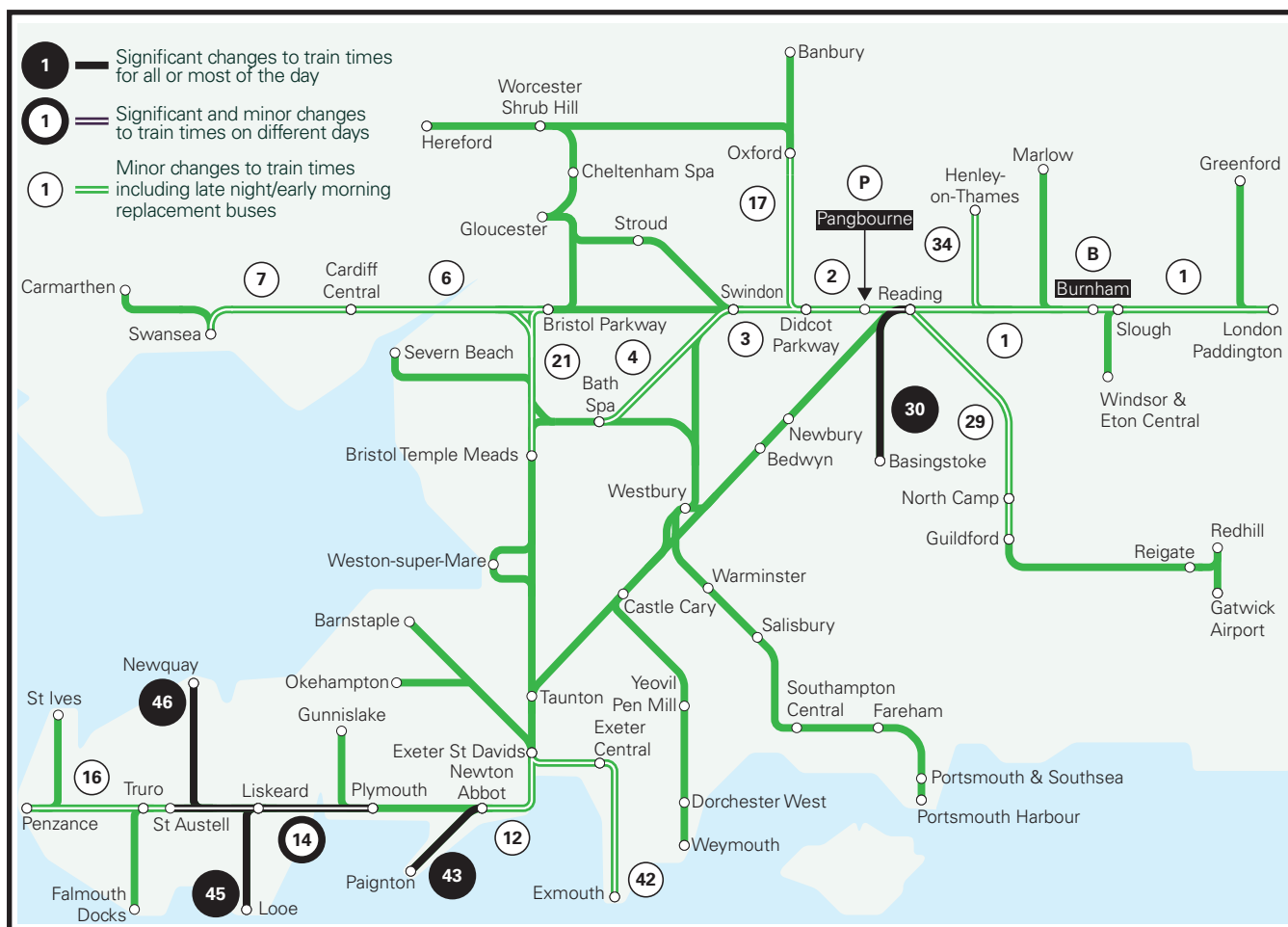


Summary of timetable changes

- ① ② **Saturday from approximately 2345 to Sunday until approximately 0800** - Late Saturday evening/early Sunday morning trains will not run for part of their journey. Some connections will be by alternative TfL Central line services to/from central London, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.
- ① **Sunday** - All day, most High Speed services from London Paddington will be retimed, with some departing a few minutes EARLIER than usual. A few other trains will not run at all.

- ② ③ ④ **Sunday** - The 2258 (departing 2308) & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will run non-stop from Reading to Bath Spa. Alternative local rail services will be available from Reading to Didcot Parkway. Buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham.

- ⑥ ⑦ **Sunday** - Most eastbound trains will depart stations in south Wales as far as Cardiff Central a few minutes EARLIER than usual. Most westbound trains will arrive Cardiff Central and beyond a few minutes later than usual. The 0858 Bristol Parkway to Swansea will run later than usual. The 1413 London Paddington to Cardiff Central will terminate at Newport and the 1650 Cardiff Central to London Paddington will start from Newport. Passengers should use alternative services to complete their journey to/from Cardiff Central.
- Monday to Thursday** - The 2048, 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.

- ⑥ ⑳ **Saturday from approximately 2200 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Cardiff Central/Newport and Filton Abbey Wood/Bristol Temple Meads.
-
- ⑫ ④③ **Saturday & Sunday** - Trains will not run between Newton Abbot and Paignton. Tickets will be accepted on local Stagecoach buses. To plan your journey, please visit www.stagecoachbus.com and select "Paignton" as your local area. A few trains will also terminate at/start from Exeter St Davids.

- ⑭ **Saturday & Sunday** - Buses will replace trains between Plymouth and St Austell. A revised rail service will run between St Austell and Penzance.
-
- ⑭ ⑰ **Monday** - The 0605 & 0910 Penzance to London Paddington and the 0740 Penzance to Cardiff Central will start from Plymouth. Passengers travel on alternative EARLIER services.
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2000 until end of service** - There will be some minor alterations to services between Plymouth/Liskeard and Lostwithiel/Par.
-
- ⑰ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2330 until 0415 next day** - Buses will replace local trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. The 0354 Oxford to Reading will depart at 0334 and run earlier to Didcot Parkway.
-
- ⑳ **Sunday** - Some trains between Reading and Guildford will be retimed by a few minutes, in some cases EARLIER than usual.
-
- ㉓ **Sunday** - Buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.
-
- ㉔ **Tuesday to Thursday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

- ④② **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2330 until end of service** - The last train in each direction between Exeter St Davids and Exmouth will be replaced by buses.

45 **Saturday** - Buses will replace trains between Liskeard and Looe. For details of specific stopping arrangements, please see local publicity.

46 **Saturday & Sunday** - Buses will replace trains to/from Newquay. Buses will run to/from St Austell, not Par. Change at St Austell for alternative buses to/from Par.

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. **Sunday** - The 0033 London Paddington to Reading will not run.

B **Sunday until approximately 0730 and from 2359 until end of service** - Trains will not call at Burnham. Buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2315 until end of service - Trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2330 until 0430 next day - Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.

P **Friday** - The 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
