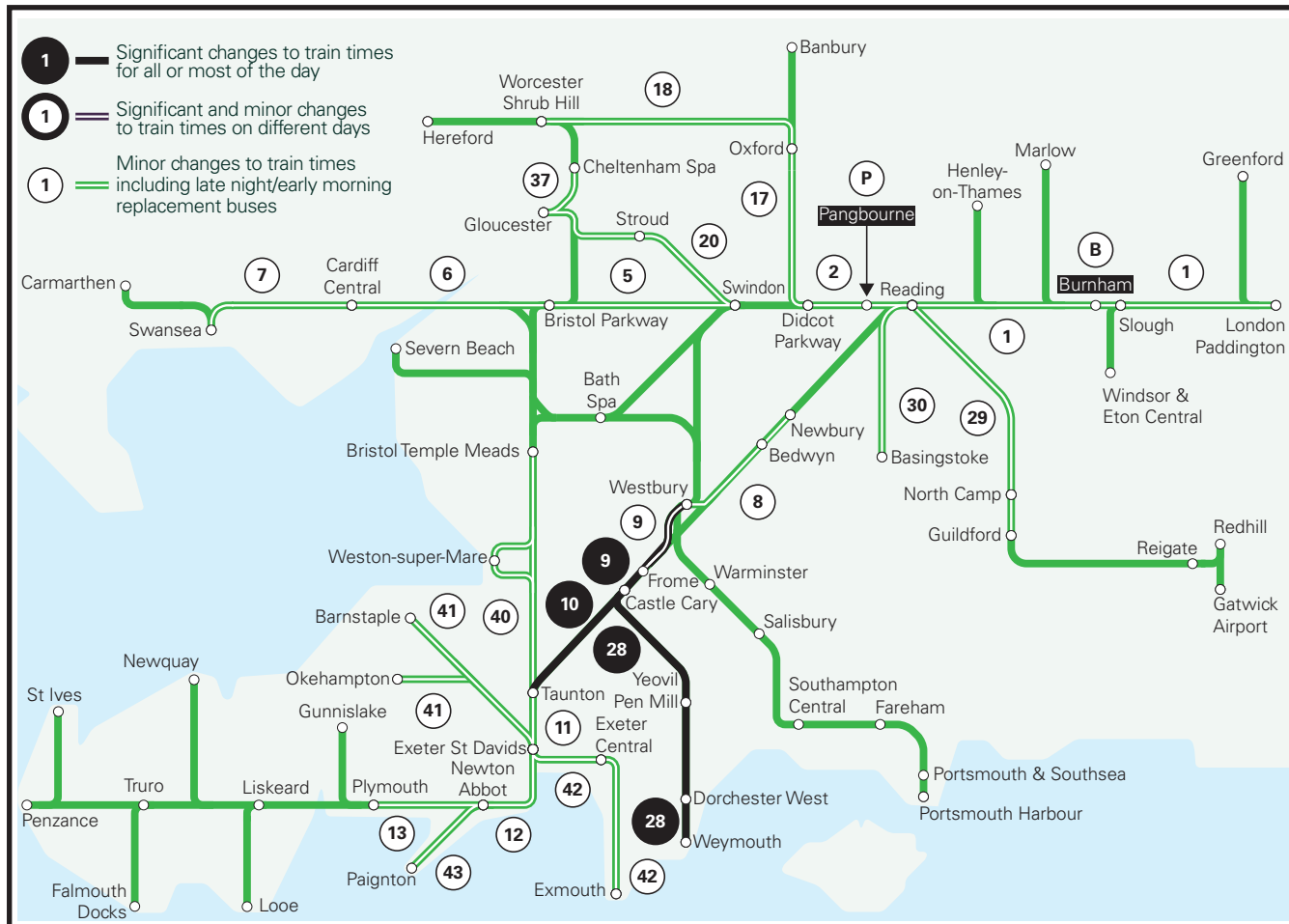


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday - The 2140 Taunton to London Paddington will not call at Slough. The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. **Sunday until approximately 0800** - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will depart EARLIER at 0013 and a later train will run at 0100 from Ealing Broadway to Reading. The 0634 London Paddington to Reading and 0728 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will start from Ealing Broadway. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journeys to / from central London, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

Sunday to Wednesday - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will run to a special timetable and will divert via an alternative route between Reading and Taunton. Many trains will depart from London Paddington and Reading EARLIER than usual. Trains that would normally call at some or all of Newbury, Hungerford, Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary will generally run between London Paddington and Westbury only. Replacement buses will run between Westbury, Castle Cary and Taunton. A few other trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service each evening - Some High Speed trains will run slightly later from Reading to London Paddington. Some local stopping trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be retimed by a few minutes for all or part of their journey.

Monday to Thursday - The 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will divert after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway onwards.

Tuesday and Wednesday - The 2048, 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will be retimed a few minutes later after Port Talbot Parkway.

Tuesday and Friday - The 0341 Swansea to London Paddington will depart at 0400 and run slightly later as far as Cardiff Central.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn.

Saturday - The 2124 Great Malvern to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.

Sunday to Wednesday - Trains will not run between Westbury, Frome and Castle Cary (Sunday and Monday) or between Frome and Castle Cary (Tuesday and Wednesday). Replacement buses will run between Westbury, Frome and Castle Cary, and a revised train service will operate between Frome (Tuesday and Wednesday only), Castle Cary and Weymouth.

Sunday - Some trains to / from London Paddington will also be subject to retimings in Devon. Other local services between Exeter St Davids and Exmouth / Okehampton / Barnstaple / Paignton may also be subject to minor retimings as a result.

- Monday to Thursday** - The 2150 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway and will then divert to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. Passengers for Oxford should travel on the 2220 London Paddington to Oxford service. A replacement bus will connect out of this train at Oxford and run to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2250 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will terminate at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill non-stop to Oxford, connecting into a train to London Paddington. A separate replacement bus will also run from Worcester Shrub Hill, calling at intermediate stations to Oxford - there will be no onward rail connection to London Paddington out of this bus.

- Monday to Thursday** - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER at 2317 and will run non-stop to and terminate at Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, serving intermediate stations.

- Sunday until approximately 2100** - Trains from Redhill to Reading will run a few minutes later than usual.

- Sunday** - The 0737 Reading to Basingstoke and 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will be replaced by buses, departing EARLIER than usual. Buses will not call at Reading West.

- Sunday** - Trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton.
-
- Saturday** - The 0018 Reading to London Paddington and 0034 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

- Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
