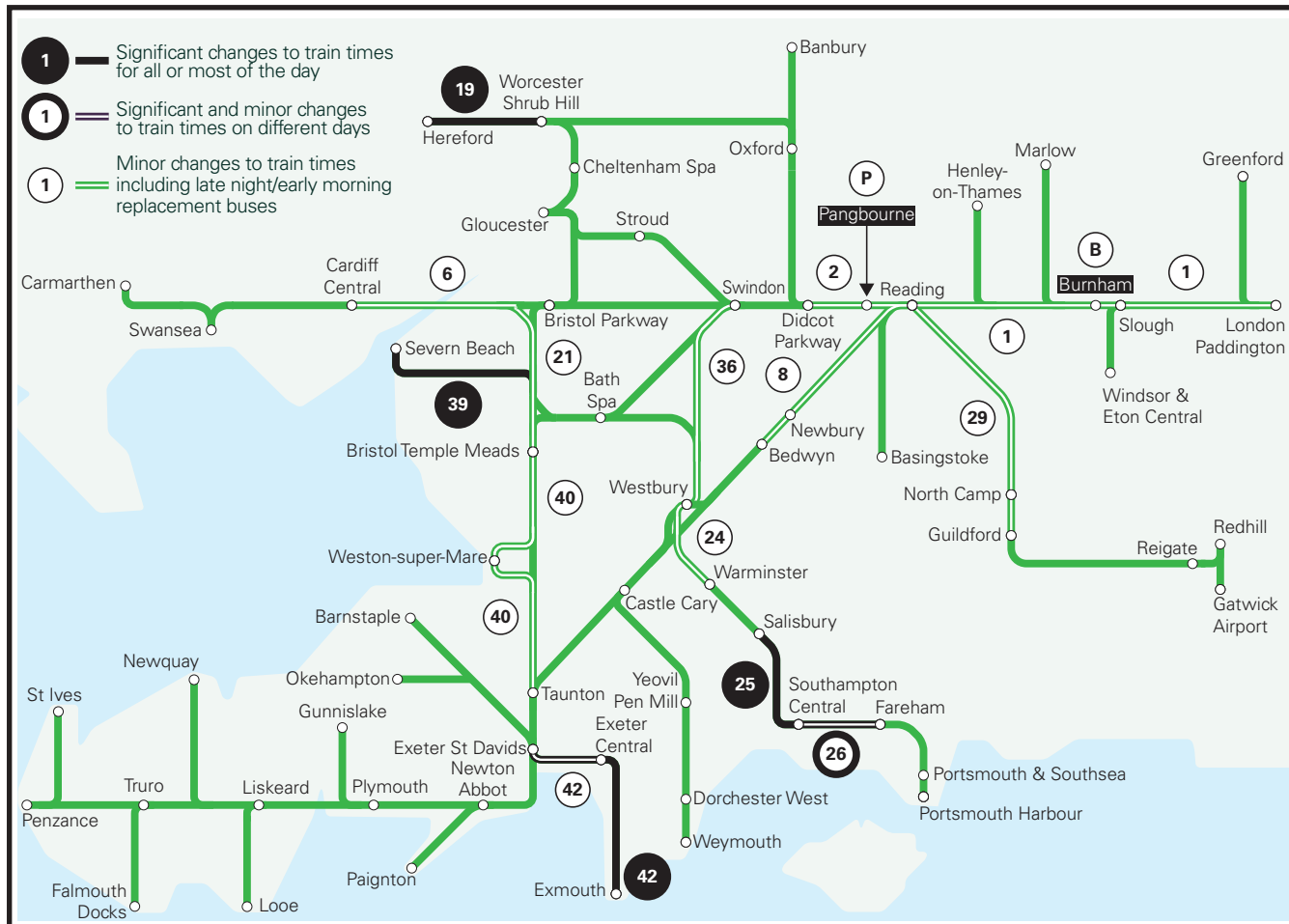


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 15 to Friday 21 October 2022

From approximately 2359 Saturday until 0745 Sunday - Late Saturday evening and early Sunday morning services to/from London Paddington will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey. The 2140 (Saturday) Taunton to London Paddington will not call at Slough.

- ① ② **From approximately 0745 Sunday until 0500 Monday** - Most High Speed services from London Paddington will depart up to 12 minutes EARLIER. A few trains will not run for the whole of their journey, with other trains making additional stops. Some GWR local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will not call at Ealing Broadway and Hayes & Harlington. Passengers should use TfL Elizabeth line services on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

Sunday until approximately 1600 - Trains will be subject to minor retimings between Newport and Cardiff Central, with some trains FROM Cardiff Central departing up to 5 minutes EARLIER than usual.

- ⑥ ⑳ **Monday & Tuesday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run approximately 5 minutes later from Patchway to Bristol Temple Meads.

- ⑧ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2130 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

Sunday - Buses will replace trains between Ledbury and Hereford. The 1227 Hereford to London Paddington will start from Great Malvern and the 1838 London Paddington to Hereford will terminate at Great Malvern. Passengers should use alternative rail/bus services provided by West Midlands Railway to complete their journey.

- ⑱ **Monday** - The 0449 Hereford to London Paddington will start from Worcester Shrub Hill. Passengers from stations west of Worcester Shrub Hill should travel on a later service.

- ⑳ ㉔ **Sunday** - The 0755 Westbury to Warminster will not run and no alternative transport will be provided. The 0811 Warminster to Swindon will be replaced by a bus departing EARLIER than usual from Warminster to Chippenham, with an alternative rail connection available from Chippenham to Swindon.

- ㉕ ㉖ **Sunday** - Trains will be diverted to run between Romsey and Fareham via Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh, not calling at Southampton Central. Buses will run between Eastleigh and Southampton Central. A few trains will only run for part of their journey.

- ㉖ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2121 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will divert after Southampton Central to call additionally at Southampton Airport Parkway and Eastleigh, and will run approximately 15 minutes later from Fareham onwards.

- ㉗ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2320 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A bus will run from Guildford to Reading.
- ㉘ **Tuesday to Friday until approximately 0600** - Early morning trains from Reading to Redhill / Gatwick Airport will be replaced by buses from Reading to Guildford, departing EARLIER than usual.

- ㉙ **Saturday** - Trains will not run between Clifton Down and Severn Beach. **Sunday** - Trains will not run between Bristol Temple Meads, Avonmouth and Severn Beach.

On both days, only a **very** limited replacement bus service will be provided. GWR tickets will also be accepted on local First Bristol, Bath & West buses via any reasonable route. To plan your journey, please visit www.firstbus.co.uk/bristol-bath-and-west

④① **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2130 until end of service** - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.

④② ④② **All weekend** - Some trains between Exeter St Davids and Exeter Central will be subject to minor retimings, in most cases, EARLIER than usual.

Sunday until approximately 1800 - Buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids, Exeter Central and Exmouth.

Ⓑ **Saturday** - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading & 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Ⓟ **Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
