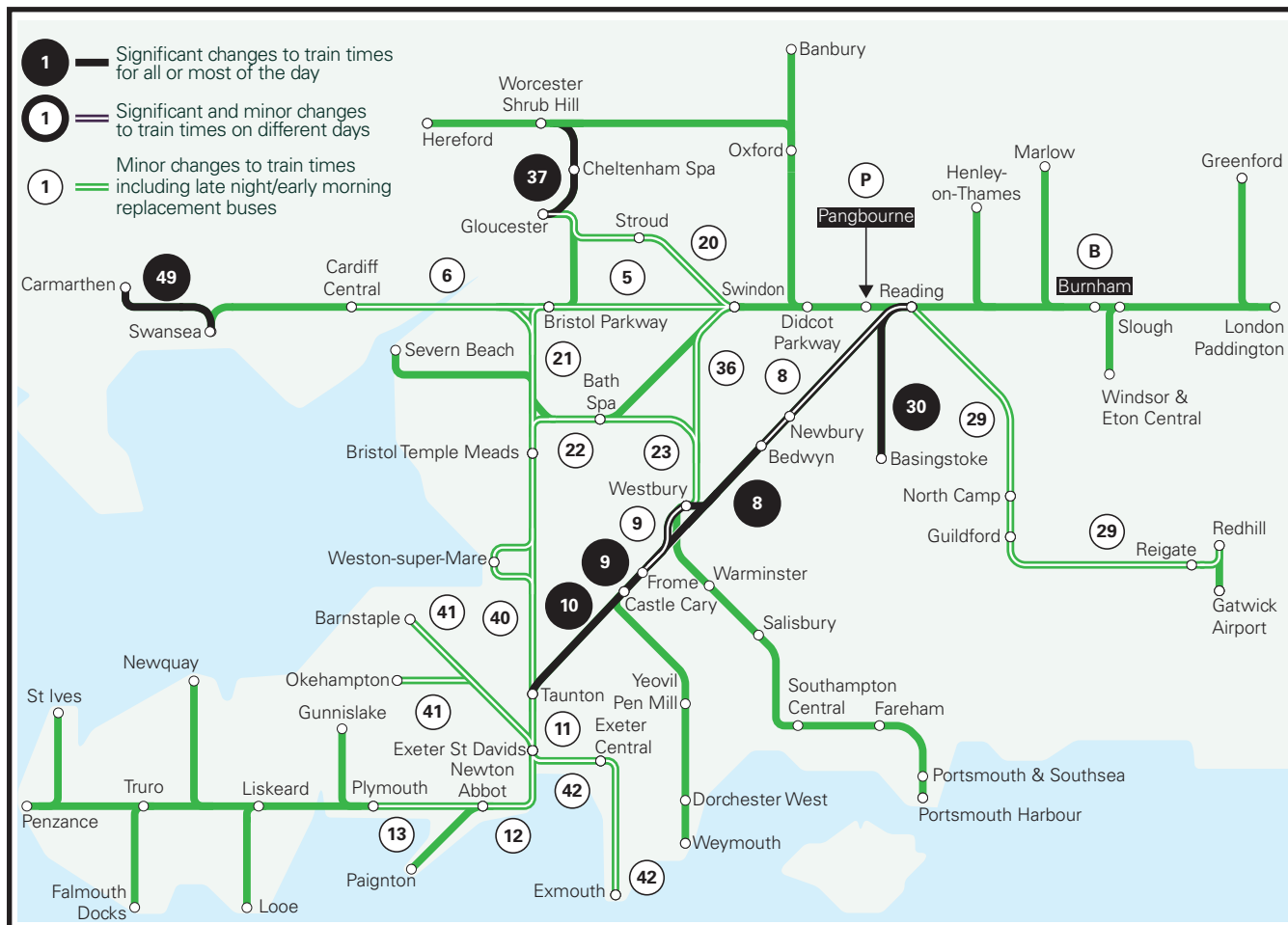


# Summary of timetable changes

⑪ **Sunday** - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will run to a special timetable and will divert via an alternative route between Reading and Westbury / Taunton. Many trains will depart from London Paddington and Reading EARLIER than usual. Long-distance trains will not call at Newbury, Hungerford or Pewsey. A few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Local stopping trains between Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey. A reduced service will call at Westbury and Castle Cary. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses to / from Swindon.

**Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

⑤ ⑥ **Sunday until approximately 1530** - Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted and will not call at Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Passengers should use other services via Bristol Temple Meads to travel between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. A few other trains will be retimed.

**Saturday** - The 1650 Penzance to Cardiff Central will divert after Filton Abbey Wood to terminate at Bristol Parkway. Passengers should use other services to complete their journey, changing where necessary. The 2247 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not run and will be replaced by a bus.

⑥ ⑳ **Sunday until approximately 1530** - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will either not run or will be diverted to / from Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Passengers should use other services to travel to / from Cardiff Central.

**Monday to Thursday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not call at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus will serve these stations.

⑧ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening** - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

㉓ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will depart at 2352 and run 5-7 minutes later throughout.

⑪ **Sunday** - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive Exeter St Davids approximately 20 minutes later than usual.

⑫ ⑬ **Sunday** - Trains running to / from London Paddington will also be subject to retimings in Devon. Some may run EARLIER than usual.

㉔ ㉗ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street. On Sunday, most trains from Swindon to Gloucester will run a few minutes later than usual.

**Sunday until approximately 2100** - Trains from Redhill to Reading will run a few minutes later than usual.

㉙ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2320 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The first three trains from Reading to Redhill / Gatwick Airport will be replaced by buses between Reading and Guildford, or will be slightly retimed.

③① **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Passengers for Reading West will need to use scheduled trains to / from Reading.

③⑥ **Sunday** - Some trains between Swindon and Westbury via Melksham will be retimed.

---

④① **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2230 until end of service each evening** - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton via Weston-super-Mare will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey - this will also include the 2305 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids. The 2024 Exmouth to Cardiff Central will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads.

④① ④② **Sunday** - Some local trains between Exeter St Davids and Exmouth / Okehampton / Barnstaple / Paignton will be slightly retimed to maintain connections with retimed long-distance services from London Paddington.

④⑨ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

---

④ **Saturday** - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

---

④ **Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
