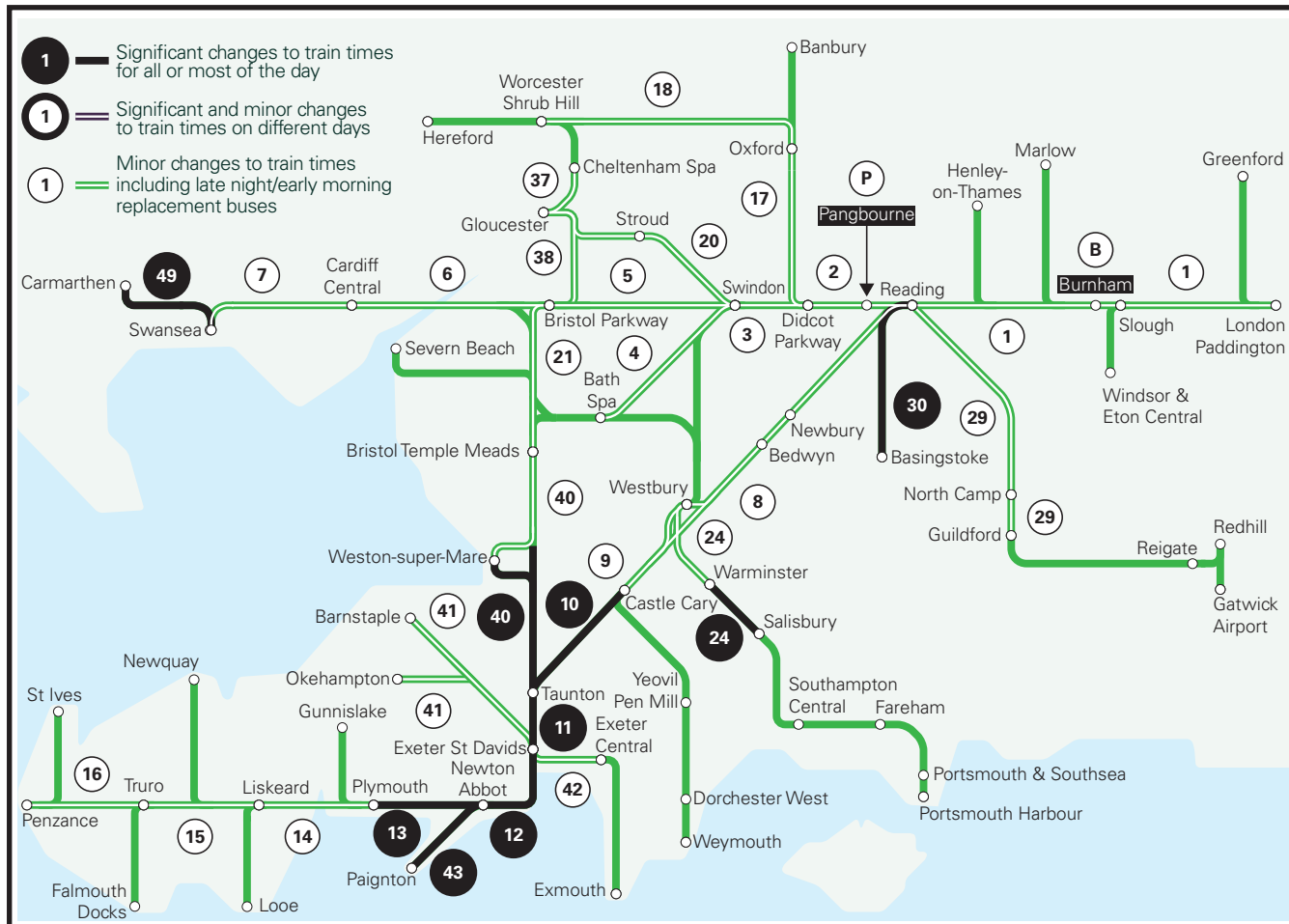


# Summary of timetable changes

**Saturday** - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway.

**Sunday** - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will depart EARLIER at 0013 and a later train will run at 0100 from Ealing Broadway to Reading. The 0634 London Paddington to Reading and 0728 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will start from Ealing Broadway.

① ② The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journeys to / from central London, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

**Monday to Thursday from approximately 2015 until end of service** - Some local trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway.

② ③ **Sunday** - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will divert after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling to Didcot Parkway should use alternative local services from Reading.

⑤ ⑥ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run approximately 25-30 minutes later from Bristol Parkway onwards.

**Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Swansea and intermediate stations to Cardiff Central. The 0835 Swansea to London Paddington will depart at 0840 and run a few minutes later as far as Bristol Parkway.

**Tuesday and Wednesday** - The 2048, 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will be slightly retimed from Port Talbot Parkway onwards.

⑩ ⑪ **Monday to Thursday** - A revised, reduced service will operate between London Paddington and the West of England. Trains will be diverted between Castle Cary and Exeter St Davids, not calling at Taunton or Tiverton Parkway. Some trains will run between London Paddington and Castle Cary only. Buses will replace trains between Weston-super-Mare / Castle Cary and Taunton / Tiverton Parkway / Exeter St Davids. A revised train service will operate between Exeter St Davids and Paignton / Plymouth (and Penzance). **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

**All weekend** - A revised service will operate between Taunton, Exeter St Davids, Newton Abbot and Paignton / Plymouth. Buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids and Newton Abbot. In addition, non-stop buses will run between Tiverton Parkway and Plymouth for passengers making longer-distance journeys. The Night Riviera Sleeper **will** run on Sunday evening, but will run up to 2 hours later than usual from Plymouth onwards. **On Sunday until approximately 1630**, buses will also replace trains between Newton Abbot and Plymouth. **On Sunday**, all day there will be no trains between Newton Abbot and Paignton. GWR tickets will be accepted on local buses. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

⑭ ⑮ **Saturday to Thursday** - As a result of the engineering work taking place between Exeter St Davids, Newton Abbot and Plymouth (on Saturday and Sunday), and between Weston-super-Mare / Castle Cary and Taunton / Tiverton Parkway (on Monday to Thursday), a revised service will run between Plymouth and Penzance.

- Monday to Thursday** - The 2150 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, then be diverted to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. An alternative rail connection will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford, with a replacement bus running from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2150 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will terminate at Oxford.
- (17) (18)** A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill. A non-stop bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, connecting into a train to London Paddington. A separate bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford calling at intermediate stations, but there will be no onward rail connection to London at Oxford.

- Monday to Thursday** - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER at 2317 and will run non-stop to and terminate at Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, serving intermediate stations.

- Monday to Thursday** - The 2236 Worcester Shrub Hill to Bristol Temple Meads will divert after Gloucester and will run approximately 30 minutes later from Bristol Parkway onwards.

- All weekend** - Buses will replace trains between Warminster and Salisbury. A few trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey.

- Sunday until approximately 2100** - Some trains from Redhill to Reading will be slightly retimed from Guildford to Reading.

- Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Reading West passengers will need to use scheduled trains to / from Newbury and travel via Reading.

- 
- Monday to Thursday** - As a result of the engineering work taking place between Castle Cary and Exeter St Davids, most trains between Okehampton and Exeter Central will not run between Exeter St Davids and Exeter Central. A few other trains to / from Barnstaple will run a few minutes earlier between Exeter and Crediton or will only run for part of their journey.

- All weekend** - Buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

- Saturday** - The 0034 (departing 0040) London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

- Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
