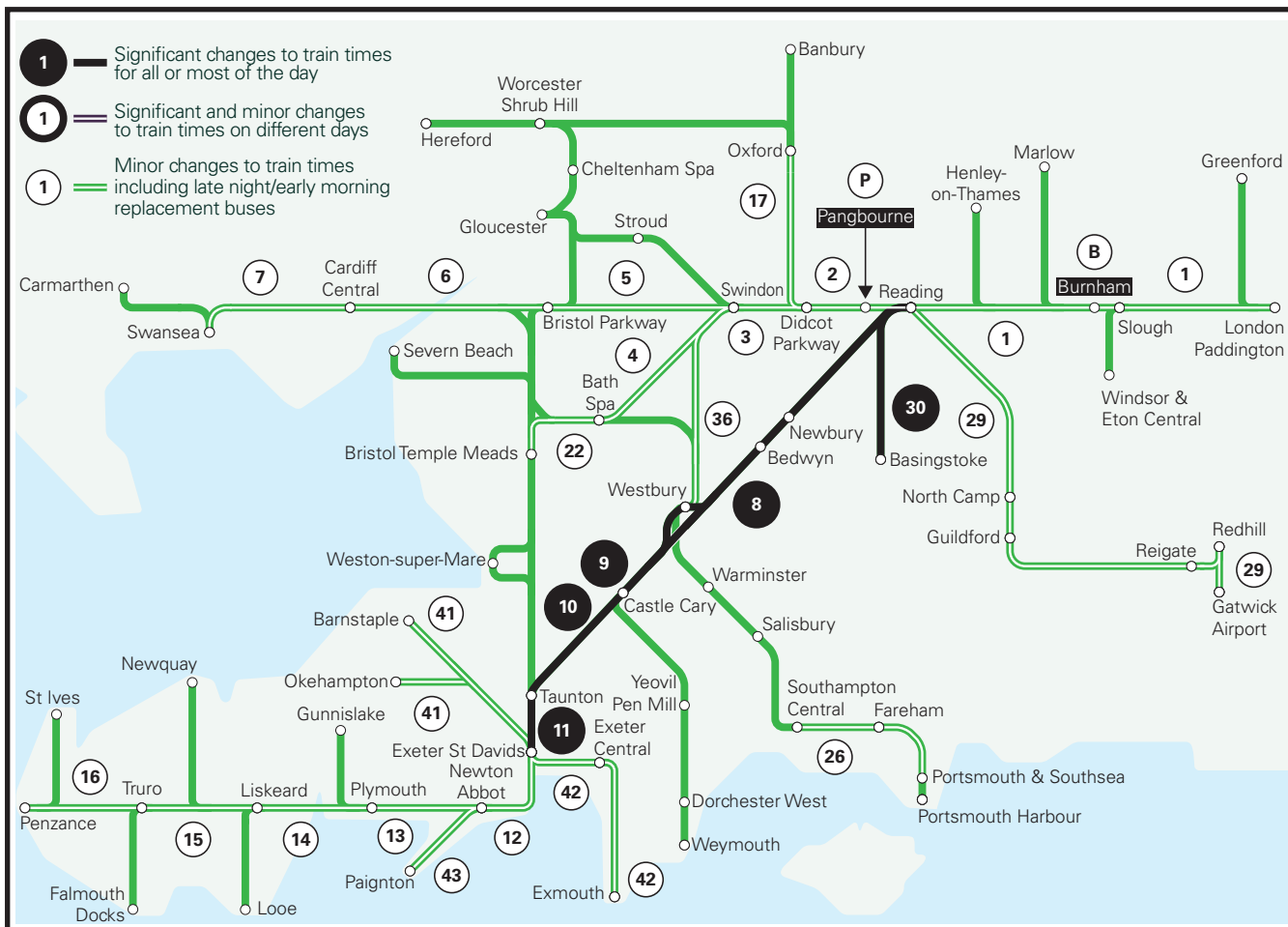


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway.

Sunday until approximately 0800 - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will depart EARLIER at 0013 and a later train will run at 0100 from Ealing Broadway to Reading. The 0634 London Paddington to Reading and 0728 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will start from Ealing Broadway. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journeys to / from central London, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

Sunday from approximately 0800 - Many High Speed services will depart from London Paddington EARLIER than usual. A few trains will either not run at all or will only run for part of their journey.

Tuesday and Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service - Some trains will be subject to minor retimings between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway.

Sunday - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will run to a special timetable and will divert via an alternative route between Reading and Westbury / Taunton. Many trains will depart from London Paddington and Reading EARLIER than usual. Long-distance trains will not call at Newbury, Hungerford or Pewsey. A few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Local stopping trains between Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey. A reduced service will call at Westbury and Castle Cary. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses to / from Swindon.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Monday to Thursday - The 2318 London Paddington to Oxford will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will divert after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham, from Didcot Parkway to Swindon and from Swindon and Chippenham to Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday - The 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will divert after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway onwards.

Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Swansea and intermediate stations to Cardiff Central. The 0835 Swansea to London Paddington will run slightly later from Swansea to Bristol Parkway.

Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will be subject to minor retimings after departing Cardiff Central.

All weekend - Trains running to / from London Paddington will also be subject to retimings in Devon and Cornwall. Some may run EARLIER than usual.

Monday to Thursday - The 2121 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will call additionally at Southampton Airport Parkway and Eastleigh, and will run approximately 15 minutes later from Fareham onwards.

Sunday until approximately 2100 - Trains from Redhill to Reading will run a few minutes later than usual.

②⑨ **Monday to Wednesday** - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport. The 2320 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Redhill. A replacement bus will run from Redhill to Guildford, then a connecting rail service from Guildford to Reading.

③⑩ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Reading West will only be served by Reading to Newbury buses. Passengers travelling to / from Reading West will need to travel via Reading.

③⑥ **Sunday** - Some trains between Swindon and Westbury via Melksham will be retimed.

④① ④② **Sunday** - Some local trains between Exeter St Davids and Exmouth / Okehampton / Barnstaple / Paignton will be slightly retimed to maintain connections with retimed long-distance services from London Paddington.

③ **Saturday** - The 0018 Reading to London Paddington and 0034 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

③ **Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
