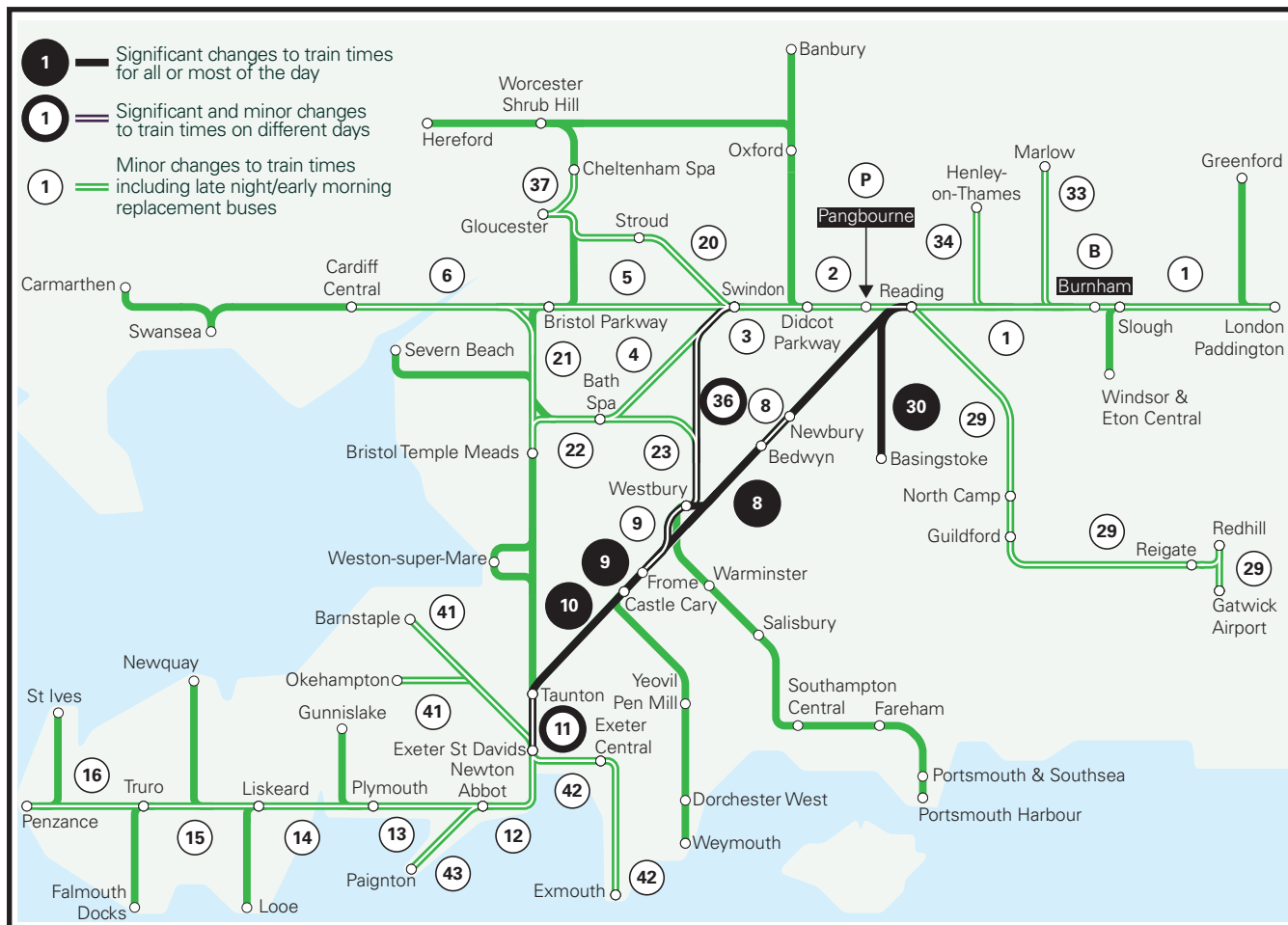


# Summary of timetable changes

**Sunday** - The 0728 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0846 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will run slightly later for all or part of their journey.

