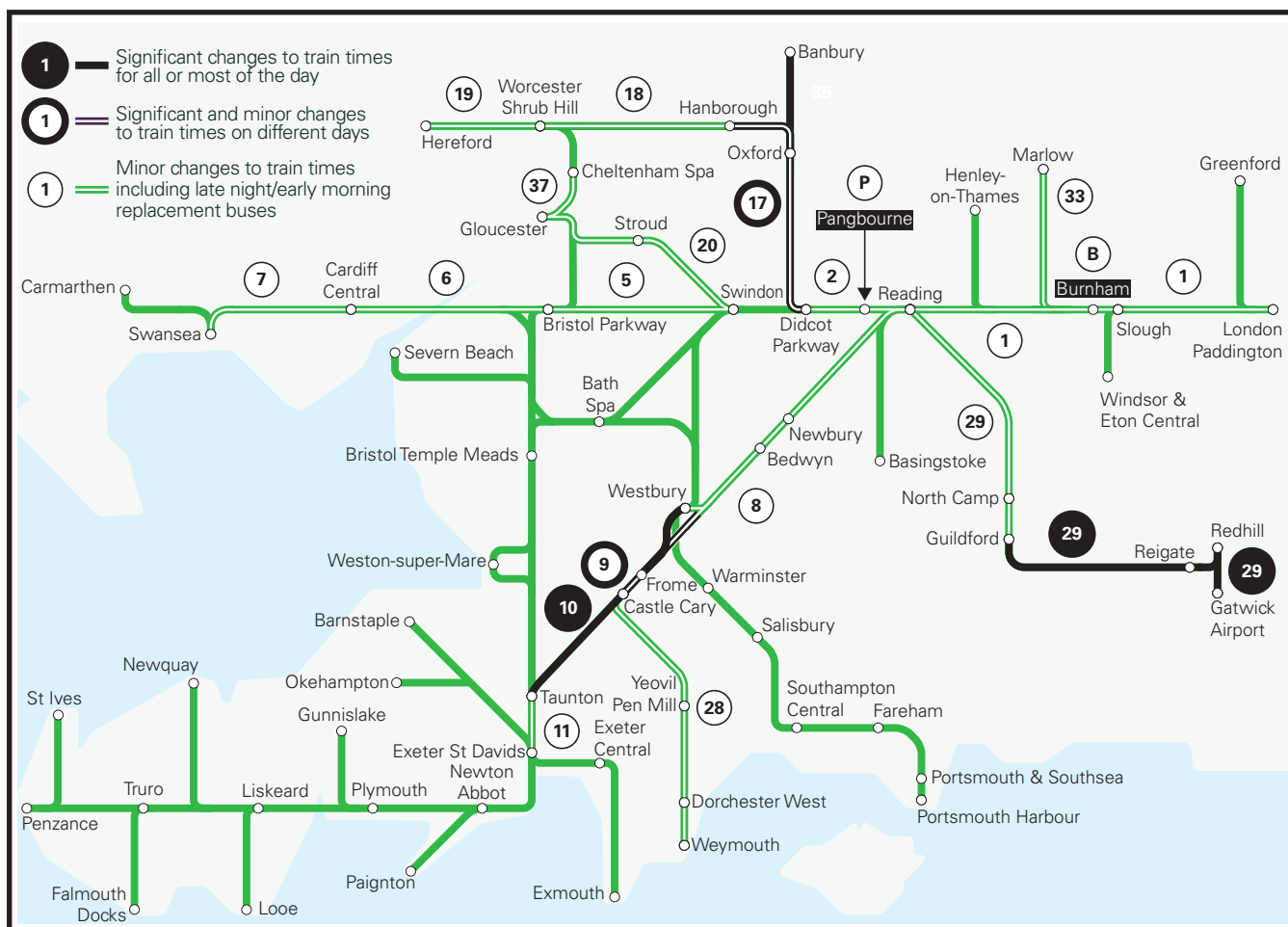


# Summary of timetable changes

- ① ② **Saturday and Sunday** - A slightly reduced service will run between London Paddington, Slough, Reading and Didcot Parkway.  
① ② **Sunday from approximately 0915 to 1930** - Local stopping services from London Paddington to Reading and Didcot Parkway will be slightly retimed.

- ⑤ ⑥  
⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will run up to 30 minutes later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.
- 
- ⑦ **Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Buses will run EARLIER from Swansea to Cardiff Central to connect into the train.

⑩ ⑪ **All week** - Most long-distance trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be diverted to run via Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads and will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. A few trains will make extra stops. Trains that would normally serve Newbury, Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary will either not run at all, or will not run west of either Westbury (Sunday to Thursday) or Castle Cary (Saturday and Friday). Buses will run between Westbury (Sunday to Thursday), Castle Cary and Taunton.

- ⑨ ⑳ **Sunday to Thursday** - Buses will also replace local trains between Frome, Bruton and Castle Cary. A revised service will run between Castle Cary, Yeovil Pen Mill and Weymouth.

⑲ **Saturday and Sunday** - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford / Hanborough / Banbury. A revised service will run between Hanborough, Worcester and Great Malvern. Only a VERY limited GWR service will run to/from Hereford. Passengers should use alternative West Midlands Railway services on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

- ⑰ ⑱ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2150 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway and then run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. A connecting train will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford, with a bus from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2250 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will terminate at Oxford. A bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill. A bus will run non-stop to Oxford, with a connecting train from Oxford to London Paddington. A separate bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford calling at intermediate stations, but there will be no connecting train service to London.

- ⑳ ㉓ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will run non-stop from Swindon and will terminate at Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve intermediate stations.
- 
- ㉔ ㉔ **All weekend** - A revised service will run between Reading and Redhill. Buses will replace trains between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport.
- 
- ㉓ **Sunday from approximately 2000 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow.

- Ⓑ **Sunday from approximately 2315 until end of service** - GWR trains will not call at Burnham. Buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
- 
- Ⓟ **Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
