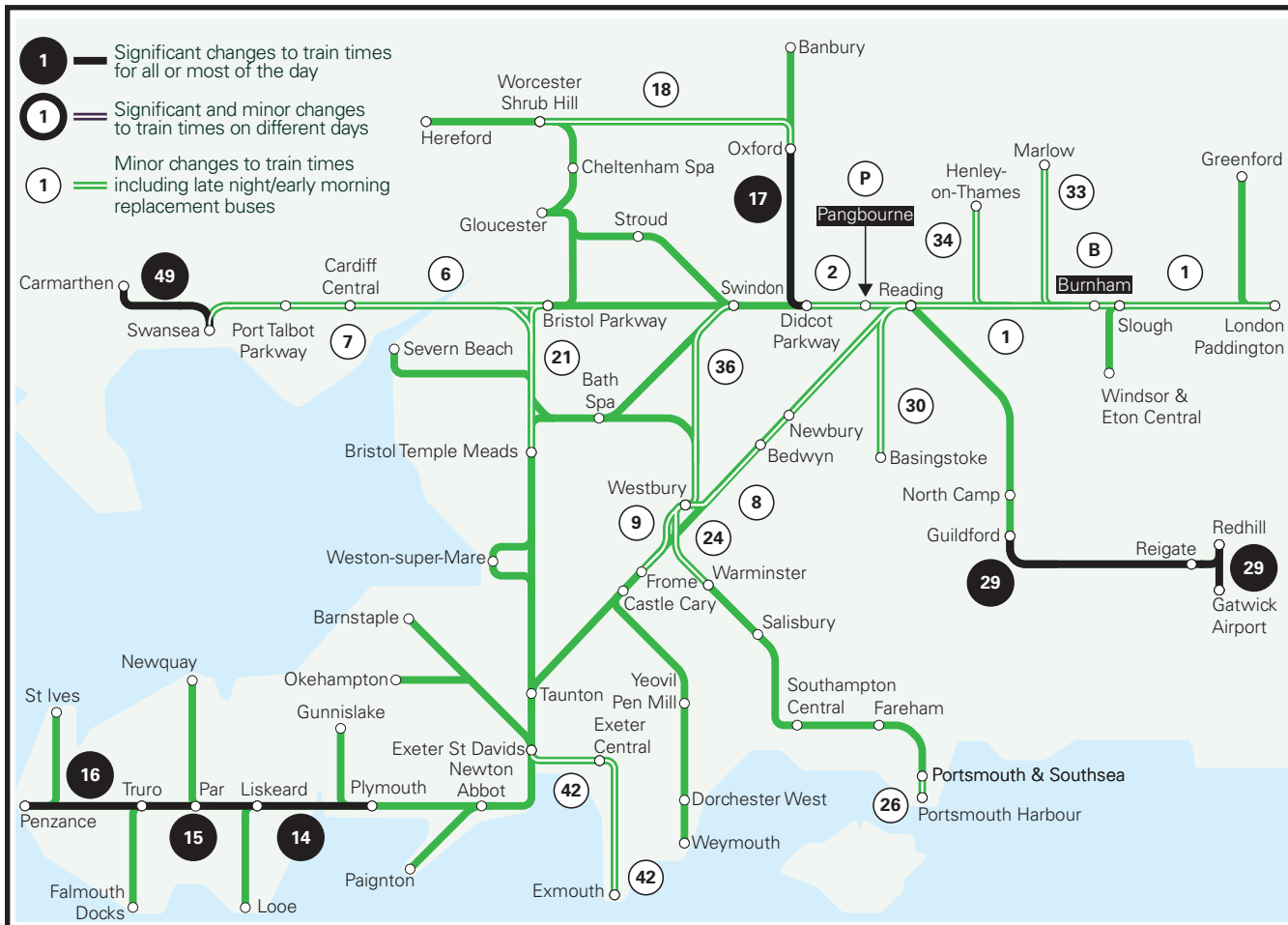


# Summary of timetable changes

**Saturday** - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway.

**Sunday until approximately 0800** - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will depart EARLIER at 0013 and a later train will run at 0120 from Ealing Broadway to Reading. The 0634 London Paddington to Reading and 0728 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will start from Ealing Broadway. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journeys to / from central London, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