① ② **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service each evening** - Some High Speed trains will run slightly later from Reading to London Paddington. Some local stopping trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway.

⑪ **Sunday** - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will run to a special timetable and will divert via an alternative route between Reading and Westbury / Taunton. Many trains will depart from London Paddington and Reading EARLIER than usual. Long-distance trains will not call at Newbury, Hungerford or Pewsey. A few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Local stopping trains between Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey. A reduced service will call at Westbury and Castle Cary. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses to / from Swindon.

**Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

⑥ **Sunday until approximately 1430** - Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. Trains towards South Wales will depart EARLIER from London Paddington, Reading and Swindon. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Alternative rail connections will be available between Swindon and Bristol Parkway via Bristol Temple Meads. The 0858 Bristol Parkway to Swansea will start from Newport. The 1003 Bristol Parkway to London Paddington will depart EARLIER at 0935 and the 1016 London Paddington to Bristol Parkway will depart at 1043.

⑫ ⑬ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2232 & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will divert after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads. The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run in place of all these services.

**Saturday** - The 1650 Penzance to Cardiff Central will divert after Filton Abbey Wood to terminate at Bristol Parkway. The 2247 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will be replaced by a bus.

⑥ ⑰ **Sunday until approximately 1430** - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will either not run or will be diverted to run to / from Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport.

**Monday and Tuesday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Patchway to Bristol Temple Meads.

⑧ **Saturday** - The 0508 Reading to Bedwyn will terminate at Newbury and the 0608 Bedwyn to Reading will start from Newbury. Replacement buses will run between Newbury and Bedwyn.

**Sunday** - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive Exeter St Davids approximately 20 minutes later than usual.

⑪ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2200 until end of service** - Trains running via Taunton, Tiverton Parkway and Exeter St Davids will be subject to retimings.

- ⑫ ⑬ **Sunday** - Trains running to / from London Paddington will also be subject to retimings in Devon and Cornwall. Some may run EARLIER than usual.

- ⑳ ㉑ **Sunday** - The 1054 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will depart at 1104 and the 1401 Cheltenham Spa to Swindon will depart at 1420.  
**Monday to Thursday** - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will divert to run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve intermediate stations via Stroud.

- ㉒ **Sunday until approximately 2100** - Trains from Redhill to Reading will run a few minutes later than usual.  
**Monday to Thursday** - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport. The 2320 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Redhill and restart from Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Redhill to Guildford.  
**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will run later from Guildford onwards and will terminate at Redhill. The 0600 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. Alternative rail connections, operated by Southern or Thameslink, will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

- ㉓ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Reading West will only be served by Reading to Newbury buses.
- 
- ㉔ **Sunday** - The 0009 (departing 0012) Marlow to Maidenhead will terminate at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
- 
- ㉕ **Monday to Wednesday** - The 2146 & 2216 Twyford to Henley-on-Thames and the 2201 & 2231 Henley-on-Thames to Twyford will run 3 minutes later than usual.  
**Tuesday to Thursday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

- ㉖ ㉗ **Sunday** - Some trains between Swindon and Westbury via Melksham will be retimed.  
**Tuesday to Thursday** - Trains between Swindon and Westbury via Melksham will not run. Replacement buses will run between Chippenham and Westbury. Alternative rail connections will be available between Swindon and Chippenham.

- ㉘ ㉙ **Sunday** - Some local trains between Exeter St Davids and Exmouth / Okehampton / Barnstaple / Paignton will be slightly retimed to maintain connections with retimed long-distance services from London Paddington.

**Saturday** - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

**Sunday** - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

**(B)** **Monday to Friday** - 2350 London Paddington to Reading;  
**Tuesday to Friday** - 0018 Reading to London Paddington and 0034 (departing 0040) London Paddington to Reading.

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

**Sunday - *The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:*** 0634 & 2354 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 & 0710 Reading to London Paddington, 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

***The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:***

**(P)** **Sunday** - 2320 Reading to Didcot Parkway, 2327 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway, 2245 (departing 2248) & 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

**Friday** - 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway.

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
