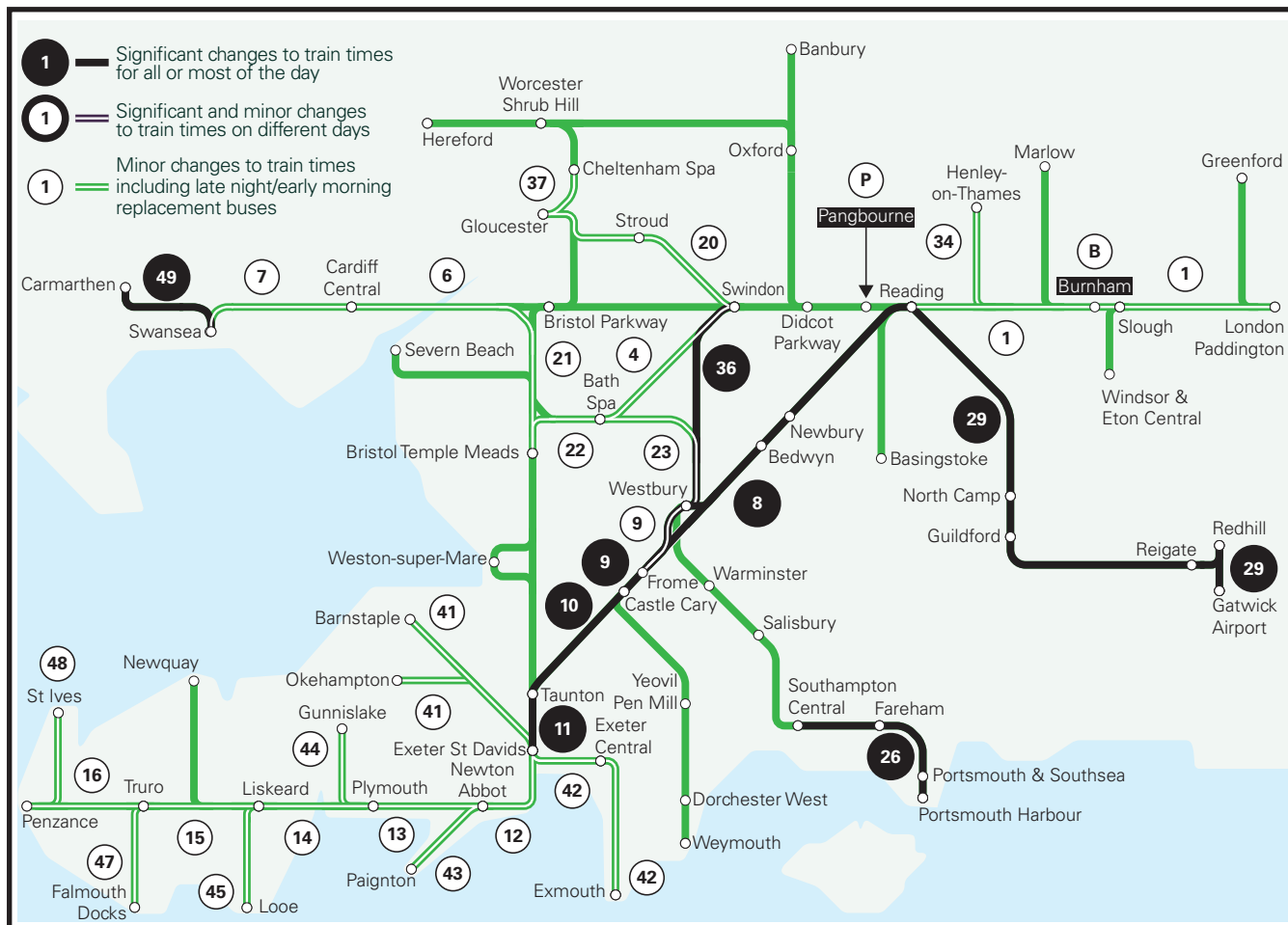


Summary of timetable changes

All weekend - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will run to a special timetable and will divert via an alternative route between Reading and Westbury / Taunton. Many trains will depart from London Paddington and Reading EARLIER than usual. Long-distance trains will not call at Newbury, Hungerford or Pewsey. A few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Local stopping trains between Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey. A reduced service will call at Westbury and Castle Cary. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses to / from Swindon.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Monday to Thursday - The 2232 & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will divert after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will serve Chippenham and Bath Spa.

Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Patchway to Bristol Temple Meads.

Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will run up to 30 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2330 until end of service each evening - The 2116 Great Malvern to Westbury will terminate at Bath Spa. The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run instead of all these services. The 2023 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads with a connecting service available from Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 1900 until end of service each evening - Trains running between Newton Abbot and Plymouth will be subject to alteration. Some trains will only run for part of their journey with other trains making additional calls as a result. Some trains will be replaced by buses for part of their journey. In some cases, passengers may need to travel EARLIER than usual to complete their journey. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

All weekend - Trains running to / from London Paddington will also be subject to retimings in Devon and Cornwall. Some may run EARLIER than usual.

Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve Kemble, Stroud and Stonehouse.

All weekend - Buses will replace trains between Southampton Central, Fareham and Portsmouth & Southsea / Portsmouth Harbour. A few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey.

Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday - The 2146 & 2216 Twyford to Henley-on-Thames and the 2201 & 2231 Henley-on-Thames to Twyford will all run 3 minutes later than usual.

Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

All weekend - Trains between Swindon and Westbury via Melksham will run to a revised timetable.

All weekend - Some trains between Exeter St Davids and Exmouth / Paignton / Okehampton and Barnstaple will be slightly retimed to maintain connections with retimed long-distance services from London Paddington.

Monday to Thursday - The 2054 Exmouth to Barnstaple will terminate at Crediton and the 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run at all. Replacement buses will run instead. Yeoford will be served by a separate minibus shuttle to / from Crediton only.

Saturday - Some afternoon and evening trains between Plymouth and Gunnislake, Liskeard and Looe, Truro and Falmouth Docks, and Penzance / St Erth and St Ives will be slightly retimed to maintain connections with retimed long-distance services from London Paddington.

All weekend - Buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday - 2350 London Paddington to Reading

Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday - 0018 Reading to London Paddington

Tuesday to Friday - 0034 (departing 0040) London Paddington to Reading

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Sunday - The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:

0634 & 2354 London Paddington to Reading, 2327 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway, 0620 and 0710 Reading to

London Paddington, 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway, 2332 Reading to Didcot Parkway and 2322 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Pangbourne.

Tuesday and Wednesday - The 0045 & 0355 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne.

Friday - The 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne.

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