- ① ② **Sunday from approximately 0800** - Many High Speed services will depart from London Paddington EARLIER than usual. A few trains will only run for part of their journey. Many local stopping services from London Paddington to Reading / Didcot Parkway will be retimed and will not call at Ealing Broadway or Hayes & Harlington. Passengers should use alternative TfL Elizabeth line services if travelling to / from these stations, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

**Monday to Thursday from approximately 2015 until end of service** - Some local trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway.

- ⑥ ⑦ **Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Port Talbot Parkway. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Swansea and Neath to Port Talbot Parkway.  
The 0858 Bristol Parkway to Swansea will start from Newport. Passengers travelling from Bristol Parkway should use the next available service.

- ⑥ ②① **Saturday from approximately 2130** - The 2200 & 2247 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not run and will be replaced by buses. The 1823 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will terminate at Newport and the 1650 Penzance to Cardiff Central will divert after Filton Abbey Wood to terminate at Bristol Parkway. Onward rail connections will be available in both cases. The 2023 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads, with a replacement bus running from Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central.

- ⑧ **Sunday** - The 0751 London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. Newbury passengers travel on later services. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses to / from Swindon. The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run, and will be replaced by a bus, departing EARLIER than usual.

- ⑨ **Saturday** - The 2124 Great Malvern to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.  
**Monday to Thursday** - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.

**Sunday** - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance Night Riviera Sleeper service will terminate at Plymouth. Alternative road / rail connections will be available to stations in Cornwall.

- ⑭ ⑮ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance Night Riviera Sleeper service will terminate at Plymouth. Alternative rail / road connections will be available to stations in Cornwall.

- ⑯ **Monday to Friday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Plymouth / Liskeard and St Austell. The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington Night Riviera Sleeper service will start from Plymouth. Alternative rail / road connections will be available from stations in Cornwall.

**17 18** **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Two direct trains will run from London Paddington at 1920 to Hereford and 2050 to Worcester Shrub Hill, diverted via an alternative route between Didcot Parkway and Worcester Shrub Hill.

**24 36** **Sunday** - The 0755 Westbury to Warminster will not run (no replacement transport provided). The 0811 Warminster to Swindon will be replaced by a bus from Warminster to Chippenham, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0914 Swindon to Westbury will start from Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon.

**26** **Saturday** - All day, most GWR services from Portsmouth Harbour will depart 3 minutes EARLIER than usual.

**29** **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport.

**30** **Sunday until approximately 0915** - The 0737 Reading to Basingstoke & 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will be replaced by a bus departing EARLIER than usual. The 0837 Reading to Basingstoke will depart later and will run non-stop from Reading to Basingstoke. The 0906 Basingstoke to Reading will run slightly later than usual.

**33 34** **Sunday** - The 0009 Marlow to Maidenhead will depart at 0012 and terminate at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.

**33 34** **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

**42** **Monday to Thursday** - The 2340 (Monday to Wednesday) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (Tuesday to Thursday) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by buses.

**49** **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

## ***The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:***

**Saturday** - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington

**Sunday** - 0034 (departing 0013) London Paddington to Reading and 0120 Ealing Broadway to Reading

**Monday to Friday** - 2350 London Paddington to Reading

**B** **Tuesday to Friday** - 0018 Reading to London Paddington and 0034 (departing 0040) London Paddington to Reading  
In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

**Sunday** - ***The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:*** 0634 (starting Ealing Broadway) & 2354 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (terminating Ealing Broadway) & 0710 Reading to London Paddington, 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington.  
Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

## ***The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:***

**P** **Sunday** - 2320 Reading to Didcot Parkway, 2327 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway, 2245 & 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington

**Friday** - 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
