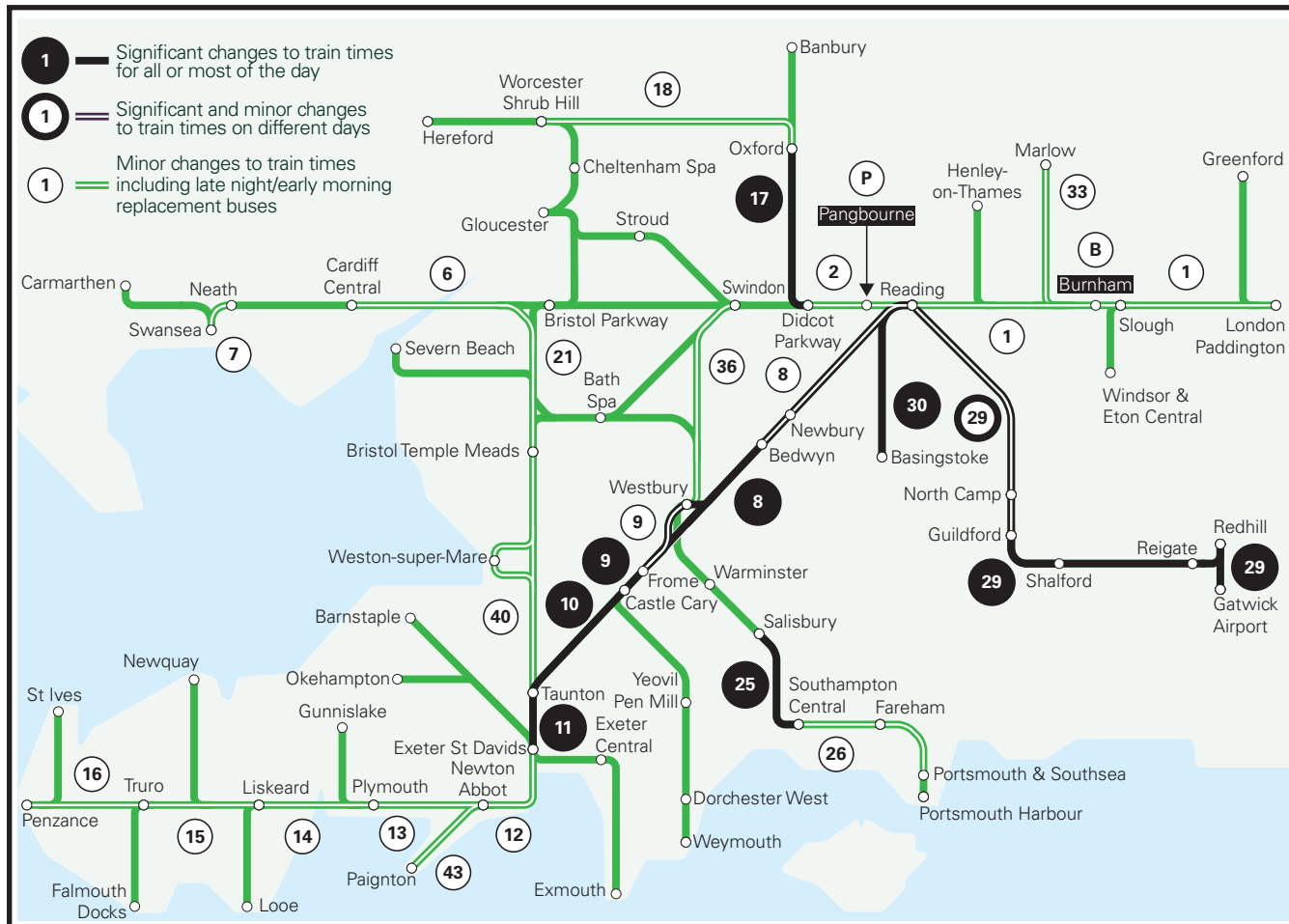


Summary of timetable changes

- Saturday** - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway.
- Sunday until approximately 0800** - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will depart EARLIER at 0013 and a later train will run at 0100 from Ealing Broadway to Reading. The 0634 London Paddington to Reading and 0728 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will start from Ealing Broadway. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journeys to / from central London, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.
- Sunday from approximately 0800** - A few trains will be subject to minor alterations between Maidenhead and Reading.
-
- Friday** - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will run to a special timetable and will divert via an alternative route between Reading and Westbury / Taunton. Many trains will depart from London Paddington and Reading EARLIER than usual. Long-distance trains will not call at Newbury, Hungerford or Pewsey. A few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Local stopping trains between Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey. A reduced service will call at Westbury and Castle Cary. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses to / from Swindon.
- Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**
-
- Monday and Tuesday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Patchway to Bristol Temple Meads.
-
- Monday to Thursday** - The 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will terminate at Neath. Replacement buses will run from Neath to Swansea.
- Tuesday to Friday** - The 0341 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run from Swansea to Neath.
-
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.
-
- Friday** - The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.
-
- Friday** - Trains running to / from London Paddington will also be subject to retimings in Devon and Cornwall. Some may run EARLIER than usual.
-
- Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. A very limited direct service will run from London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill, diverted via an alternative route between Didcot Parkway and Worcester Shrub Hill.
-
- Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Salisbury and Southampton Central. Romsey will only be served by replacement buses operated by SWR. A few trains will only run for part of their journey.

- Monday to Wednesday** - The 2121 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will call additionally at Southampton Airport Parkway and Eastleigh, and will run approximately 15 minutes later from Fareham onwards.

- 29 **Sunday** - All day, a reduced hourly service will run between Blackwater, North Camp, Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Buses will replace trains between Reading and North Camp. Passengers should interchange between buses and trains at North Camp.
-
- Monday to Wednesday** - The 2320 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.
- 29 **Tuesday to Thursday** - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport and 0458 Reading to Redhill will both start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Guildford, departing EARLIER than usual and only calling at certain stations. The 0531 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart slightly EARLIER at 0528 and will call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North and Ash.
-
- 30 **Friday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Reading West will only be served by Reading to Newbury buses. Passengers travelling to / from Reading West will need to travel via Reading.
-
- 33 **Sunday from approximately 1500** - The 1529 (and hourly until 2029) Maidenhead to Marlow will run 3 minutes later than usual. The 2135 Maidenhead to Marlow and 2201 Marlow to Maidenhead will run 2 minutes later than usual.
-
- 36 **Friday** - Some trains between Swindon and Westbury via Melksham will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual. The 1625 Westbury to Swindon will depart at 1647 and terminate at Chippenham. The 1736 Swindon to Westbury will start from Chippenham at 1714 and run earlier throughout.
-
- 40 **Tuesday and Wednesday from approximately 2045 until end of service** - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.
- Wednesday and Thursday** - The 0525 Bristol Temple Meads to Exmouth will start from Taunton. Passengers travelling from stations between Bristol Temple Meads and Bridgwater will need to travel EARLIER on the 0500 from Bristol Temple Meads and change at Taunton.
-
- 43 **Friday** - Direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton will not run. Passengers should use other services, changing where necessary to complete their journey.

- B **Saturday** - The 0018 Reading to London Paddington and 0034 (departing 0040) London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
-
- P **Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
